

Accessing CBQ Online

- 2. Once logged in, you will be at your Member Compass™.
 - a. On your Member Compass, click on "PUBLICATIONS" on the navigation toolbar to reveal the drop-down menu (see screenshot below).
 - b. In the drop-down menu, click on "CBQ-Online (Members Only)" (see screenshot below).



3. You will be brought to the CBQ-Online access page. Click on the image of CBQ (see screen shot below).

4. You will be brought to the Atla Serials database of *The Catholic Biblical Quarterly*.

This permits you access to pdf versions of the CBQ articles and book reviews from 1939 to the present.

- a. At the far right, click on the plus sign (+) next to the year you wish to access. This will reveal a drop-down menu for each of the issues published that year (see screen shot below).

5. You will be brought to the list of pdf versions of the articles and book reviews, appearing in the order that they appear in the journal.

- a. At the far right, use the scroll bar to navigate up and down the page (see screen shot below).
- b. At the bottom of the page, click on "Next" to go to the next page of articles/book reviews (see screen shot below).
- c. Click on "PDF Full Text" for any article/book review you wish to access (see screen shot below).

6. You will be brought to the ON SCREEN pdf version of the item you selected. You may use the scroll bar to scroll down to the next page.

- a. Placing your cursor near the top of the screen will reveal the toolbar with icons for REFRESH (circular arrow);
 DOWNLOAD (downward arrow); and PRINT (printer).
- b. Toward the bottom of the page on the right, your cursor will reveal icons to ENLARGE (plus sign) or DECREAST (minus sign) the image ON SCREEN (see screen shot below).
- c. On the left side, there is a menu you may use to navigate within the issue, thus accessing other articles/book reviews (see screen shot below).
