River City Food Bank's (RCFB) mission is to alleviate hunger in Sacramento County by providing consistent access to healthy, meaningful food for all.

RCFB helps people avoid a crisis and work toward self-reliance by providing a short-term food supply when they are unable to meet basic living expenses. Our programs serve low-income families, children, seniors, individuals who are medically fragile, refugees/asylum-seekers, individuals experiencing homelessness, the working poor and individuals with disabilities. RCFB serves all people experiencing food insecurity regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, age and background in Sacramento County (no zip code restrictions). In 2023, RCFB provided more than 3 million pounds of healthy, meaningful food to 308,005 people in Sacramento County.
