STAYING ON-CAMPUS

Amenities: Each guest will get one linen packet placed in their room. pillow, pillowcase, top & bottom sheet, blanket, 2 bath towels, 2 hand towels, 2 wash cloths, bar of soap.

Keys: Each guest will get two key cards or keys. One for the building entrance and one for their room. All doors automatically lock, so whenever you leave your room, you need your key card to get back in.

There is a fee for any lost cards or keys.

EARLY ARRIVALS:

Meal plans begin with Saturday dinner. Walsh University has several local eateries within walking distance of the campus. There is a Starbucks, Giant Eagle supermarket, Walgreens, and some fast food services on East Maple Street opposite of the Walsh University campus.
