The **BOMA Greater Phoenix Scholarship Program**, was established by the Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) of Greater Phoenix, a 501c6 Trade Association to provide financial education assistance to eligible applicants (*current Principal members in good standing* towards further education and the professional development of qualified professionals. BOMA Greater Phoenix does not discriminate based on race, color, national or ethnic origin, gender, disability veteran status or age in the administration of the BOMA Greater Phoenix Scholarship Program.

We look forward to helping as many deserving applicants as possible. The availability of scholarship funds is highly predicated upon the success of association events including, but not limited to our annual golf tournament and other special events. Therefore, award amounts are determined solely by the scholarship committee based on the availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY

For designation program class scholarships, all candidates must be a current Principal member in good standing* of BOMA Greater Phoenix

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted to BOMA Greater Phoenix. The scholarship committee will convene at least semi-annually to consider current applications.

- A completed and signed BOMA Great Phoenix Scholarship Application Form.
 - NEATNESS IS A CONSIDERATION.
- Essay Question answered on a separate page(s) and attached to your final application.
- Optional: a current photograph of the applicant (for publicity purposes only) in an acceptable format for print and web publishing: .jpg or .eps format, emailed to the BOMA office at olimpia@bomaphoenix.net

AWARDS

- 1. Multiple scholarships may be awarded. Scholarships will range from \$500.00 \$2,000.00 per applicant selected.
- 2. Although the intent of the BOMA Greater Phoenix Scholarship Program is to recognize outstanding nominees, should candidates rank equally in the judgment of the Selection Committee, the level of need shall be considered the final criteria.
- 3. The scholarship disbursement will be made by the BOMA Greater Phoenix office directly to BOMI International or specified institutional learning facility.
- 4. All scholarship awards will be formally announced at BOMA of Greater Phoenix Annual Awards Ceremony in November/December.



JUDGING

- 1. The Scholarship Selection Committee has the sole authority for granting the scholarship awards. The scholarship recipients are selected based on employment experience and financial need.
- 2. All applicants selected as finalists may be subject to a personal interview with representatives of the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- 3. The scholarship will be awarded without consideration of race, creed, national origin, or gender.
- 4. The Scholarship committee chairperson will:
 - a. Receive and keep secure all scholarship applications until such time as the Scholarship Committee is prepared to conduct its review.
 - b. Review applications to ensure each applicant meets the minimum standards of the application criteria.
 - c. Prepare applications that meet the minimum criteria for review by the Scholarship Committee.
- 5. The Scholarship Committee shall review the applications at a time and place determined by the Scholarship Committee chairperson.
 - a. The Committee may request further information from applicants and/or invite all or some applicants for an interview.
 - b. Information to help determine financial need may be requested during this review process.
- 6. A list of applicants selected by the Scholarship Committee for potential awarding of a scholarship will be forwarded to the Executive Committee for consideration.
 - a. The Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee (or designee) will present the recommendation to the Executive Committee.

7. Award Process

- a. A scholarship award ceremony will be planned by the Scholarship Committee in consultation with the BOMA Greater Phoenix Executive Director and Executive Committee.
- b. The Executive Director shall coordinate payments approved by the Committee with each recipient.
- c. Scholarship awards shall be made payable directly to the educational facility.

*DEFINITIONS:

-Members in good standing defined as no outstanding invoices or disciplinary issues on membership account
