Annual Learning Exchange & LBM Expo Recap

#### LEARN GROW CONNECT Annual Learning Exchange & LBM Expo

As the 2024 Expo grows distant in the rearview, we would like to take a moment to reflect on this exciting event filled with valuable insights, meaningful networking and embracing change. Exhibitors showcased the latest advancements in their products and services, while the education sessions provided forward-thinking, actionable strategies to help attendees navigate the ever-changing industry landscape.

Wednesday's seminars began with an engaging panel discussion on the intangible topic of Company Culture, sponsored by Nuvo. Industry peers shared applicable and well-organized solutions that have fueled success in their businesses and improved the lives of their employees. Panelists encouraged leaning on the company mission, business model & leadership as keys in shaping company culture also noting the importance of communication, education and engagement with leadership. The book Traction by Gino Wickman and the EOS management system was also referenced as helpful with leadership decisions and follow-through. Improving the employee climate was achieved by others with community involvement, employee recognition, training/support & wearables. These leaders have not only enhanced their company's overall success, they have also enriched the lives of their employees and communities.

Up next, Dawn Stastny educated us on how to Lead and Inspire a Multi-Generational Workplace, sponsored by Rader Solutions. In today's diverse workforce, one of the greatest leadership challenges is bridging the generation gap and fostering a collaborative environment where employees of all ages can thrive. With builders, boomers, Gen X, millennial, and Gen Z (and soon Gen Alpha) working side by side, it's essential for leaders to embrace diversity, leverage the unique strengths of each generation, and create a culture of inclusivity and respect. Dawn outlined what a multi-gen workforce looks like, breaking down characteristics of each generation, noting the major differences. She spoke to the benefits of such a diverse

workforce and addressed challenges that will arise based on their generational differences. By embracing diversity, you can inspire success and create a thriving multi-generational workplace where all employees feel valued, empowered, and motivated to reach their full potential.

#### Pennsylvania Lumbermens Mutual

Insurance sponsored the final session on Wednesday, where Kaiser Yang, a globally recognized innovation leader, award-winning author and CEO/co-founder of Platypus Labs, a global innovation research, consulting and training company, spoke to members about the Five Core Mindsets of Innovators. Too often, once great companies fail to adapt, fail to innovate, and then simply fail. To avoid this trap in times of massive upheaval and change, Kaiser suggests that we exploit our most powerful weapon: human creativity. He went on to say that most creative people aren't really creative, they just breakthrough barriers with the mindset that Every Barrier Can Be Eliminated. Many of us tend to overestimate the risk of making changes and are unwilling to start the process of change without having everything in place. Kaiser suggests we Put Our Old Self Out of Business, by challenging industry standards and no longer relying on models from the past. Research people and companies that have solved a problem similar to what you're dealing with and "borrow" their ideas and techniques. Seek the Unexpected by looking past your first, second or third ideas and continue to press your imagination for more creative solutions. Start Before You're Ready by testing a new idea weekly and move forward using a compass, not a detailed map. Finally, Kaiser reminded us that setbacks are normal and we may Fall Seven Times, but Stand the Eighth. Push the boundaries, shake it up, explore what's possible. Inject innovative approaches into your everyday work, and the results will be stunning!

On Thursday morning BMSA held its Annual Membership Breakfast. **Federated Insurance** sponsored the breakfast, which was open to all BMSA members, and featured a 2024 Housing Economy Forecast by Dr. Robert Dietz, Chief Economist and Senior Vice President for Economics and Housing Policy for NAHB.

Ongoing shifts in demographics, technology, and global events continue to impact trends in the housing economy. For 2024, Dr. Dietz reports the Fed will ease and interest rates will normalize and single-family home building will lead a recovery. However, availability of AD&C Loans remains tight for builders citing the cost of borrowing, amount of credit extended and lower allowable loan-to-cost ratio all as issues. Demand is expected to return but the lack of/affordability of lots, lack of manpower and building material constraints are all positioned to create supply-side issues. Navigating the economic terrane never proves to be boring.

Then it was time to reveal the new show floor! The expo hall buzzed with excitement over the new floor plan, designed to enhance the flow and optimize foot traffic with the Expo Hub at the center to foster interaction. Exhibitors and Attendees alike spoke highly of the new layout noting improved visibility and ease of navigation. As we reflect on the success of the 2024 Annual Learning Exchange & LBM Expo, we're filled with gratitude for your continued support and enthusiasm.


