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## The New Purpose of Networking



### Craving

Modern attendees desire genuine connections and fresh industry insights, not just small talk



### Intentional Networking

Attendees want a new kind of networking that is purposeful and not random or transactional



### Networking is a Priority

Over 51% of attendees said successful networking is a reason to return to an event

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## The Alignment Gap: Perception vs. Plan

- learn something new (61% of attendees) vs. 47% of organizers
- Identify contacts for idea sharing (58% of attendees) vs. 44% of organizers
- Identify potential collaboration 54% of attendees vs. 61% of organizers

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## The Serendipity Paradox: Planning for "Luck"



### Serendipity

Serendipity is not an accident, it can be planned for



### Intentional Design

Design experiences that lead to serendipitous connections

**Serendipity + Intentional Design = High Networking Value**

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## Mere Exposure: The Serendipity Accelerator

### The ROI

Leveraging mere exposure accelerates like-minded connections to win over a loyal, raving attendee who can't wait to return.

### The Challenge

Nearly 1 in 4 attendees (24%) feel anxious or skeptical when a session is explicitly labeled "networking".

### Mere Exposure

The serendipity accelerator that leads to lasting connections.

### Key Insight

Intentionally designing for increased mere exposure can create an environment conducive to meaningful interactions.

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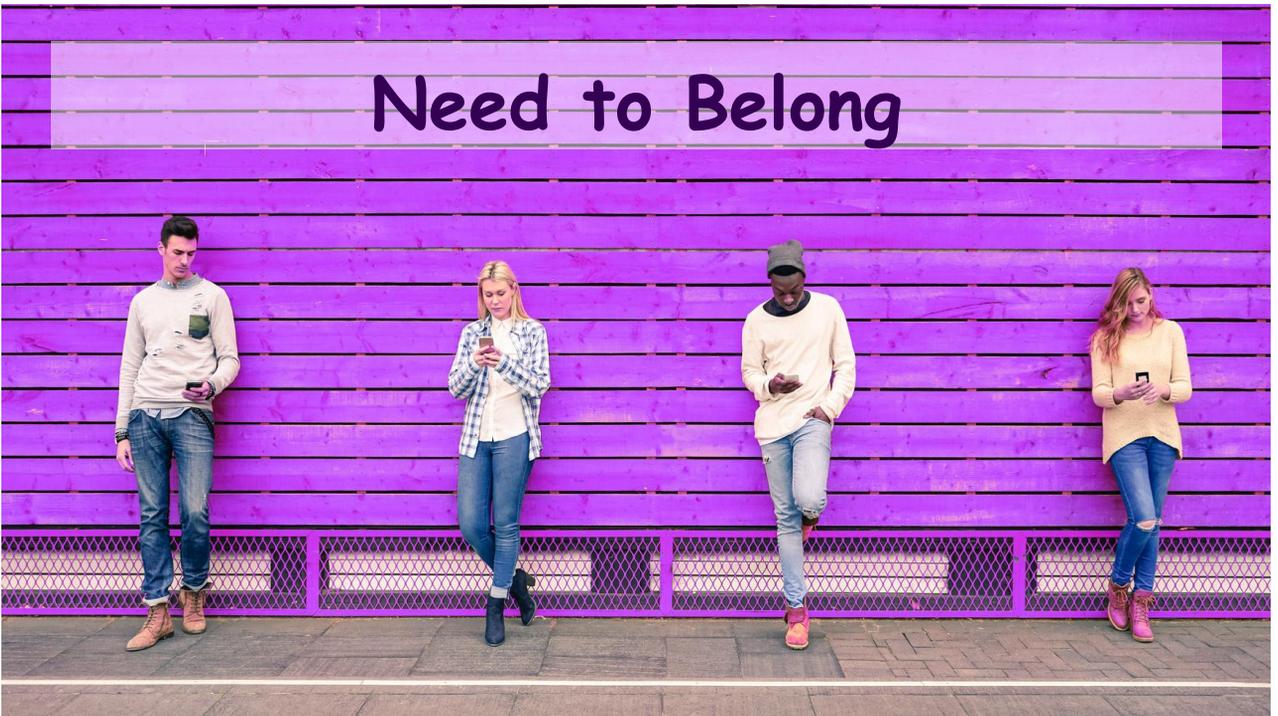

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## Attendees Don't Want Small Talk. They Want Real Talk.



### Networking anxiety

Nearly 1 in 4 attendees (24%) feel anxious or skeptical when a session is explicitly labeled 'networking'.



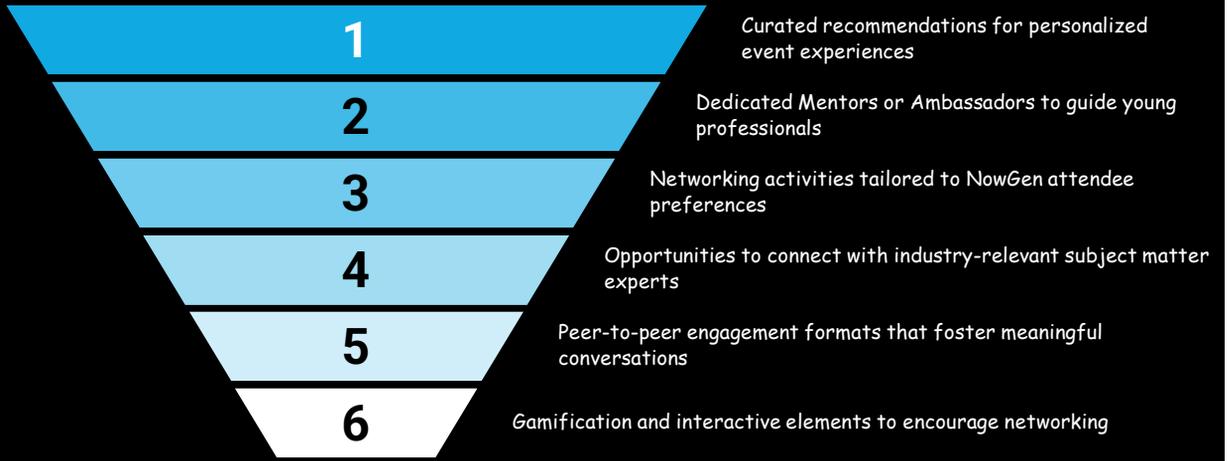
### Higher for NowGen

This anxiety is even higher for NowGen attendees (28%).

Attendees are wary of 'networking' events, preferring more purpose-driven and structured interactions that avoid superficial small talk.

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# The NowGen Imperative & Connection Conundrum



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## Purpose Multiplies Connection

### The Formula

People + Place + Provisions x PURPOSE = Connection.

### Purpose-Driven Formats

Attendees overwhelmingly prefer industry topic-specific discussions (51% of attendees). The key is providing industry-related prompts to start discussion (49%).

### The Role of Experts

Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) are the most important contributors (63%), bringing purpose, credibility, and direction beyond surface-level talk.

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## Personalize & Prime (Pre-Event)

### Opt-in Model

Use an opt-in model to connect attendees with experts and peers in advance.

### Advance Connections

Pre-event connection drives on-site momentum and accelerates meaningful interactions.

### Curated Recommendations

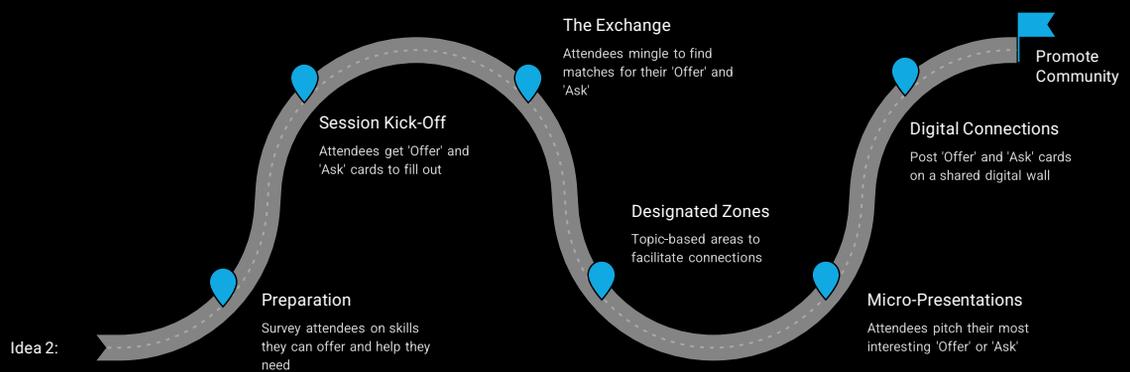
Provide curated recommendations for attendees to connect with relevant experts and peers.

### Mentor/Ambassador

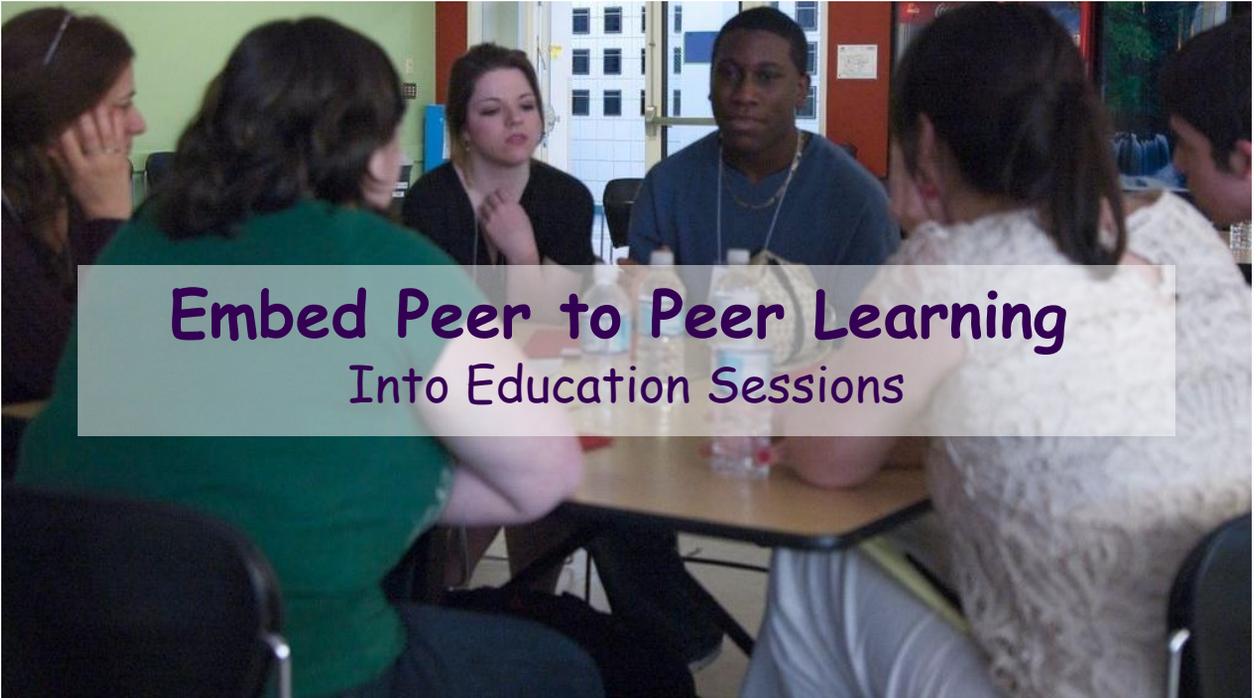
Assign a Mentor or Ambassador to help attendees, especially the NowGen segment, navigate and connect.

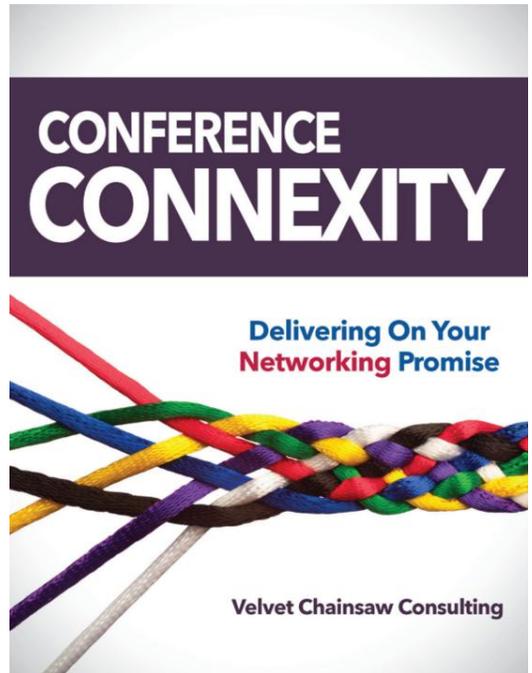
