General Information

Open Submission Deadline: 11:59 p.m. CST, Jan. 31, 2024. **Extension Submission Deadline**: 11:59 a.m. CST, Feb. 7, 2024.

- All entries require:
 - Entry information and book cover image submitted through the online application.
 - Books must be shipped to the CMA Office.
 - Each submission requires two copies of the book mailed to the CMA office. If you are submitting a series, you must send in two copies of each volume.
- Fee per entry:
 - \$79 per entry for non-members
 - \$89 per entry for non-members (extension period)
 - \$38 per entry for CMA members
 - \$48 per entry for CMA members (extension period)
- All entries must be published in the calendar year 2023 except categories labeled MULTI-YEAR.
- Entries must be published within the U.S. or Canada except for the international division.
- All members must be in good standing as of March 31, 2024.
- All Books must be received by Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.
- Payment deadline is Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.
- There is no limit to the number of categories into which a single book may be entered.
- **Two** hard copies of **EACH** entry must be sent to the CMA office for judging.
 - Please note that this applies to each category a submission is entered.
 - Example: If submitting the same book into three different categories, send six copies (2 copies x 3 categories = 6 copies).
- All submitted hard copies will not be returned to the entrant after the program completes as they are used for judging.
- If you are entering a multi-year category, your entries must not have won in a previous Awards season.

Judging

Book judges include editors, authors, academics, and professionals familiar with Catholic publishing.



Eligibility Requirements

The CMA Book Awards recognizes the achievement of publishers and authors of related Catholic works. The following are eligibility requirements for entries to the CMA Book Awards:

- 1) You do not have to be a CMA member to enter into the Book Awards.
- 2) Entries may either be from a publishing organization, author or editor of a book. Publishers may submit any book that they have published that meets the requirements. Authors may submit their own original work or work that they co-authored that meets the requirements. Editors may submit their own compilations or reference materials that meet the requirements. Copy editors and translators are not eligible.
- 3) Neither the author nor the publishing company need to be Catholic to submit work.
- 4) Work submitted must be supportive of the teachings of the Catholic Church and may not contradict or stand opposed to the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- 5) Entries must be the original work that is appropriately credited. Any entries that are plagiarized or incorrectly credited will be disqualified.
- 6) All entries must be published in the calendar year 2023 except categories labeled MULTI-YEAR.
- 7) Entries must be published within the U.S. or Canada except for the International division.
- 8) Submitters must follow all Catholic Book Awards rules regarding deadlines, submission instructions, and payment for their entries to be considered.
- 9) CMA members receive the member rate of \$36 per entry. Publishers must be General Publisher Members and individual authors or editors must be either Freelance or Affiliate Members of the CMA to qualify for the member rate. Non-member entry fee is \$79.

Reasons for Disqualification

- Too few submissions in a single category: Every category requires at least two submissions total
 in order to be evaluated. Any category that has only one submission will be pulled from the
 competition. In this case, the submitter will be refunded their submission fee. You will be notified of
 this refund via email.
- Entry does not meet submission requirements: In order for judges to evaluate your submissions, entries must include all required components and they must be submitted properly. Please check the category descriptions to make sure your entries are correct.

Categories & Descriptions

Please note new categories are marked **NEW** and updated Categories are marked **UPDATED.**

Church Life

B101: Pilgrimages/Catholic Travel

This category is for books about taking a pilgrimage, pilgrimage sites, or sites of special interest to Catholics.

B102: Pope Francis

This category is for books about his life, travels, or teachings. Submissions may also include books that include his writings.

B103: Spirituality Classical

This category is for books on spiritual life and practice: meditation, Christian life, etc. Please submit books about prayer or books that are collections of prayers to **B106.**

B104: Spirituality Contemporary

This category is for books on spiritual life and practice including topics such as meditation, Christian life, etc. Please submit books about prayer or books that are collections of prayers to **B106.**

B105: Prayer Books

This category is for books about prayers.

B106: Collections of Prayers

This category is for book collections of Catholic prayers.

B107: Mysticism

This category is for books about treating Christian mysticism from a "how to" perspective or through the examples of the classic Christian mystics.

B108: Liturgy

This category is for books on the celebration of the Eucharist, Sacraments, or Preaching.

B109: Pastoral Ministry - Parish Life

bThis category is for books on parish life and ministries within the parish setting including the following topics: Marriage, Family life, Marriage Preparation, Social Concerns, Outreach, Peace and Justice initiatives, Aging, or Counseling. This may include homebound circumstances, hospital and nursing home, or healing and grieving.



B110: Pastoral Ministry Catechetical

This category is for books about Pastoral ministry Catechetical themes. submissions in this category include topics such as faith formation, religious education, RCIA, adult and continuing education, CCD, textbooks, newest volume in a series, workbooks, manual and supplementary books used in classroom or group or individual faith development, providing an understanding of the Church's teachings and practices.

B111: Pastoral Ministry: Youth & Young Adult

This category is for books on topics such as youth and young adult ministry. Some examples may include teachings, journey of ministry, and life as a youth minister.

B112: Church Professional

This category is for Church Professional books. Books in this category provide knowledge and professional growth for those involved directly in Church ministry and Church-related work. This category includes deacons as working church professionals.

B151: Newly Canonized Saints or those in the Process MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books covering topics such as saints canonized or in the process of canonization within the past ten years. Submissions should be published between 2018 and 2023.

Education

B201: Popular Presentation of the Catholic Faith

This category is for books suitable for a broad Catholic audience that present a particular aspect or a summary review of Catholic faith, life, history, the Bible, Apologetics, etc.

B202: Theological and Philosophical Studies

This category is for books about general theological and philosophical studies.

B203: History of Theology, Church Fathers and Mothers

This category is for books that include topics on the history of theology or Church Fathers and Mothers.

B204: Morality, Ethics, Christology, Mariology, Redemption, etc.

This category is for books that include topics on morality, ethics, Christology, Mariology, redemption, etc.

B205: Scripture - Popular Studies

This category is for books on popular Scripture studies. For series, please enter B1654.



B206: Scripture - Academic Studies

This category is for books on academic Biblical Studies. For series, please enter B1654.

B207: History

This category is for books providing brief or extended historical studies of Catholic eras, movements, or events.

B208: Biography

This category is for biographies of persons that include Catholic context.

B209: Reference/Academic Studies

UPDATED

This category is for books providing in-depth resources for church professionals in dictionaries, almanacs, encyclopedias, or other formats. An example might be a book suited for the professional's library.

B210: Faith and Science

This category is for books that encourage and enhance the respectful and constructive conversation between science and faith.

B211: Faith Formation

UPDATED

This category, also known as religious education, includes any book meant for systematic education in the Catholic faith within a catechetical context. Historical educators of the Catholic faith may be entered here. Please note, this category excludes lesson plans.

B212: Jesus - Christology

This category includes Jesus in any aspect. Some subject matters may include Jesus as a savior, Jesus as a historical figure, and His journey through His life.

B213: Sacraments

This category is for books about one or more of the seven sacraments (Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, and Anointing of the Sick).



Family Life

B301: Children's Book Non-Reader

NEW

This category is for books for children that have a Catholic faith context. Ages 0-5. For series, please enter B1652.

B302: Children's Book Reader

NEW

This category is for books for children that have a Catholic faith context. Ages 6-11. If your work is targeted for teens, please enter B351. For series, please enter B1652.

B303: All Children's Books

NEW

This category is for books for children that have a Catholic faith context. Ages 0-11. For series, please enter B1652.

B304: Family Life

This category is for books on any aspect of family life, parenting, or grandparenting that have a faith context.

B305: The Sacrament of Marriage

This category is for books on any aspect of marital relationships, explanation of Church teachings on the sacrament of marriage.

B351: Book for Young Adults (Ages 12-18)

NEW/MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books for young adults that have a Catholic faith context. Submissions should be published between 2018 and 2023. For series, please enter B1653.

Lifestyle

B401: Coffee Table Poetry Book

UPDATED

This category is for coffee table poetry books. A "coffee table book" is a book that is intended to sit on a coffee table or similar surface in an area where guests sit and are entertained. Pages consist mainly of photographs and illustrations with brief text. All submissions in this category require Christian or Catholic context.

B402: Coffee Table Art Book

UPDATED

This category is for coffee table art books. A "coffee table book" is a book that is intended to sit on a coffee table or similar surface in an area where guests sit and are entertained. Pages consist mainly of photographs and illustrations with brief text. All submissions in this category require a Christian or Catholic context.



B451: Cookbooks NEW/MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books that are a collection of recipes for food or drinks, etc. from a Catholic perspective. Books should be published anytime between 2018-2023.

B452: Lifestyle Books NEW/MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books that discuss or portray any lifestyle topics including but not limited to the following topics: gardening, healthy living, decoration and home decor, minimalism, etc. Books should be published anytime between 2018-2023.

Social Issues

B501: Inclusion in the Church

This category is for books that address diversity, equity, inclusion, disability, gender issues, women in the Church, and multicultural engagement.

B502: Catholic Social Teaching

This category is for books that engage contemporary social justice concerns within the context of faith and the gospel in contemporary society. This category includes environmental issues.

B503: Religion in the Public Square

UPDATED

This category is for books that discuss contemporary political issues from a faith perspective.

B504: Immigration

This category is for books that discuss Immigration issues and reform in the light of Catholic social teaching.

B505: Ecumenism or Interfaith Relations

This category is for books about ecumenism or interfaith relations. Some examples of this might include: Our God Is the Same, Seeking Unity with the Church of the East, and Catholic Teachings on other Faiths.

B506: The Future of the Church

This category represents books dealing with discussions regarding the future of the Catholic Church, the issues the future Church faces, and how Catholics will be affected by these changes.

B507: Life and Dignity of the Human Person

UPDATED

This category is for books that include any of the subjects included in the consistent ethic of life: life of the unborn, death penalty, nuclear arms, euthanasia, sexual abuse, child abuse, and elder abuse.



Individual Excellence Awards

B601: First Time Author: Children's Book

This category is for first-book authors on children's books of theological interest.

B602: First Time Author: Novel

This category highlights first-book authors for novels of theological interest.

B603: First Time Author: Biography

This category recognizes first-book authors of biographies of theological interest.

B604: First Time Author: Poetry, Essays, or Short Stories

This category is for Poetry, essays, or short stories by a first time author. Submissions in this category include first-book authors of essays, poetry, and short stories of theological interest.

B605: First Time Author of Theological Subject Matters

This category recognizes the first-book authors on any topic of theological interest.

B606: Author of the Year

This category recognizes an individual's writing and exemplary service to the Catholic community. The author's work may be produced by different publishers, including self-publishing, but at least one book must be published by a commercial publisher. Entry samples can be of any subject matter. Judging will focus on demonstrated talent, creativity, thoroughness, and effectiveness.

An entry consists of **three to five** books that showcase the author's writing. You may also submit a PDF file or a Word Document listing URLs if the samples are available online.

A letter may be submitted to explain circumstances that made the individual's success notable. The letter should focus on how the author's work contributes to the Catholic community. One or more books may have previously won a book award for its single entry. All books submitted must be published in English between 2018 and 2023. At least one book must be published in 2023.

B607: Self-Published Author of the Year

This category recognizes an individual's writing and exemplary service to the Catholic community. Entry samples can be of any subject matter, but all books must be self-published. Judging will focus on demonstrated talent, creativity, thoroughness, and effectiveness.

An entry consists of **three to five** books that showcase the author's writing. You may also submit a PDF file or a Word Document listing URLs if the samples are available online.

A letter may be submitted to explain circumstances that made the individual's success notable. The letter should focus on how the author's work contributes to the Catholic community. One or more books may have previously won a book award for their single entry. All books submitted must be published in English between 2018 and 2023. At least one book must be published in 2023.



Catalog/Reference

B701: Diocesan Directory

This category is for a diocesan directory. Judges will look at the perspective of content, organization, design, and accessibility.

B702: Catalog

This category is for the best example of a complete, trade, or seasonal announcement catalog.

Novels

B801: Catholic Novel

This category is for books whose underlying theme involves Catholic faith, Catholic imagination, the Catholic story, the power of grace, the struggles of life on all levels, the gifts of the Spirit, and God's closeness in the struggles of faith, in times of loss and sadness, and in times of joy.

B802: Faith-Based Novel

This category is for books whose underlying theme involves faith, imagination, the faith-based story, the power of grace, the struggles of life on all levels, the gifts of the Spirit, and God's closeness in the struggles of faith, in times of loss and sadness, and in times of joy.

Grief/Self-Help

B901: Healing and Self Help

This category is for books that provide readers with understanding, support, and practical help. The book may be intended for the reader (and/or someone the reader knows, loves, or supports) who are encountering pain, illness, and suffering. More specifically, subjects might include broken relationships, aging, dying, depression, cancer, loneliness, self-care, etc. The book will emphasize physical and emotional help, with special emphasis on spirituality. Please enter books on Grief and Bereavement in category B902.

B902: Grief and Bereavement

This category is for books that provide understanding, support, and practical help. The book may be intended for the reader (and/or someone the reader knows, loves, or supports) who is encountering pain or bereavement. The book will emphasize physical and emotional help, with special emphasis on spirituality.

International/In Translation



B1101: International Publication: Novel or Short Stories

This category is for books that are published in English outside of the U.S. and Canada. This category is for international novels and short stories from a Catholic faith perspective.

B1102: International Publication: Poetry

This category is for books that are published in English outside of the U.S. and Canada. This category is for international poetry from a Catholic faith perspective.

B1103: International Publication: General Theological Subject Matter

This category is for books that are published in English outside of the U.S. and Canada. Submissions in this category are international works on general theological subjects from a theological perspective.

B1104: International Publication: Biography

This category is for books that are published in English outside of the U.S. and Canada. Submissions in this category include biographies from a Catholic perspective.

B1151: English Translation Edition

MULTI-YEAR

This category represents translated work from non-English publications. There is no required original publication date parameter, but the book must be published in English between 2018 and 2023. Books may have multiple authors. The book must be a full translation of a previously published book where the original format is in another language. Only English-translated edition copies are required as hard copies.

Design/Production

B1201: Design and Production

This category is for books that exhibit quality of design and total packaging including design from cover to cover, layout, format, typeface, white space, and graphics. The designer/artist will receive the award for their work. Please enter their name(s) under the bylines section of the submission form. Judges will not consider book content.

B1202: Design and Production: Children's Book

NEW

This category is for books that exhibit a quality of design and total packaging including, design from cover to cover, layout, format, typeface, white space, and graphics. The designer/artist will receive the award for their work. Please enter their name(s) under the bylines section of the submission form. Judges will not consider book content.



B1203: Front Cover Artwork

This category is for Best book cover artwork. This category still requires hard copies of books so judges can look at content if needed to help judge. A PDF file of the artwork must be uploaded on the submission form.

Small Publisher

B1301: Best Book by a Small Publisher

This category is for a book produced by a publisher with gross sales under \$500,000 per year. Books in this category can be on any topic of theological interest.

Self Publisher

B1401: Self-Published Fiction Books

UPDATED

This category is for a self published fiction book. This category recognizes books that are produced by a self-published author with gross sales under \$500,000 per year, on any topic of Catholic interest. This category includes teen fiction (ages 12-18).

B1402: Self-Published Non-Fiction Books

UPDATED

This category is for a self published non-fiction book. This category recognizes books that are produced by a self-published author with gross sales under \$500,000 per year, on any topic of theological interest.

B1403: Self-Published Children's Books

UPDATED

This category is for a self published children's book. This category recognizes books that are produced by a self-published author with gross sales under \$500,000 per year, on any topic of theological interest. This category includes books intended for ages (0-11).

B1451: Best Book Published by a Diocese

NEW/MULTI-YEAR

This category is for a book specifically published by a diocese. Entry types include:historical reference guides, diocesan directories, cookbooks, etc. Books should be published anytime between 2018-2023.

B1452: Best Book Published by a Parish

NEW/MULTI-YEAR

This category recognizes books that are published by a parish include historical reference guides, parish directories, cookbooks, etc. Books should be published anytime between 2018-2023.



Special Collections

B1501: Anthology

This category includes books on collections of stories or essays in one book. The collection must not exceed 500 pages. A collection of stories and essays can be from one or more authors.

B1502: Memoir UPDATED

This category is for a book that represents first-person accounts of conversion, formation, spiritual growth dealing with a crisis, or reversion to faith in a theological context.

B1551: Poetry MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books of poetry and poetry anthologies from a theological perspective. Books should be published anytime between 2018-2023.

B1552: Backlist Beauty

MULTI-YEAR

This category is for books that are still actively published on any topic under Catholic interest. Books must be newly published between 2018 and 2023. Cumulative sales of the title may not exceed 50,000 copies.

Series

B1651: Religious Book Series

SERIES

This category is for best religious book series. Best religious book series is a set of books with at least **one** or more volumes published in 2023. Book series may be of any religious theme. Series may have more than one author. One or more books may have previously won a book award for its single entry.

- If your series is more than three volumes, please send the most recent three books.
- Send two sets of hard copies for judging. These three must be consecutive. One of these three must be the book published in 2023.
- Book must not have received a prior CMA Book Award or Honorable Mention for a series submission.

B1652: Children's Book Series

SERIES

This category is for best children's book series. Best children's book series is a set of books with at least **one** or more volumes published in 2023. Book series may be of any subject matter. Series may have more than one author. One or more books may have previously won a book award for its single entry.

If your series is more than three volumes, please send the most recent three books.



- Send two sets of hard copies for judging. These three must be consecutive. One of these three must be the book published in 2023.
- Book must not have received a prior CMA Book Award or Honorable Mention for a series submission.

B1653: Young Adult Book Series

SERIES

This category is for best young adult book series. Best young adult book series is a set of books with at least **one** or more volumes published in 2023. Series may be of any subject matter of Catholic interest. Series may have more than one author. One or more books may have previously won a book award for its single entry.

- If your series is more than three volumes, please send the most recent three books.
- Send two sets of hard copies for judging. These three must be consecutive. One of these three must be the book published in 2023.
- Book must not have received a prior CMA Book Award or Honorable Mention for a series submission.

B1654: Scripture - Series

NEW/SERIES

This category is for books on scripture that are a part of a series. This category series is a set of books with at least **one** or more volumes published in 2023. Series may have more than one author. One or more books may have previously won a book award for its single entry. If your series is more than three volumes, please send the most recent three books.

- Send two sets of hard copies for judging. These three must be consecutive. One of these three must be the book published in 2023.
- Book must not have received a previous award for a series submission.



Submission Instructions

Getting Started

All entries are submitted digitally through the <u>website</u> on the book awards page, under the awards tab. Please read category descriptions to determine submission requirements for each category. If you have questions about eligibility, submissions, or payment, please visit our <u>website</u> then click book awards under the awards tab. If you need further assistance, please email the awards team at Awards@CatholicMediaAssociation.org.

Please Note

- · All entries include two copies of the book sent to the CMA office.
- · Please include all contributing authors/editors in your submission.
- · There is no limit to the number of entries in any category.

Creating a Profile

Entries are made through our <u>website</u>. The website allows you to view categories, make submissions, and pay for submissions in the same place.

Returning entrants can use the same login information they used last year. To create a new profile, click "Enter the CMA Book Awards" on the homepage and follow prompts to create a username and password for your account. For simplicity's sake, we recommend creating **one account** for your organization.

Creating a New Submission

- 1. Either create your account or log into your existing account.
- 2. Click "Make Another Application" then "Enter CMA Book Awards." You will be prompted to review your past submissions or to begin a new submission.
- 3. Select "Click here to begin a new submission." Fill out the form as prompted and click "Save and Next" to continue. You can return to the previous form at any time.
- 4. At the end of the form, you have a few options:
 - a. Clicking "Save" and leaving the form saves your submission as "Incomplete." You can return to the entry later, edit data, and complete the entry.
 - b. Clicking "Add To Cart" saves your data and puts your submission in your cart. You can return to the entry later and pay for it, edit the data, or remove it from your cart. Entries are marked "Complete" after you pay for them. Once an entry is marked "Complete," you cannot edit it. We recommend keeping submissions in your cart until you have created all of your entries and checked that they are correct. Doing so will help prevent duplicate, missing, and incorrect entries.
- 5. You can view submissions that are incomplete, in your cart, and complete by clicking "My



Applications." To edit submissions that are incomplete, click the "Edit" button in the action column. For entries in your cart, click "Make Changes."

6. To save time, you may duplicate your submission form. Once the entry is duplicated it copies all information. Then you only need to select a new category AND make sure all files needed are appropriately updated.

Hard Copy Materials

You must send **two copies** of each book per submission for judging purposes. If you enter into the series categories two copies of the series need to be sent for judging purposes. To ensure that your submissions are ready for judging:

- Provide clean material with no marks or highlighting on the submission.
- You must label your hard copy materials for easy identification (See LABELING ENTRIES).
- All submitted hard copies will not be returned to the entrant after the program is completed as they are used for judging.
- Hard copies must be <u>received</u> by Friday, February 9, 2024, to be considered. Please keep current shipping delays in consideration when shipping out through postal service and distribution centers.
- Example: If submitting the same book into three different categories, send six copies (2 copies x 3 categories = 6 copies).

Labeling Entries

We must know from where the entries are coming and what invoice. You must label each hard copy submission so that judges can identify them. To label your entries:

• Print the labels on the last page of the packet. Fill out all information, cut out labels, and affix labels to **each** of the hard copy submissions.

Affix a label to the outside cover (front) of every book. Books without labels will be disqualified.

• If hard copies are being sent directly from the distribution center, please email awards@catholicmediaassociation.org a PDF file of the labels so we may add them to your books once they arrive. We must know where the entries are coming from, and what invoice they are from so we can identify them correctly.

Shipping

In order to help with processing, please:

- Keep individual boxes to no more than 25 lbs.
- · Mark the outside of box with **Box 1 of** # being sent, and so on.
- · If paying by check, include printed invoice and payment in Box 1.
- Delivery confirmation may have to be done through your carrier's tracking service.
- · Email Awards@CatholicMediaAssociation.org with any questions.
