Division of Employment Security (DUA)

Following a federal disaster declaration because of Hurricane Helene, Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) benefits are now available in 25 counties as well as the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.

- People in these counties have **60 days from October 1** to file an application for Disaster Unemployment Assistance.
- The deadline to apply is **December 2.**
