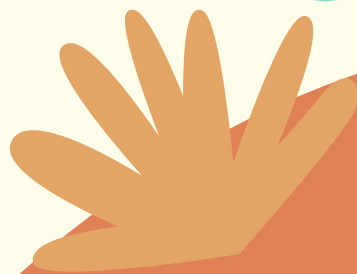

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ABCD ROCKIN' MY TEACHER ERA MUG

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Large mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes
Blue painters tape
Toothbrush or splatter tool



Glaze Paint Colors

Red, Deep Orange, Bright Yellow, Dark Pink, Green, Blue, Gray
Writer bottle: Black

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the letter A with 3 coats of Red.
3. Paint the letter B with 3 coats of Deep Orange.
4. Paint the pencil lightning bolt with 3 coats of Bright Yellow.
5. Paint the pencil eraser Dark Pink.
6. Paint the letter C with 3 coats of Green.
7. Paint the letter D with 3 coats of Blue.
8. Paint the metal spacer on pencil with 2 coats of Gray.
9. With a liner brush or writer bottle, outline the entire design in Black. Let dry.
10. Once dry, lightly tape tissue paper just over the painted design area.
11. Dip toothbrush or splatter tool in water and then into one of the glaze colors and splatter on the mug. Repeat the splatter for each paint color plus Black.
12. Fill in the letters along the bottom with a Black writer bottle. Let dry.
13. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

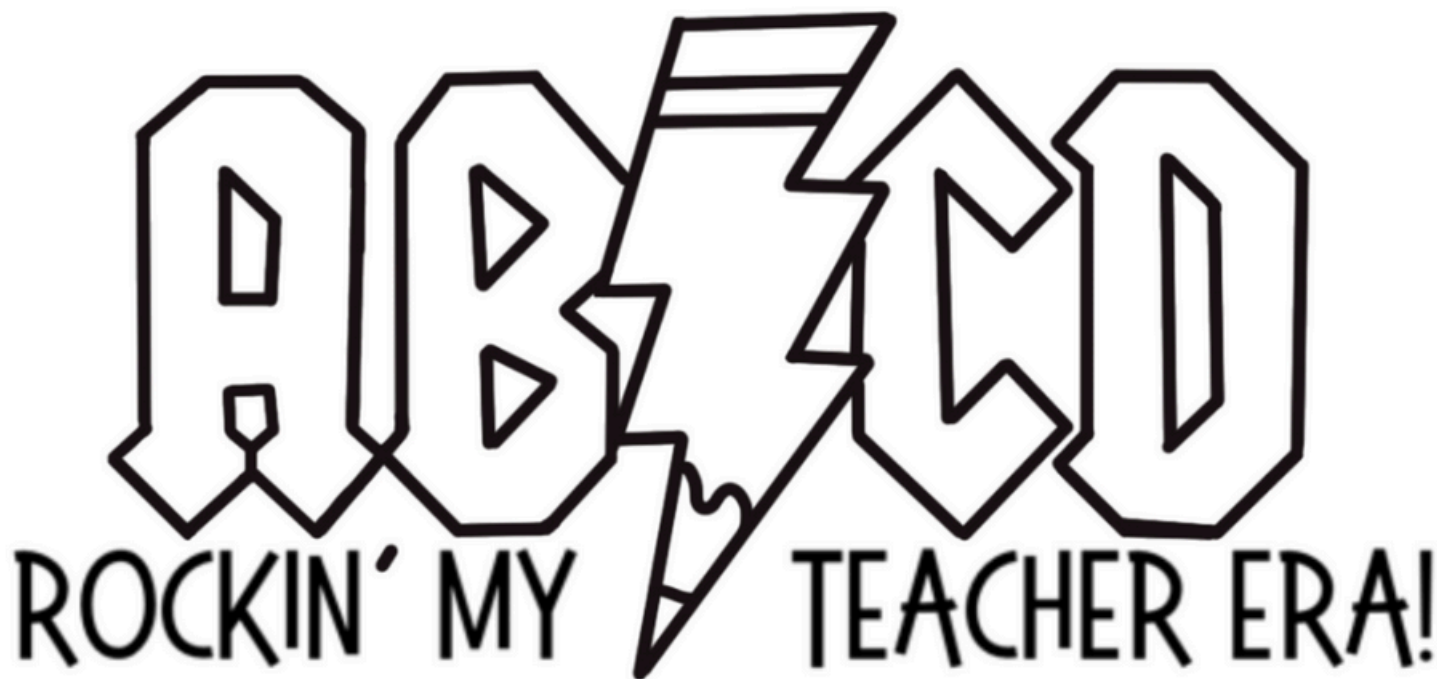

BEWARE OF MUMSTERS CHARGER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Tracing paper
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

White, Black, Red, Pink
Writer bottles: Red, Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the entire plate with 1 solid coat of White. Let dry.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the lettering with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the lettering with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Having the lettering traced on the plate will help determine placement of the handprint in the next step.
3. Paint the person's hand with a solid coat of Black. Press the painted hand onto the plate to make a handprint centered inside the traced lettering.
4. Tear some tracing paper into thin strips about ½" wide or less. You'll need about 10 strips.
5. Paint each strip of paper one at a time with a heavy coat of White. Press the paper pieces painted side down over the handprint, placing them at various angles and slightly overlapping in some areas. Leave a small area open in center of palm for the mouth to be painted. Once all the papers are applied, be sure to tap and smooth each one to remove any air pockets. At that point, all the papers can be removed.
6. With the pencil, lightly draw two large circles for the eyes and a mouth shape on the handprint.
7. Fill in the eyes with a White writer bottle.
8. Paint the mouth shape with 2 coats of Red for the upper portion and 2 coats of Pink for the lower portion.
9. Fill in the lettering with a Red writer bottle.
10. With a Black writer bottle, add pupils to the eyes and make dots in a random pattern on the background of the plate. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Light Orange, Deep Orange, Purple, Light Gray, Black
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the center teeth with 3 coats of Light Orange.
3. Paint the fangs with 3 coats of Deep Orange.
4. Paint the lips with 3 coats of Purple.
5. Paint the inside of the mouth with 3 coats of Light Gray.
6. Paint the remaining background space with 3 coats of Black.
7. Outline the details of the design and make the lettering with a Black writer bottle. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

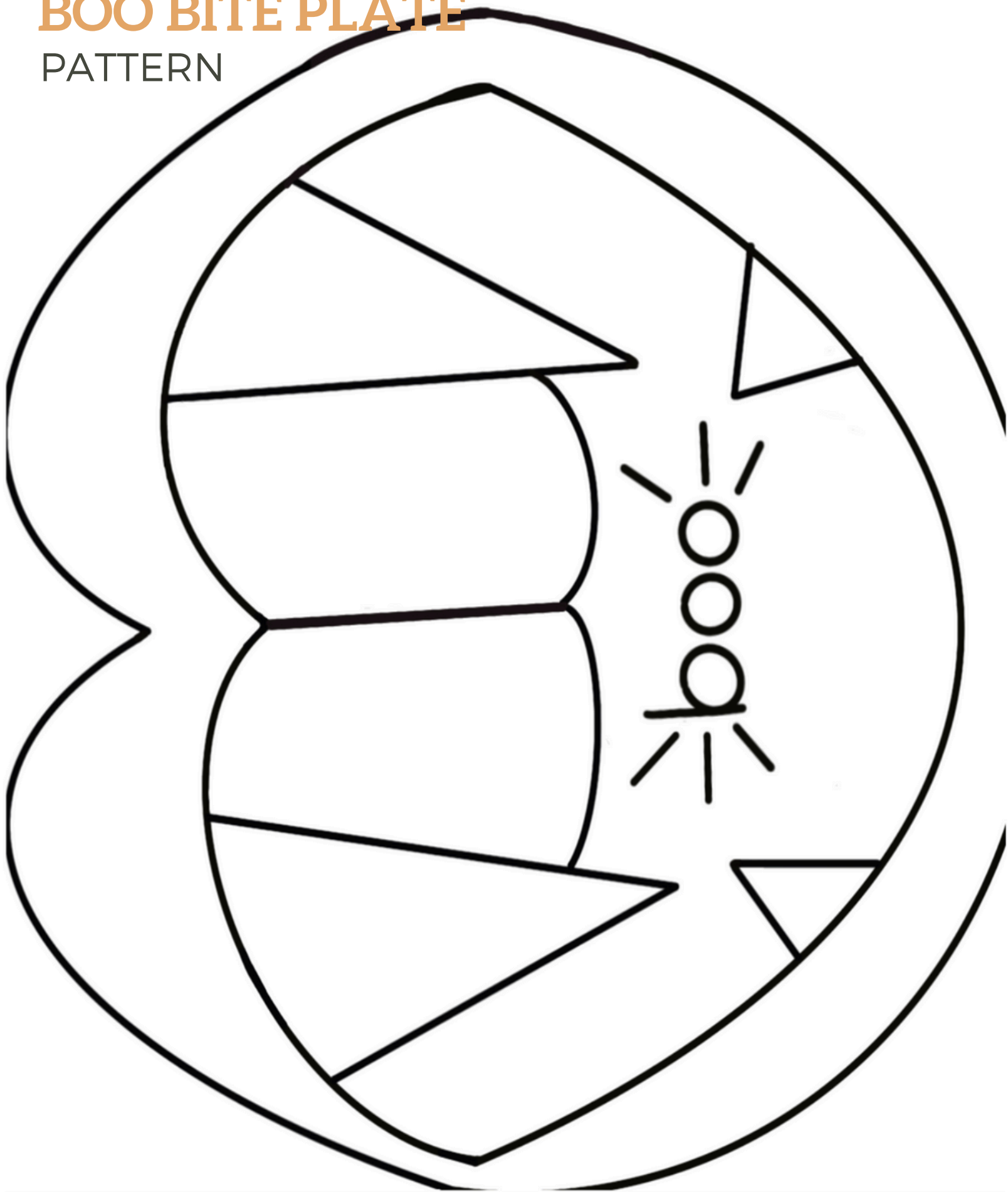

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Large mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Taupe, Cream, Black
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint all the petals with 3 coats of Taupe.
3. Paint the flower centers with 3 coats of Cream.
4. Paint the dots in the centers with 3 coats of Black.
5. With a Black writer bottle, make a line design on the mug handle. Leave a space between each line and add a Taupe paint dot in between the lines. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

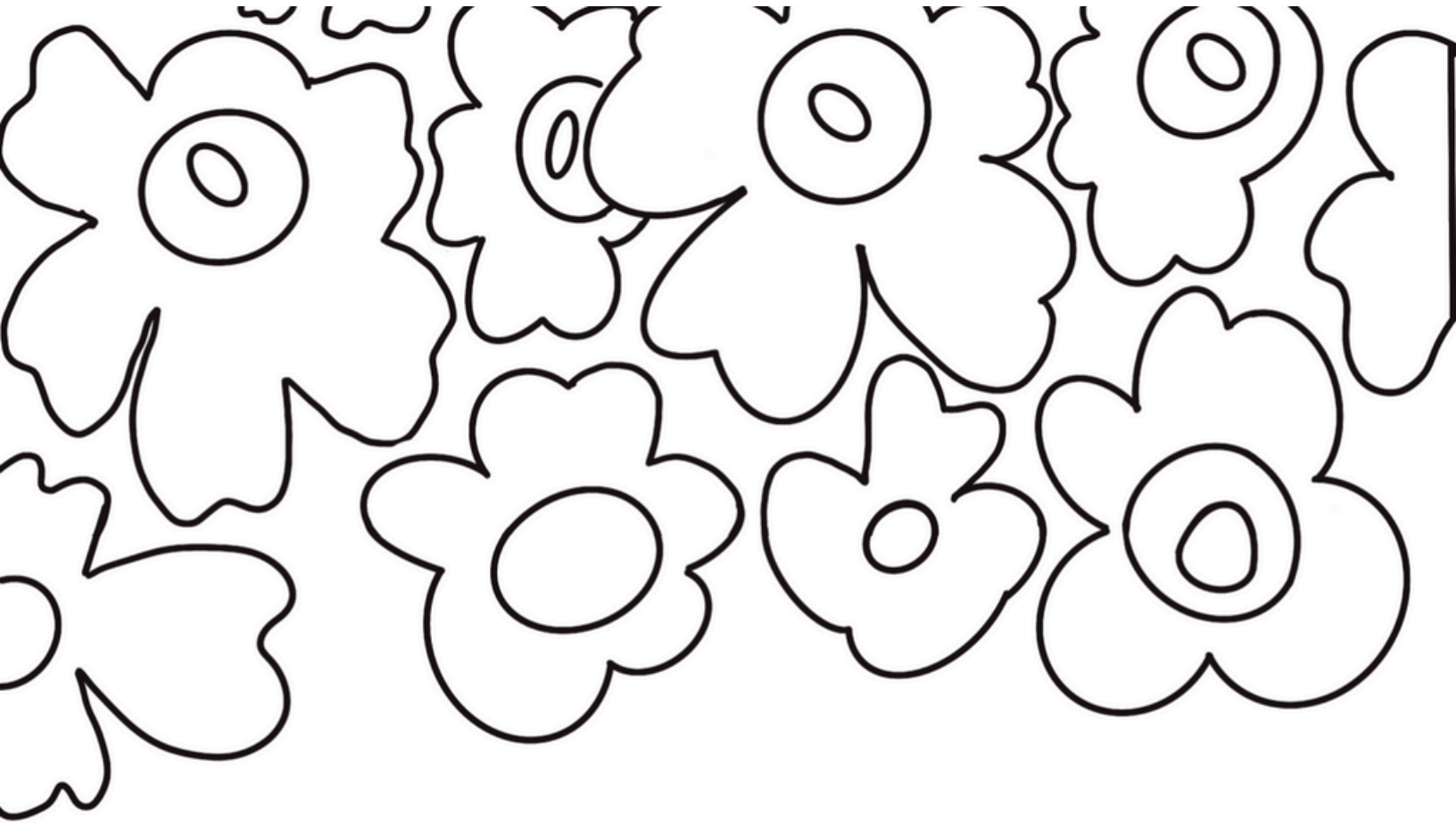

This project also lends itself easily to a mug or a plate.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Utensil holder
Pattern
Tissue paper
Stencil sticker or contact paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Scissors
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Salmon Pink, Bright Orange, White
Writer bottles: Black, White



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the stencil sticker or contact paper and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Cut out the ghost shapes.
2. Apply the ghost stickers to the bisque. Be sure to press down the edges to seal the sticker and prevent color from bleeding under the sticker.
3. Paint the entire background with 3 coats of Salmon Pink. When dry, remove the stickers.
4. Paint the cheeks on the ghost with a light coat of Salmon Pink by dabbing on the paint.
5. With a Black writer bottle, make dots for the eyes and outline the ghost shapes.
6. With small brush or writer bottle, paint Bright Orange stars in a random pattern on the Salmon Pink background.
7. With small brush or a writer bottle, paint White swirls in a random pattern on the Salmon Pink background. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

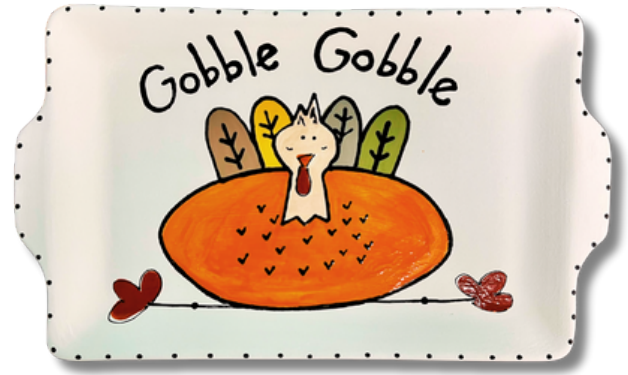
GOBBLE GOBBLE TURKEY TRAY

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rectangular platter (handles optional)
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Pumpkin, Coffee, Golden Yellow, Taupe, Olive Green,
Cream, Maroon
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

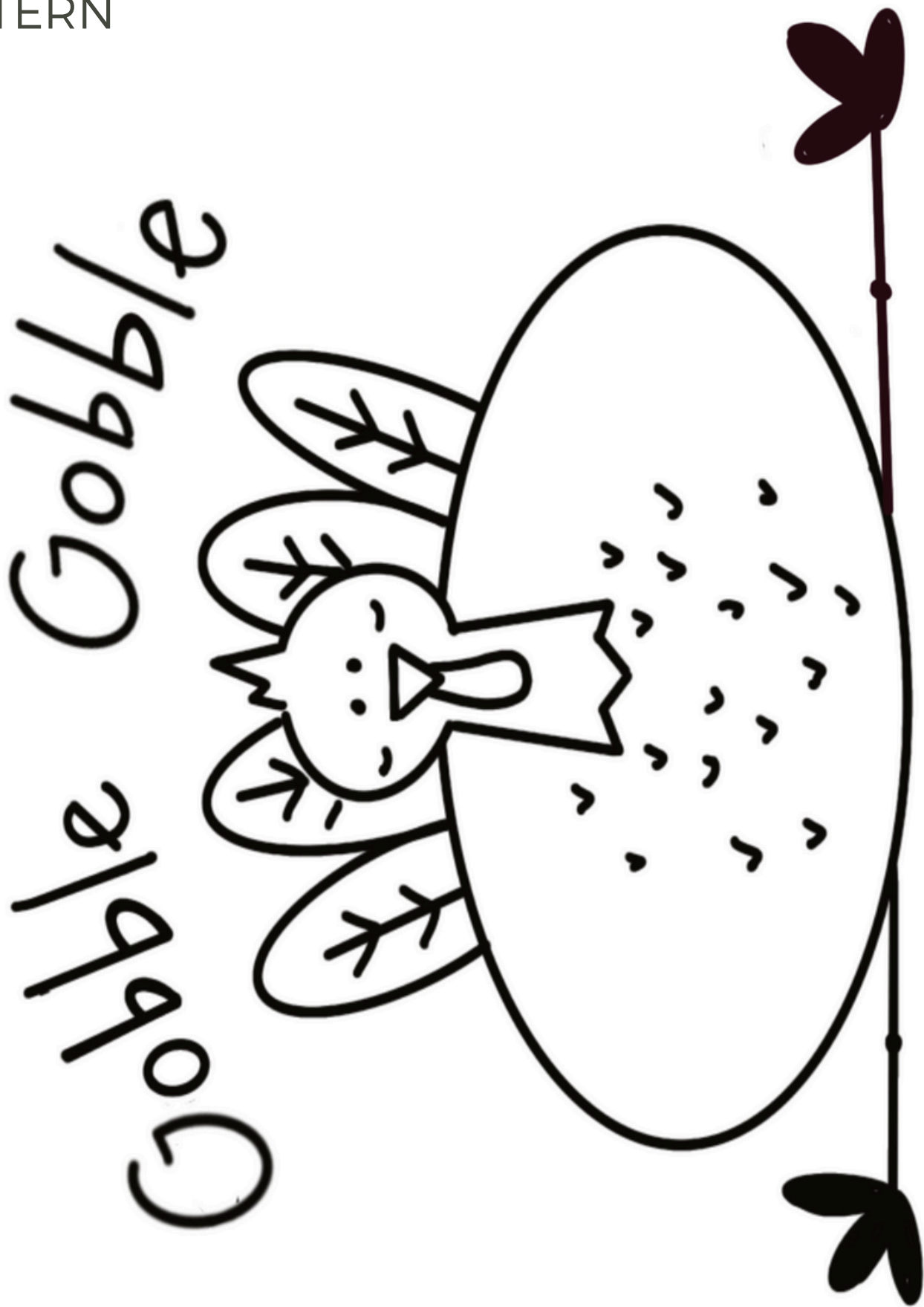
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the turkey body with 3 coats of Pumpkin.
3. Paint the feathers with 3 coats each in this order Coffee, Golden Yellow, Taupe, and Olive Green.
4. Paint the turkey head with 3 coats of Cream.
5. Paint the wattle and the feet with 3 coats of Maroon.
6. Paint the beak Pumpkin.
7. With a Black writer bottle, outline the design details, fill in the lettering, and add dots along the outer edge of the tray. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Regular mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes
Toothbrush or splatter tool



Glaze Paint Colors

Purple, Deep Orange, Lavender, Green, Light Green, Golden Yellow, Light Yellow, White, Black
Writer bottle: Black

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) For a larger mug, trace more spiders by repeating one or more of the spiders on the pattern.
2. Paint the first spider body with 3 coats of Purple. Paint the spider's head with 3 coats of Lavender. Paint dots on the body with Deep Orange.
3. Paint the second spider body and the head with 3 coats of Green. Paint the triangles on the body with 1 heavy coat of Light Green.
4. Paint the next spider body and head with 3 coats of Deep Orange. Paint the dots on the body Lavender.
5. Paint the outer stripes of the next spider body with 3 coats of Golden Yellow. Paint the inside stripe and the head with 3 coats of Light Yellow.
6. Paint the eyes on each spider with 2 coats of White.
7. With a Black writer bottle, outline the spider bodies and make the legs, the web hanging lines, and the pupils on each eye.
8. Paint the inside of the mug Deep Orange.
9. Dip a toothbrush or splatter tool in Black and splatter the inside of the mug. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

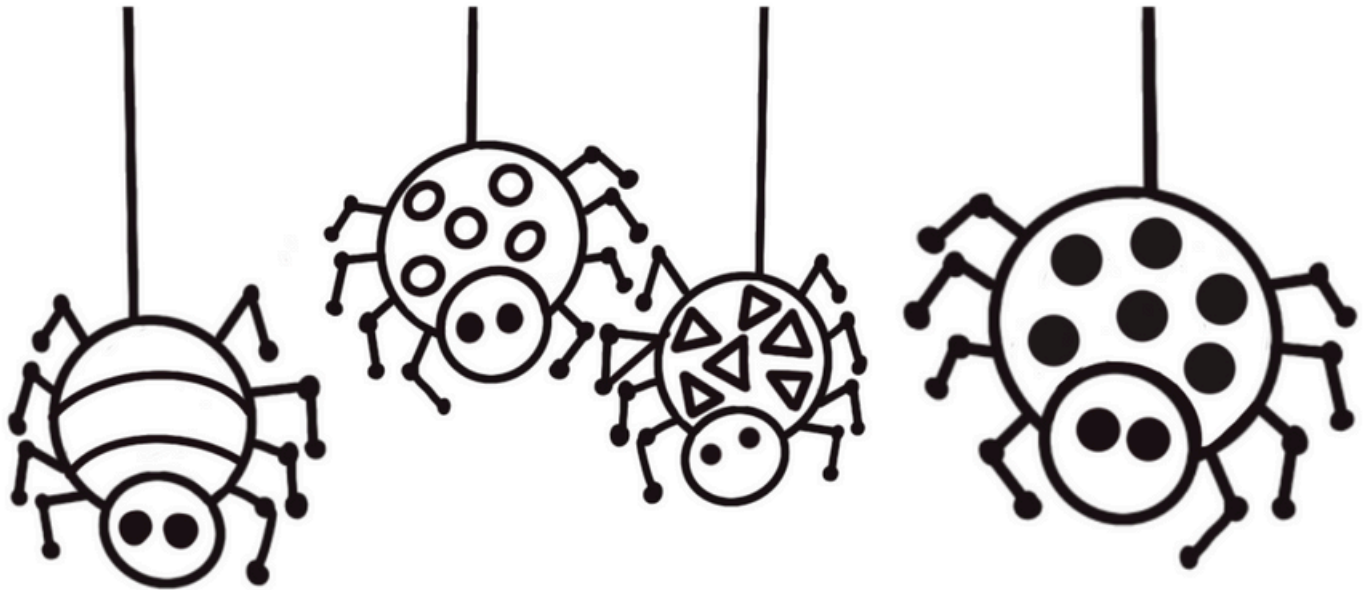

HAPPY BATS PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Orange, Medium Gray, Black, Light Gray, White
Writer bottles: Black, Light Gray



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Using the finished sample as a guide, paint four ribbons with 3 coats of Orange.
3. Again using the finished sample as a guide, paint two of the ribbons with 3 coats of Medium Gray and two with 3 coats of Light Gray.
4. Paint the last ribbon and the bats with 3 coats of Black.
5. With a small brush, paint the EEK in Orange in the center of the plate. Let dry.
6. Following the sample as a guide, use a Light Gray writer bottle to make lines, dots, and squiggles on the coordinating ribbons.
7. With a Black writer bottle, make Xs, lines, and small dots the coordinating ribbons.
8. Paint a thin line of Black down the center of the Orange EEK. Just a little of the orange should show to create a glow.
9. Dip the back end of a paintbrush in White and add dots for eyes on the bats.
10. Dip the back end of a paintbrush in Orange and add dots for cheeks on the bats.
11. With a Black writer bottle, outline the entire design. Let dry.
12. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

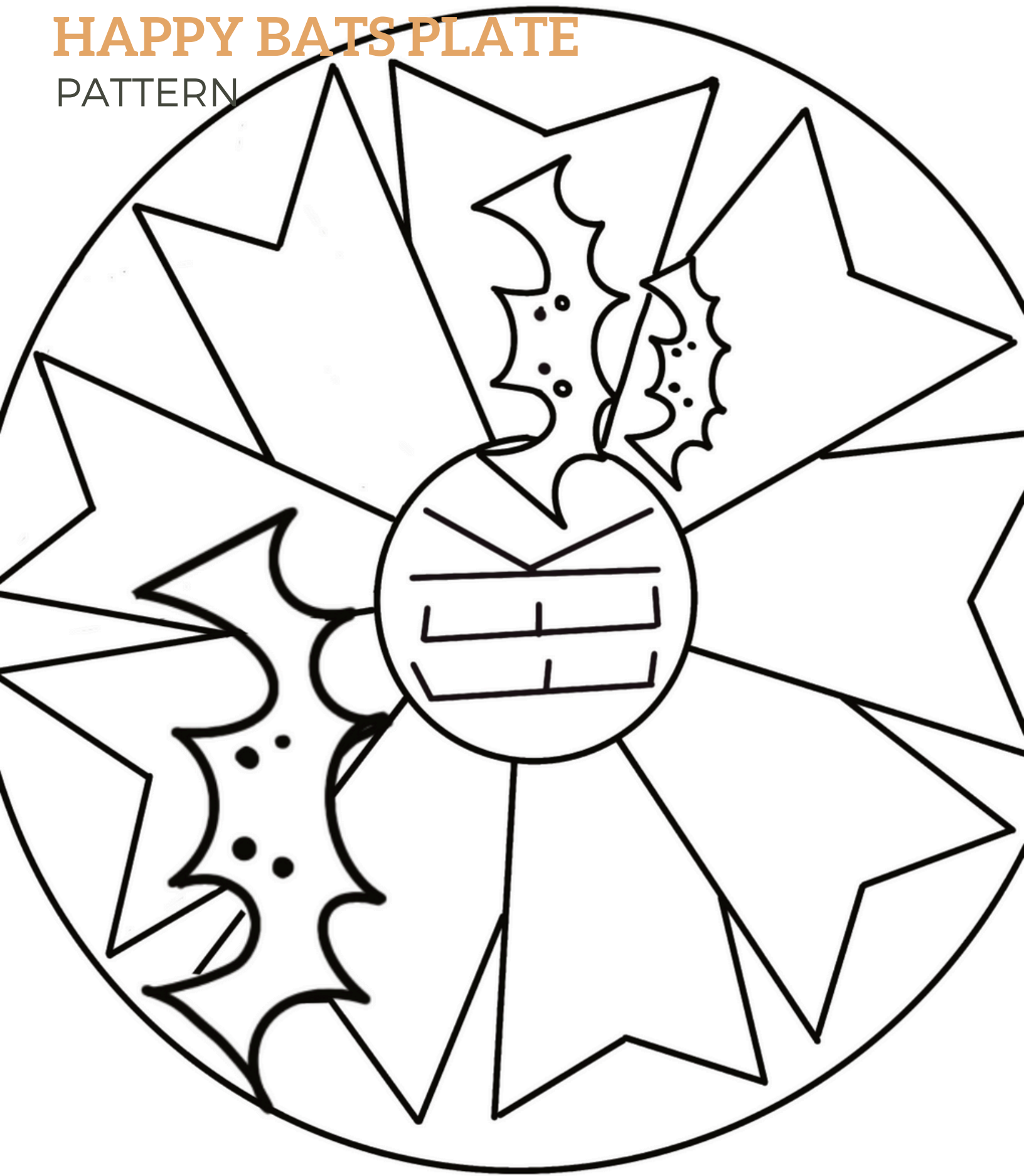

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Square dessert plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Light Gray, Green, Bright Blue
Writer bottles: White, Dark Green, Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering or the details on the mountain onto the bisque yet—they'll be transferred in step 5.
2. Paint the mountaintops with 3 coats of Light Gray.
3. Paint the mountains with 3 coats of Green.
4. Paint the sky with 3 coats of Bright Blue.
5. Reposition the tissue tracing and trace mountain details and the lettering onto the plate with the marker.
6. With a White writer bottle, make dots on the mountaintops.
7. Fill in the letters with a Dark Green writer bottle.
8. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the trees and the tent, and outline the mountains. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

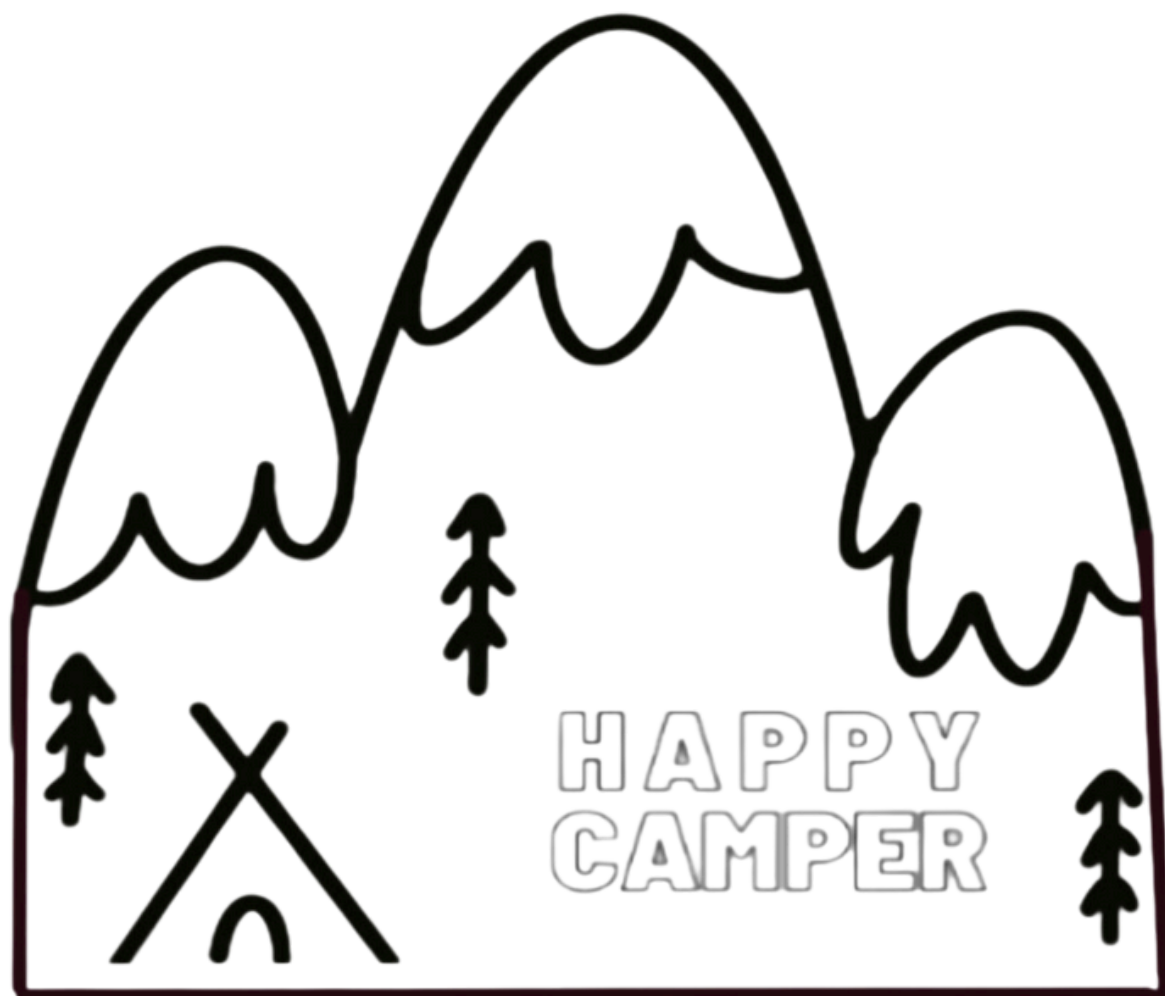

HOPE YOU BROUGHT PIE CHARGER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rounded-corner square charger
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Pumpkin, Tan
Writer bottle: Dark Brown



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Trace the number of pie shapes according to the size of the bisque piece.
2. Paint the triangle pie shapes with 3 coats of Pumpkin.
3. Paint the pie crust with 3 coats of Tan.
4. With a Dark Brown writer bottle, fill in the lettering, outline the pie shapes, and add a two-dot pattern in the white spaces between the pie shapes. Let dry.
5. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Contact paper or stencil sticker
Scissors
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Bright Green, Dark Brown, White
Writer bottles: White, Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the outline of the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace just the footballs with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) The remaining details will be traced on in step 5.
2. Place the tissue tracing on the contact paper and trace the outline of all 3 footballs connected as one onto contact paper and cut out. Place the sticker on the plate on top of the traced pattern.
3. Paint the entire plate with 3 coats of Bright Green.
4. Remove the contact paper and paint the football area with 3 coats of Dark Brown. Let dry.
5. Reposition the tissue tracing and trace the design details onto the plate with the marker.
6. Paint the wide stripes on the footballs with 3 coats of White.
7. With a White writer bottle, make the stitch lines on the footballs and the field lines on the background.
8. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering and the play diagram, outline the football shapes, and paint a thin line down the center of the stitching. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

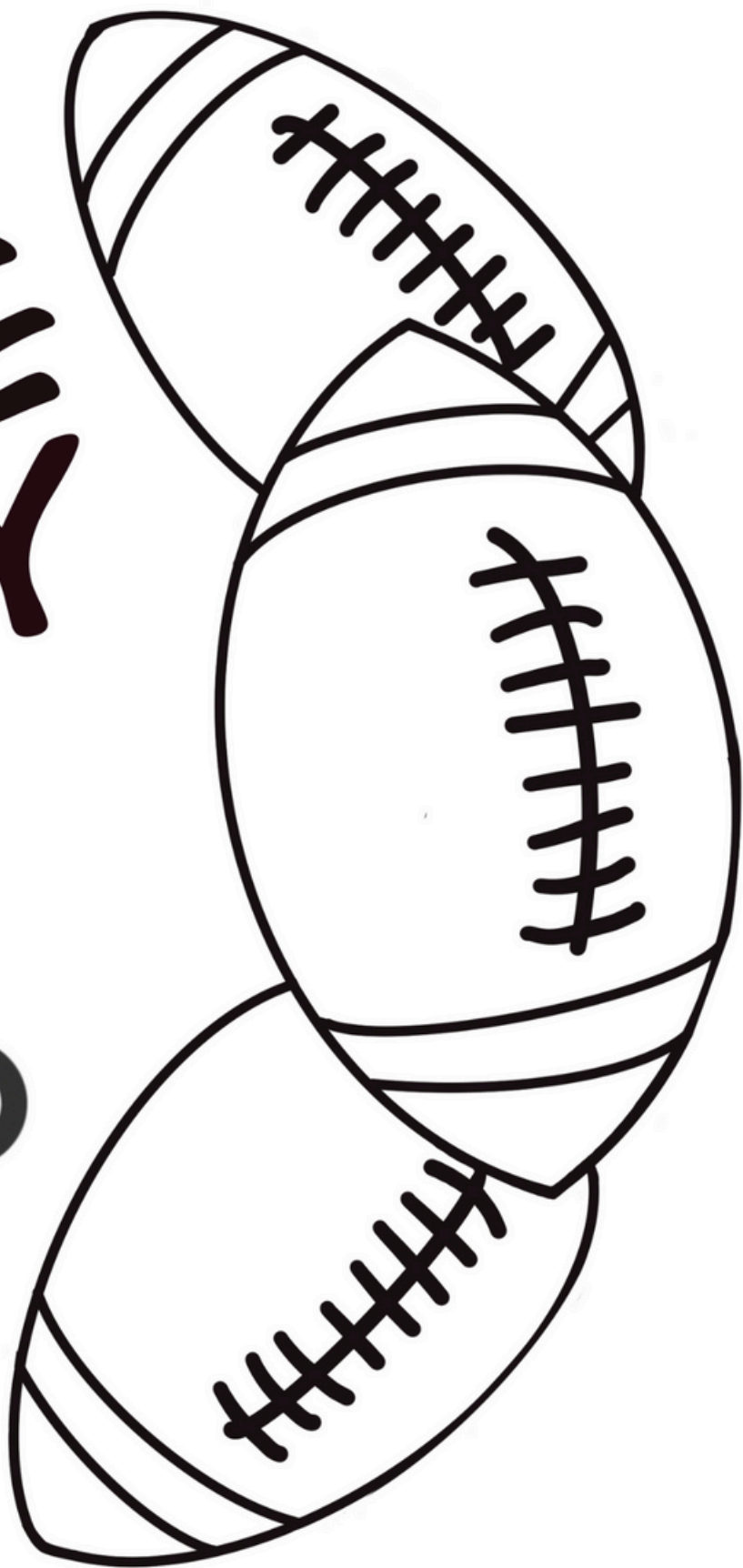
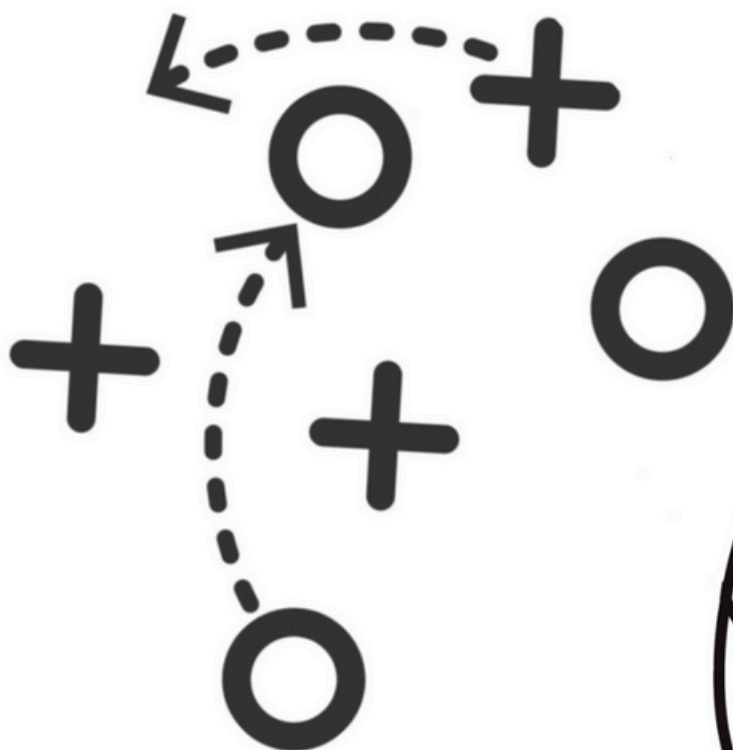

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rectangle server (7"x12")
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Olive Green, Bright Blue, Taupe
Writer bottles: Dark Olive Green, Bright Blue, Coral, Olive Green



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the mushroom top with 3 coats of Olive Green.
3. Paint the mushroom stem with 3 coats of Bright Blue.
4. Paint the dirt with 3 coats of Taupe.
5. Paint the fern stems and leaf designs in Dark Olive Green with a writer bottle or small brush.
6. With a Bright Blue writer, paint the flowers and their stems.
7. With a Coral writer bottle, make tiny dots around the edge of the mushroom top.
8. With an Olive Green writer bottle, paint tiny pebbles in clustered areas on the dirt.
9. In the background area, paint various doodles using the same doodle exclusively to that color. For example, Bright Blue is a cluster of tiny dots, Coral is an X, Taupe is an X and also an asterisk-shape, Dark Olive Green is just one dot, and Olive Green is 3 tiny dots. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

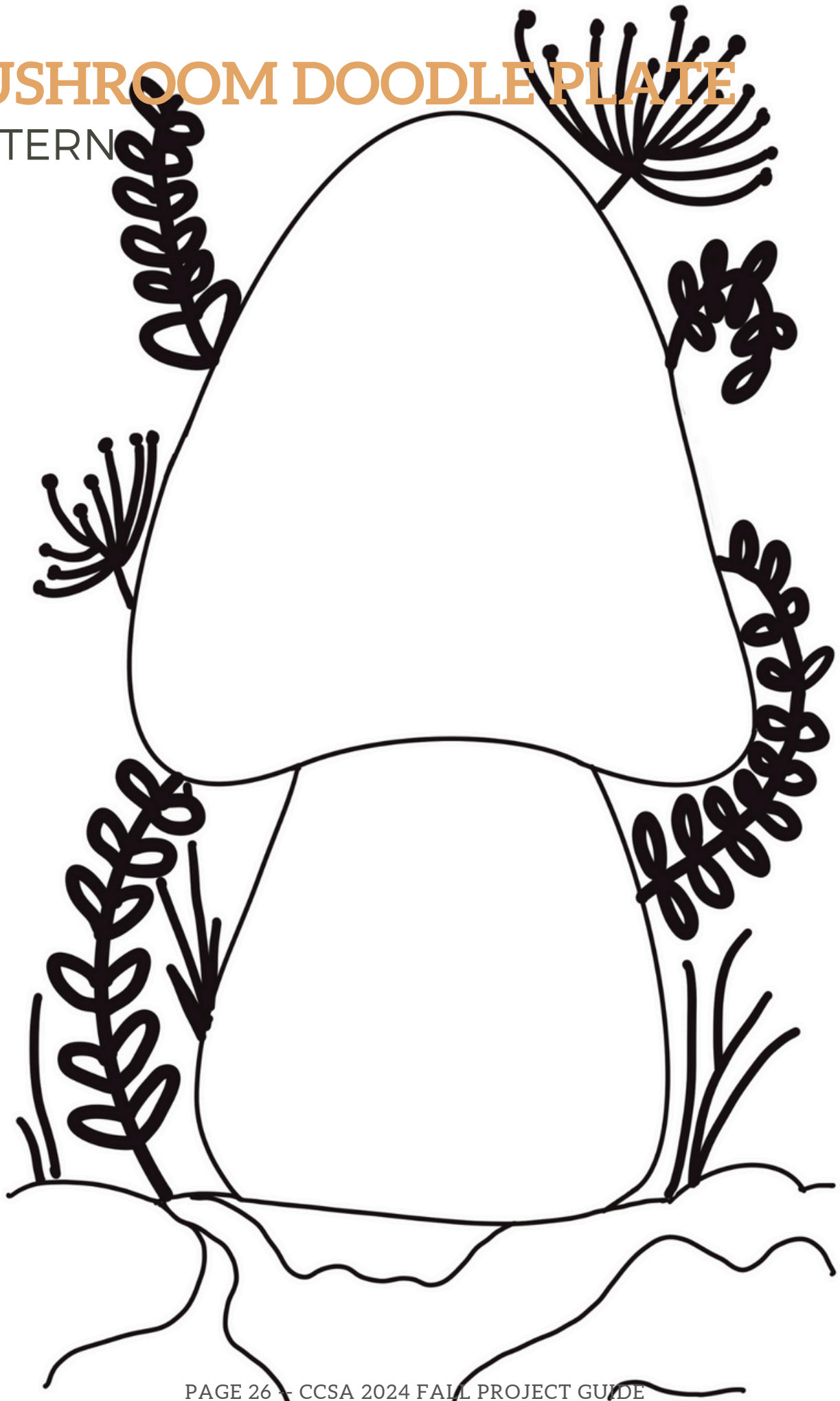

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes
Toothbrush or splatter tool

Glaze Paint Colors

Pumpkin, Cream, Taupe, Coffee, Dark Olive Green, Olive Green, Black
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the center section of the pumpkin with 3 coats of Pumpkin.
3. Add a little bit of Cream into the Pumpkin (1:3 ratio) and mix well. Paint the outer pumpkin sections with 2-3 coats of this mixture.
4. Paint the stem with 3 coats of Taupe.
5. Paint the tip of the stem with 3 coats of Coffee.
6. Paint the largest leaf with 3 coats of Dark Olive Green.
7. Paint the smaller leaf with 3 coats of Olive Green.
8. Dip a toothbrush or splatter tool into slightly watered down Black and lightly splatter the entire surface.
9. With a Black writer bottle, outline the pumpkin and fill in the lettering. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

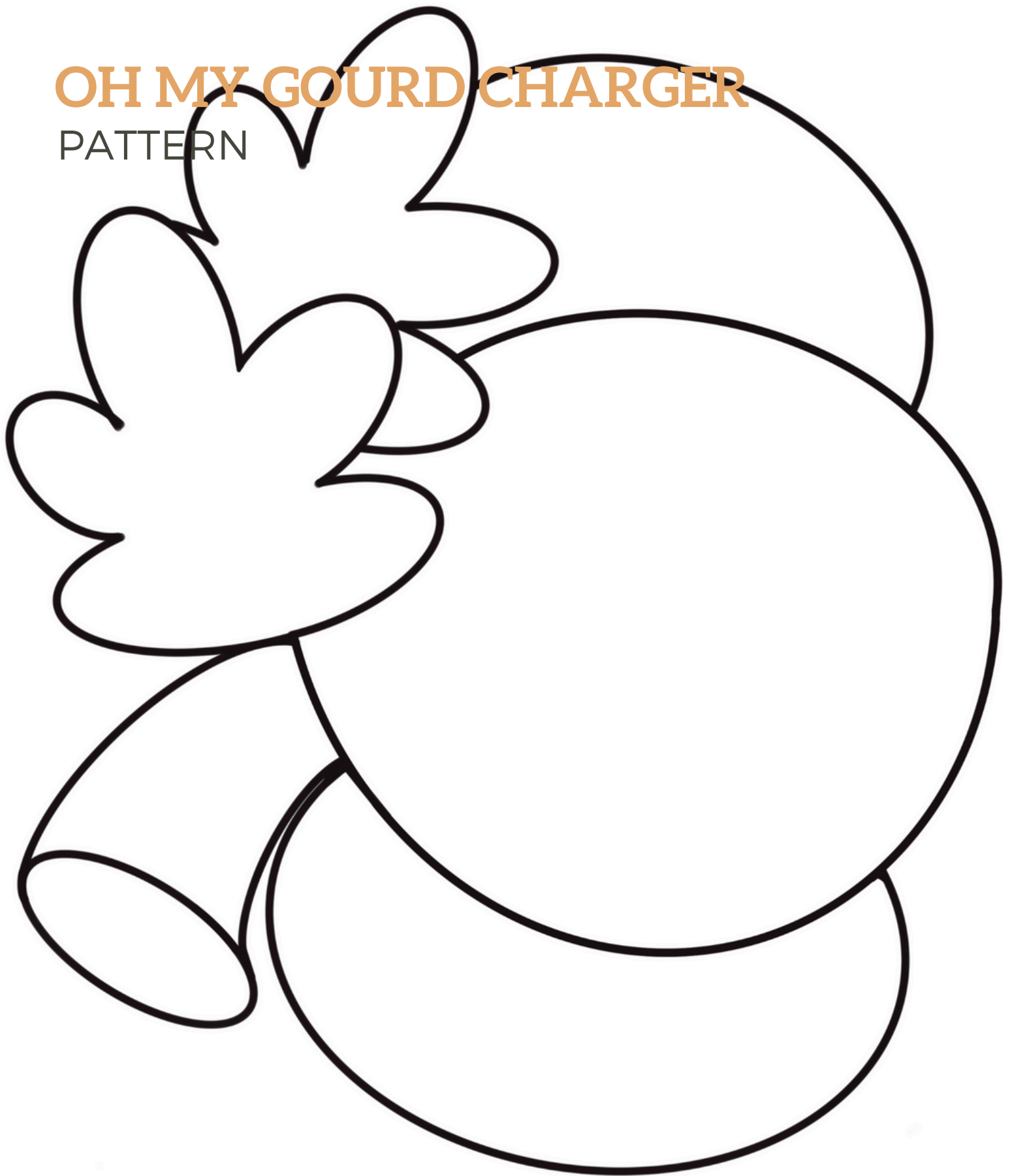

Bisque: Coupe charger
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Tan, Cream, Brown
Writer bottle: Brown, Dark Brown, White, Red



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the graham crackers with 3 coats of Tan.
3. Paint the marshmallows with 3 coats of Cream.
4. Paint the chocolate bars with 3 coats of Brown.
5. With a Brown writer bottle, make dots in a line pattern on the graham crackers.
6. Slightly water down Brown and use a liner brush to paint the edges and outlines of the marshmallows to give them a toasted effect.
7. With a White writer bottle, fill in the lettering.
8. With a Dark Brown writer bottle, paint the sticks, and the hearts on the graham crackers and chocolate bars. Also outline the graham crackers and chocolate bars with a sketchy line.
9. With a Red writer bottle, make a thin dashed line on top of the White lettering. Make a thicker dashed line all around the border of the plate. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

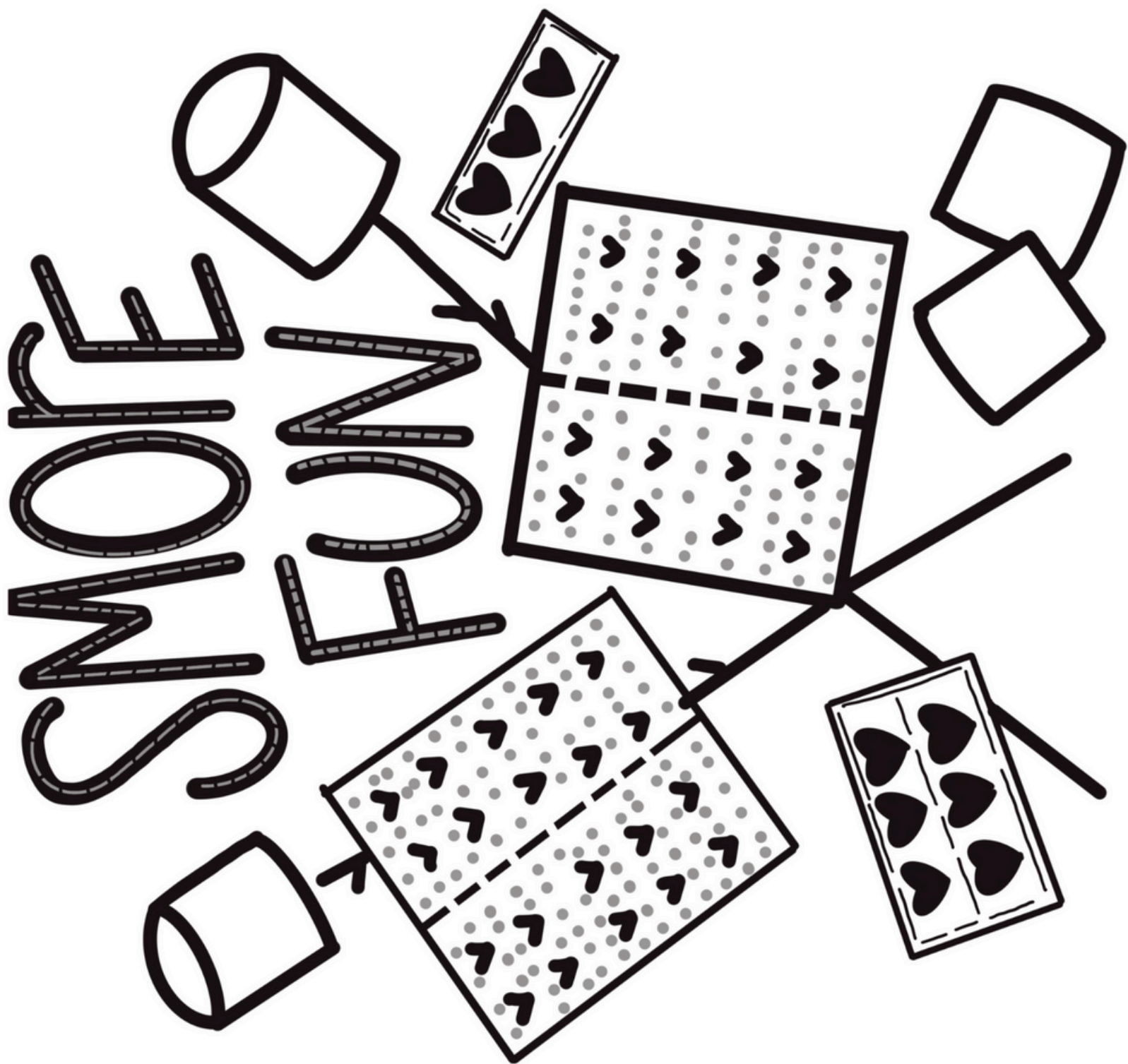

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rim dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Blue painters tape
Small and medium brushes

Glaze Paint Colors

Red, Dark Brown, Green
Writer bottles: Black, Red, White



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the apples with 3 coats of Red.
3. Paint the tree limb with 3 coats of Dark Brown.
4. Paint the leaves with 3 coats of Green.
5. With a Black writer bottle, paint the first line of the lettering. (To avoid dragging your hand through wet glaze, do not paint the third line of the lettering yet.)
6. With a Red writer bottle, paint the second line of the lettering.
7. With the Black writer bottle, paint the third line of the lettering.
8. With a White writer bottle, make the highlights on the leaves and the apples.
9. Tape off the striped sections around the rim. Paint the untaped sections with 3 coats of Red. Remove the tape.
10. With a Black writer bottle, make dots all around the inside edge of the plate rim. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
