Thinking about pursuing your RPA® but not sure where to begin? Below, you'll find a clear roadmap to earning your designation—including what to budget, helpful tips, and guidance to make your journey as smooth and successful as possible.

First RPA® Course (\$950)

This includes registration (\$800), Course Only Enrollment (\$100), and a Printed Manual (\$50). If you decide to continue with future courses, the \$100 Course Only Enrollment fee will act as a credit towards your \$225 RPA® Enrollment fee.

Second RPA® Course (\$975)

After getting that first class completed, now you'll officially declare RPA® Enrollment. This includes registration (\$800), RPA® Enrollment (\$225 - \$100 COE = \$125), and a Printed Manual (\$50).

Third RPA® Course + (\$850)

The rest of your courses will only include registration (\$800) and a Printed Manual (\$50). Completing your RPA® usually takes about 2-3 years depending on your schedule.

To earn your RPA®, you must complete all 7 Required Courses and 1 Elective Course. Each year, we design the course schedule around participant needs to help ensure you stay on track and reach your goals.
