HIGH SCHOOL EXPO POSTER PRESENTATION COMPETITION GUIDELINES

BMES encourages applicants to submit poster proposals in the Biomedical Engineering field, but it is not a requirement for entry. Participants will be selected solely based on the quality of their scientific research.

Applicants must be Juniors or Seniors in the 2021 Fall school year to be considered. Students in the Orlando area, from under represented groups, or from BMES High School Student Chapters will be given higher consideration upon submission.

Poster Size and Format for Consideration

- Your project poster should fit within a 4 ft TALL by x 8 ft WIDE cork board.
- PPT or PDF format is acceptable.
- Suggested font size for text is 26 font or larger. Keep your poster concise with more visuals and less text.

Competition Criteria

- 1) Message delivery – Clear objectives and clear approach to achieve objectives
- 2) Project conclusion – Clear project conclusion
- 3) Scientific/biomedical engineering impact – Clear scientific or societal impact of the conclusions of the project
