

SCU COVID POLICY - CONFERENCE SERVICES

The following COVID-19 policy will be in effect for all Conference programs residential and commuter. With information about Covid-19 constantly changing, current policies may be revised at any time, based on the changes directed by the Santa Clara University, County, State and Federal governments.

All groups

- All guests to the University need to be up-to-date with COVID19 vaccinations in order to participate in the Santa Clara University Conference Services program; please refer to the [CDC COVID19 vaccination guidelines](#) for additional information.
- Groups are required to confirm that they have received proof of vaccination of all attendees, 72 hours prior to coming on to campus.
- Masks recommended but not required.
- Registration will be done in each individual Residential space by the Conference planner/onsite contact

Youth Group

- Staggered registration allow for minimal contact with others
- 1 parent can assist the student during registration and move in
- All registration will be done in the Groups resident hall, unless previous arrangements have been made.
- Accommodations and meeting spaces will be cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival.
 - Note that custodial, conference employees, and facilities will not enter your room while it is in use, unless necessary to do so.
 - Facilities will enter the room if a request is made to fix any emergency issues.
- Refrain from gathering in the main lobby of the building - please congregate outdoors as much as possible.
- Finally, if you attend and test positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of attending, please report this to the University by emailing covid19@scu.edu.
