





The Measure	The Meaning
A Customer Service Culture	Do we operate in a culture of "How Can I Help You?" We are community of members who understand and respond to the needs of our community members.
Alignment of Products and Services with Mission	Do Our Actions Clearly Illustrate Our Purpose and Intentions? We are driven by a common commitment to purposeful and defined service to our members and society.

The Measure	The Meaning		
Data-Driven Strategies	Do The Numbers Matter? Our decisions rest on a foundation of objective information leveraged by personal experience and opinion.		
Dialogue and Engagement	Do We Talk AT People or Talk WITH People? The facilitation of community conversation results in a sense of ownership in the organization and a sense of belongingness in the decision-making processes.		
The CEO as Broker of Ideas	Is Visionary Thinking Facilitated or Dictated? Leadership is a distinct responsibility from management as one oversees the day-to-day while the other builds equity and enthusiasm for the future.
