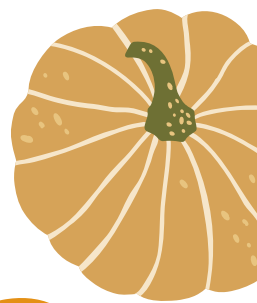
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BY THE LIGHT OF THE MOON PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Paper
Scissors
Assorted brushes
Sponge

GLAZE COLORS

White, Black, Light Gray, Bright Lime Green
Writer bottles: White, Bright Lime Green



DIRECTIONS

1. Sponge-paint the plate with 1 light coat of White.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't transfer the bats to the plate yet.
3. Cut out the tree shape from the pattern. Paint the back of the tree cutout with a solid coat of Black and place it, painted side down, over the traced shape on the plate. Tap the cutout down with a damp sponge dipped in White to seal the edges.
4. Sponge-paint the night sky area with 2-3 coats of Light Gray.
5. With a medium brush, paint the crescent moon with 2-3 coats of Bright Lime Green.
6. Remove the tree cutout.
7. Mix a little bit of Light Gray with White. Dip a sponge into this mixture and paint small areas to create clouds, overlapping some of the clouds with the tree.
8. Once dry, reposition the tissue tracing and trace on the bats with the marker.
9. Paint the bats with 2-3 coats of Black.
10. Add dots to the bat wings with a White writer bottle.
11. Add dot eyes to each bat with a Bright Lime Green writer bottle. Let dry.
12. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

CANDY CORN BOWL

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Tapered bowl with straight sides

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes



GLAZE COLORS

Orange, Golden Yellow, White, Pink, Bright Orange, Bright Yellow, Black

Writer bottles: Black, White

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Mark the stripe sections with O (orange), P (pink), or Y (Bright Yellow) to keep the colors in order.
2. Paint the bottom section of the candy corns Golden Yellow, the middle section Orange, and the top section White using 3 coats for each color.
3. Paint the striped sections with 3 coats of each color: Bright Orange, Bright Yellow, or Pink.
4. Using a liner brush or writer bottle, outline the candy corns and lines between the stripes with Black.
5. Using a liner brush or writer bottle, paint squiggles and dots inside the stripes with White. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

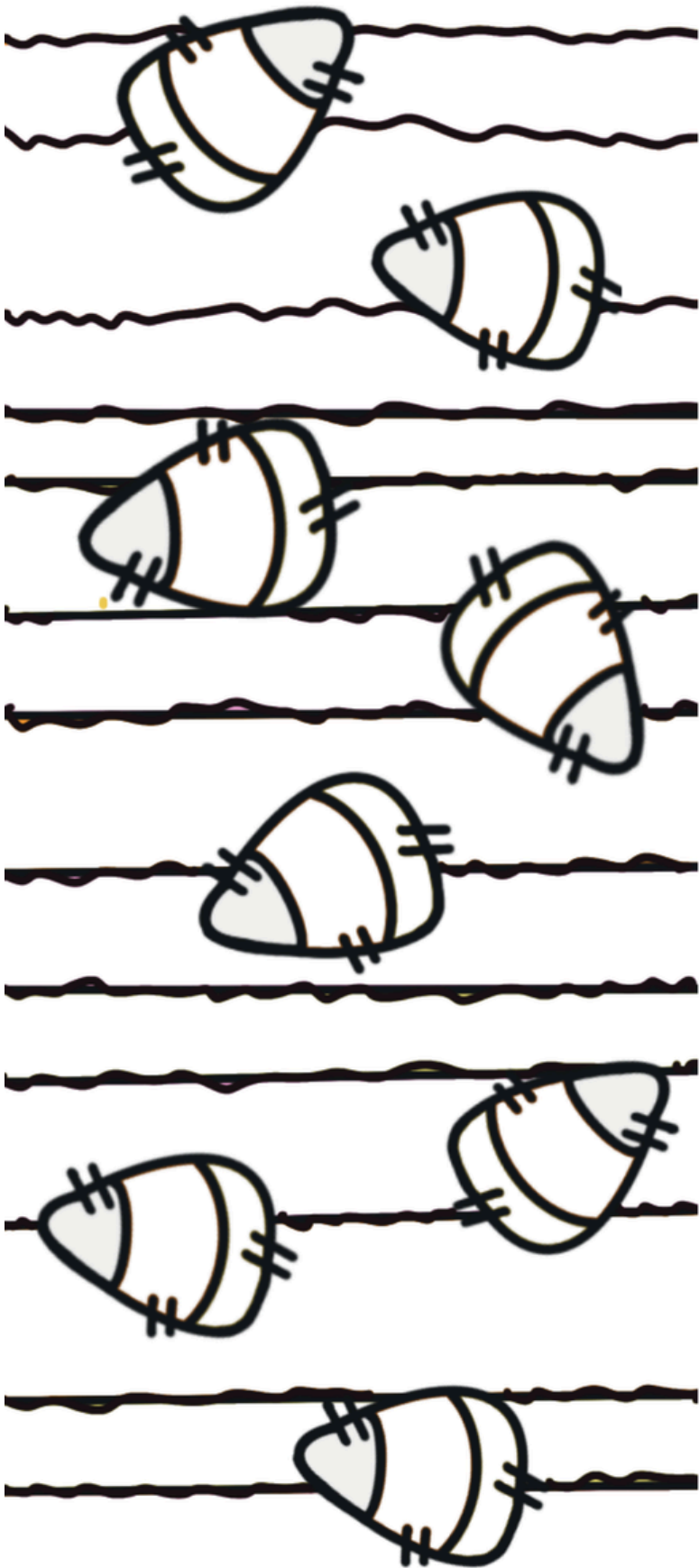

CRUMBS HAPPEN SALAD PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe salad plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Dark Tan, Dark Brown
Writer bottles: Brown, Dark Brown



DIRECTIONS

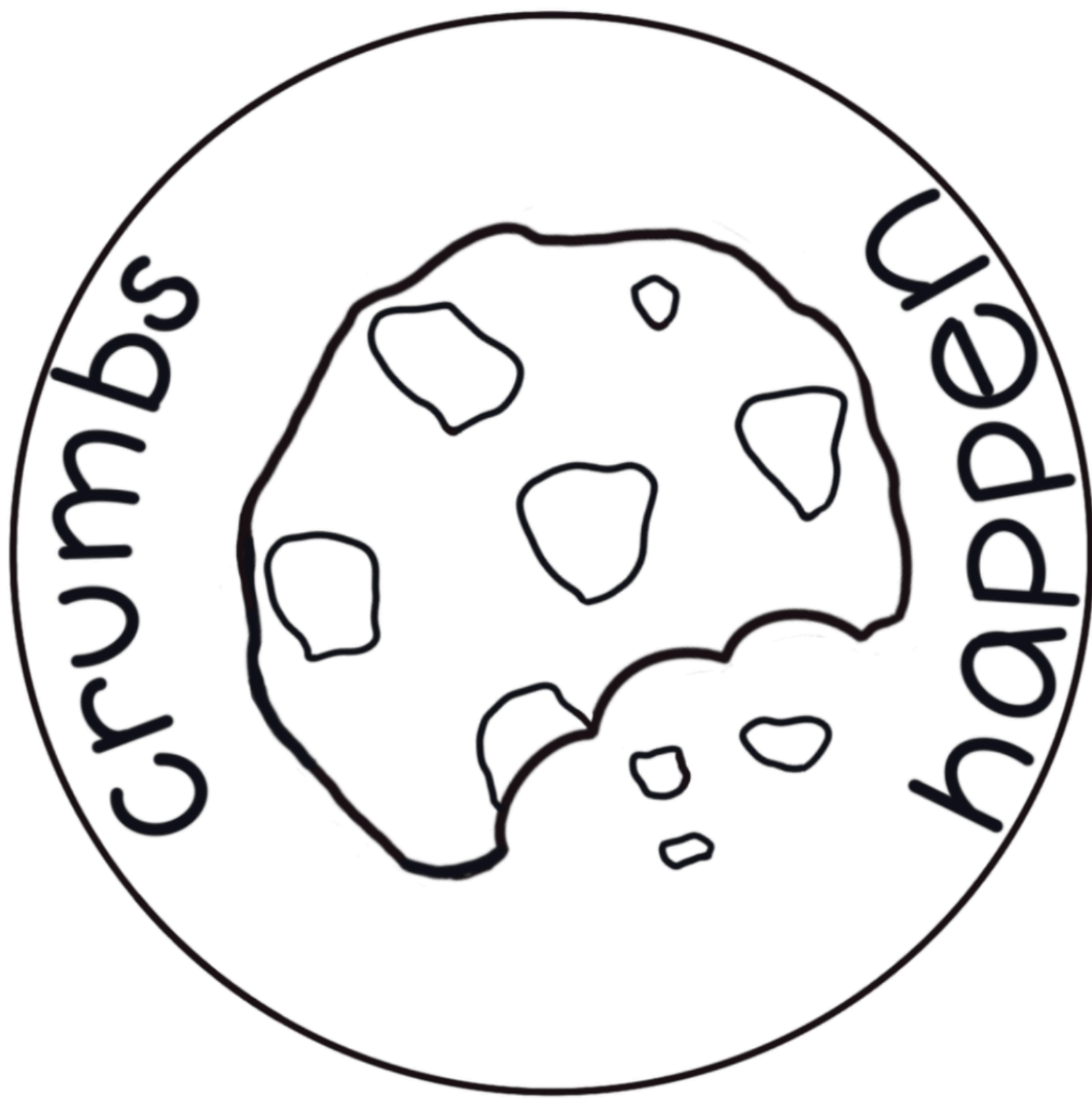
1. Paint the plate with 1 light coat of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Paint the cookie and two of the crumbs with 2 coats of Dark Tan.
4. Using a brush or writer bottle, paint the chocolate chips and the last crumb with 2 coats of Dark Brown. Also outline the cookie with Dark Brown.
5. Using a Dark Brown writer bottle, fill in the lettering and make dots around the inside of the rim. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

FALL BRANCHES UTENSIL HOLDER

This design works well on just about any bisque shape.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Tall utensil holder
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Pumpkin, Dark Brown, Coffee, Taupe, Dark Brown
Writer bottles: Dark Brown



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the background with 2 coats of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Mix equal parts of Pumpkin and Cream. Paint every other leaf with 2–3 coats of mixture.
4. Paint the remaining leaves with 2–3 coats of Pumpkin.
5. Alternating acorn shapes, paint the acorn bottom with 2 coats of Coffee. Paint the top of the same acorn with 2 coats of Taupe. Paint the reverse pattern on the remaining acorns.
6. Paint the inside of the holder with 2–3 coats of Pumpkin.
7. With Dark Brown writer bottle, paint the branches, make the leaf veins, outline all the leaves and acorns, and add the acorn details. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

FRIENDSGIVING DOODLES TRAY

Patterns are provided for two lettering options.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rectangular tray
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes
Small dotter

GLAZE COLORS

Pumpkin, Olive Green, Bright Teal Blue, Golden Yellow, Taupe
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Note: You may need to retrace some of the leaves once the painted background areas are dry.
2. Following the sample, paint the background areas behind the leaves with 1–2 coats of each of the colors: Pumpkin, Olive Green, Bright Teal Blue, Golden Yellow, and Taupe. Try not to paint two of the same color areas next to each other.
3. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering and make all the doodles of the pattern.
4. Use a small round dotter with various colors to fill in around the doodles and lettering. Let dry.
5. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Assorted brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Dark Green, Medium Green, Medium Brown, Gray, Gold,
Black, White

Writer bottles: White, Black



DIRECTIONS

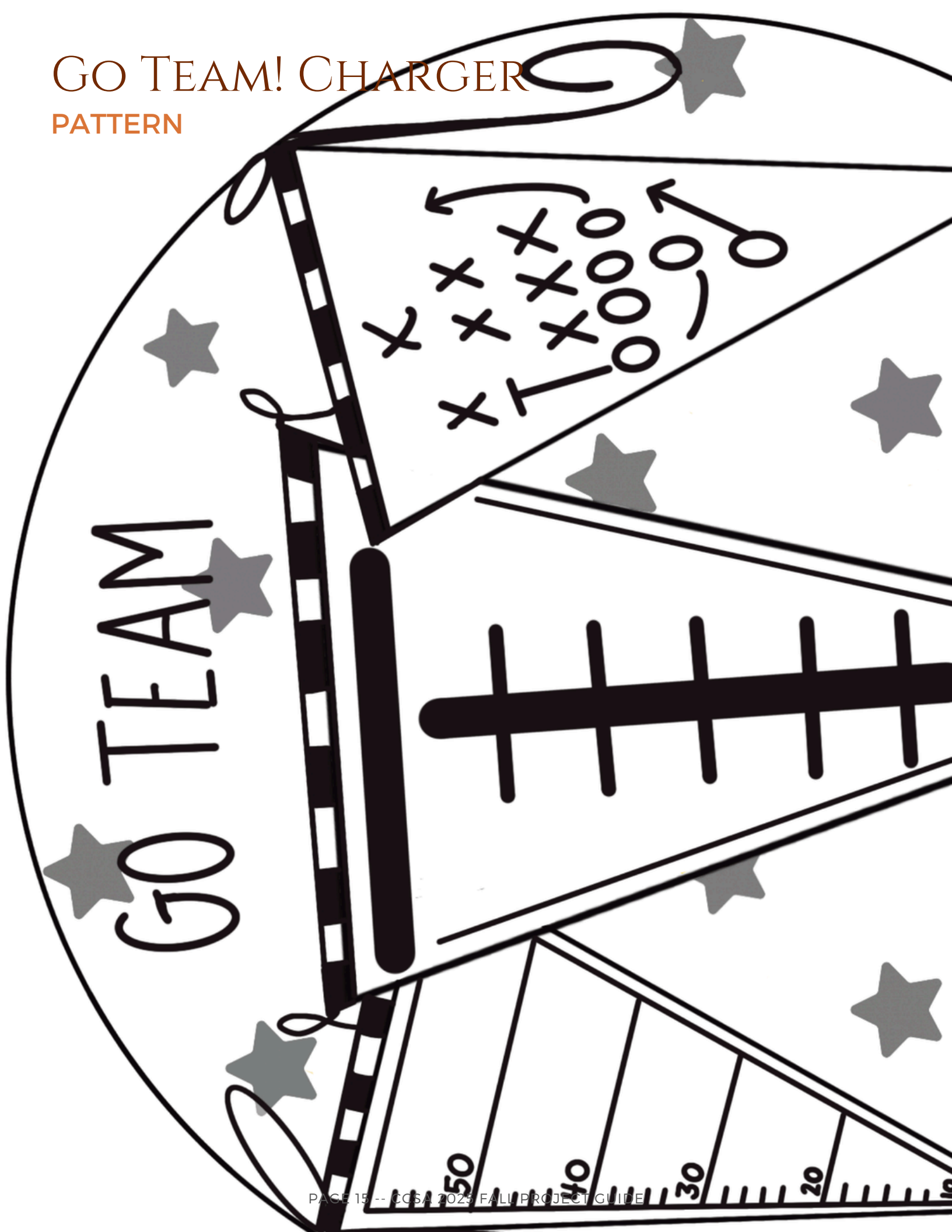
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the flag details onto the plate yet.
2. Field Flag: Paint the alternating green stripes with 3 coats each of Dark Green and Medium Green.
3. Football Flag: Paint the entire flag with 3 coats of Medium Brown.
4. Playbook Flag: Paint the entire flag with 3 coats of Gray.
5. Once all the flags are dry, reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the flag details onto the plate.
6. With the Black writer bottle, add the field line details on the Field Flag.
7. With the White writer bottle or a liner brush, paint thick White lines on the Football Flag. Once the White is dry, use the Black writer bottle to make a thinner line on the White stitches.
8. With the Black writer bottle, fill in the details on the Playbook Flag.
9. With the Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering at the top, and make the outlines of all the flags, the stripes on top of the each flag, and the connecting string between flags.
10. Paint the stars with 3 coats of Gold. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

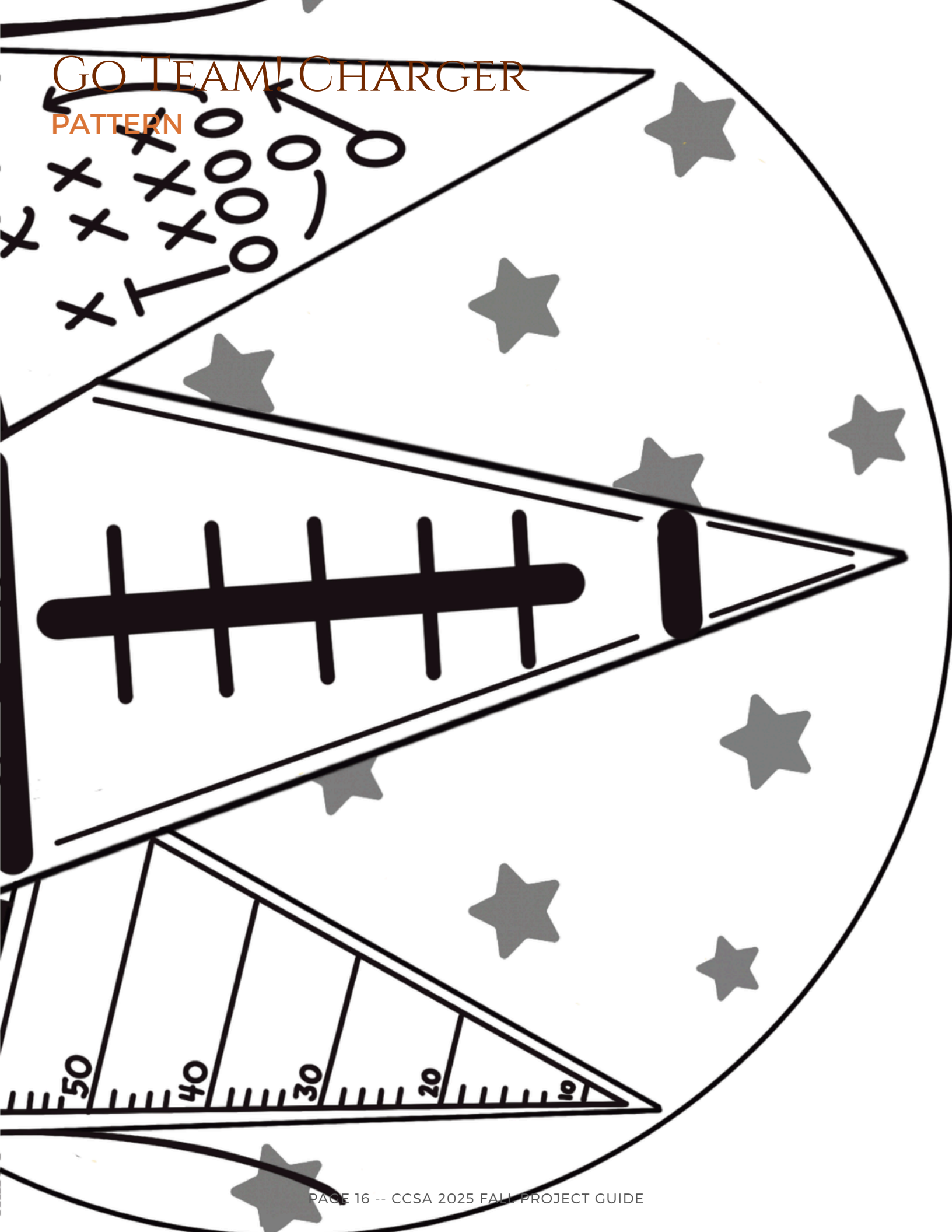

HAPPY ROSH HASHANAH PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Bright Yellow, Yellow, Gold, Red, Medium Green, Dark Green,
Gray, White, Black
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the lid on the honey jar with 3 coats of Bright Yellow.
3. Paint the honey jar with 3 coats of Yellow.
4. Paint the honeycombs on the jar with 1 coat of Gold.
5. Paint each apple with 3 coats each, following the sample for placement: Red, Yellow, Medium Green, and Gold.
6. Paint the leaves with 3 coats of Dark Green.
7. Paint the honey dipper with 2 coats of Gray.
8. Paint the inside of the cut apples with 3 coats of White.
9. Using a Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering and outline all the design elements of the apples, leaves, jar, and honey dipper.
10. Paint dots all around the border of the plate, except where a design element interrupts that circle. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

HELLO FALL MUG

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Mug with 4" side

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes



GLAZE COLORS

Gray, Blue, Olive Green, Orange, Pumpkin

Writer bottle: Coffee Brown

DIRECTIONS

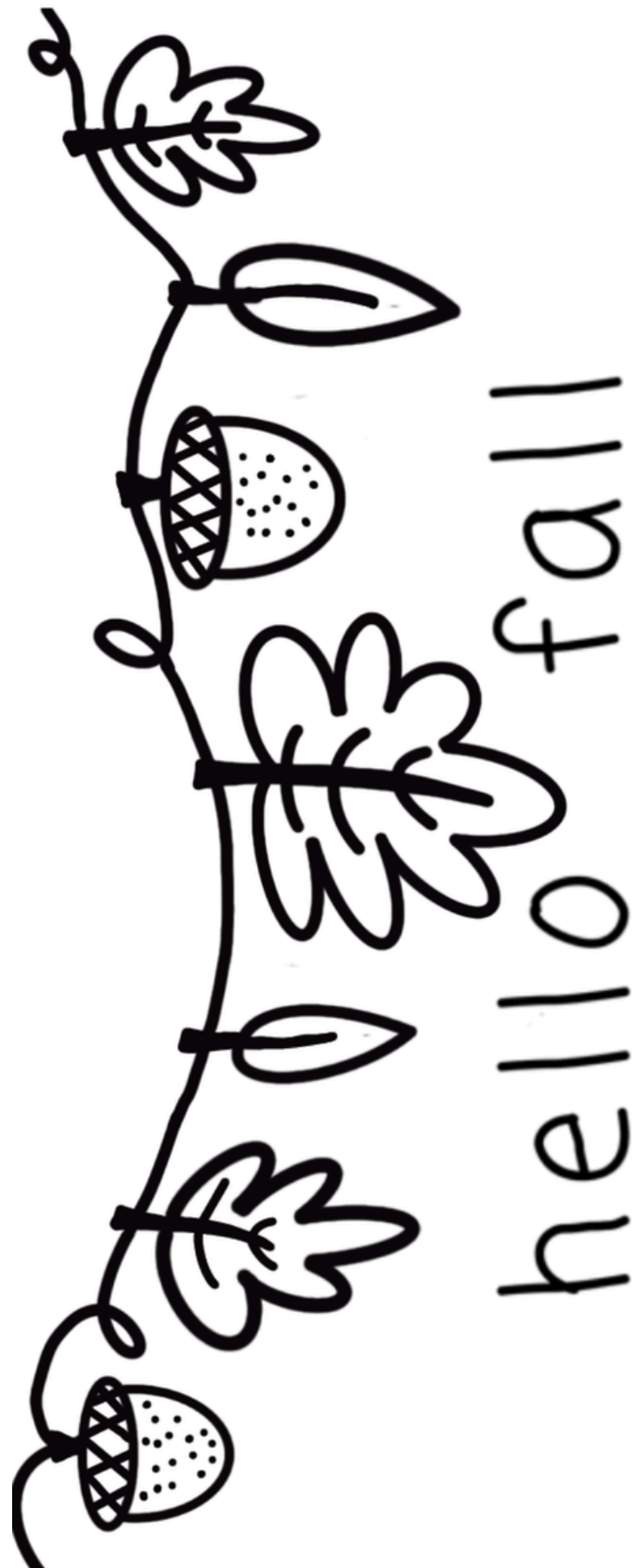
1. Paint the mug with 1 coat of watered-down Gray.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Paint the leaves with 3 coats of each color, as follows. The small wide leaves are Blue. The large leaf is Orange. One narrow leaf is Olive Green and the other is Pumpkin.
4. Paint the acorns (not the acorn cap) with 3 coats of Gray.
5. With a Coffee Brown writer bottle, add the vine, outline all the elements, and add the veins on the leaves, the dots on the acorn, and the crisscross pattern on the acorn cap.
6. Fill in the lettering with the Coffee Brown writer bottle. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

HOWDY PLATTER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rectangular platter
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Taupe, White, Black, Red
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Mix 2 parts Taupe to 1 part White, enough to cover the entire background. Paint the background with 2–3 coats of this mixture, avoiding the letters. Once dry, retrace the stitched rope line using the tissue paper tracing.
3. Paint the cow spots on the letters with 3 coats of Black.
4. Paint the hat with 3 coats of Red.
5. With Black writer bottle, outline the letters, the details on the hat, and the stitched rope lines. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

PERFECTLY PICKED PUMPKIN CHARGER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Pumpkin, Dark Olive Green, Taupe, Light Teal Blue

Writer bottle: Taupe



DIRECTIONS

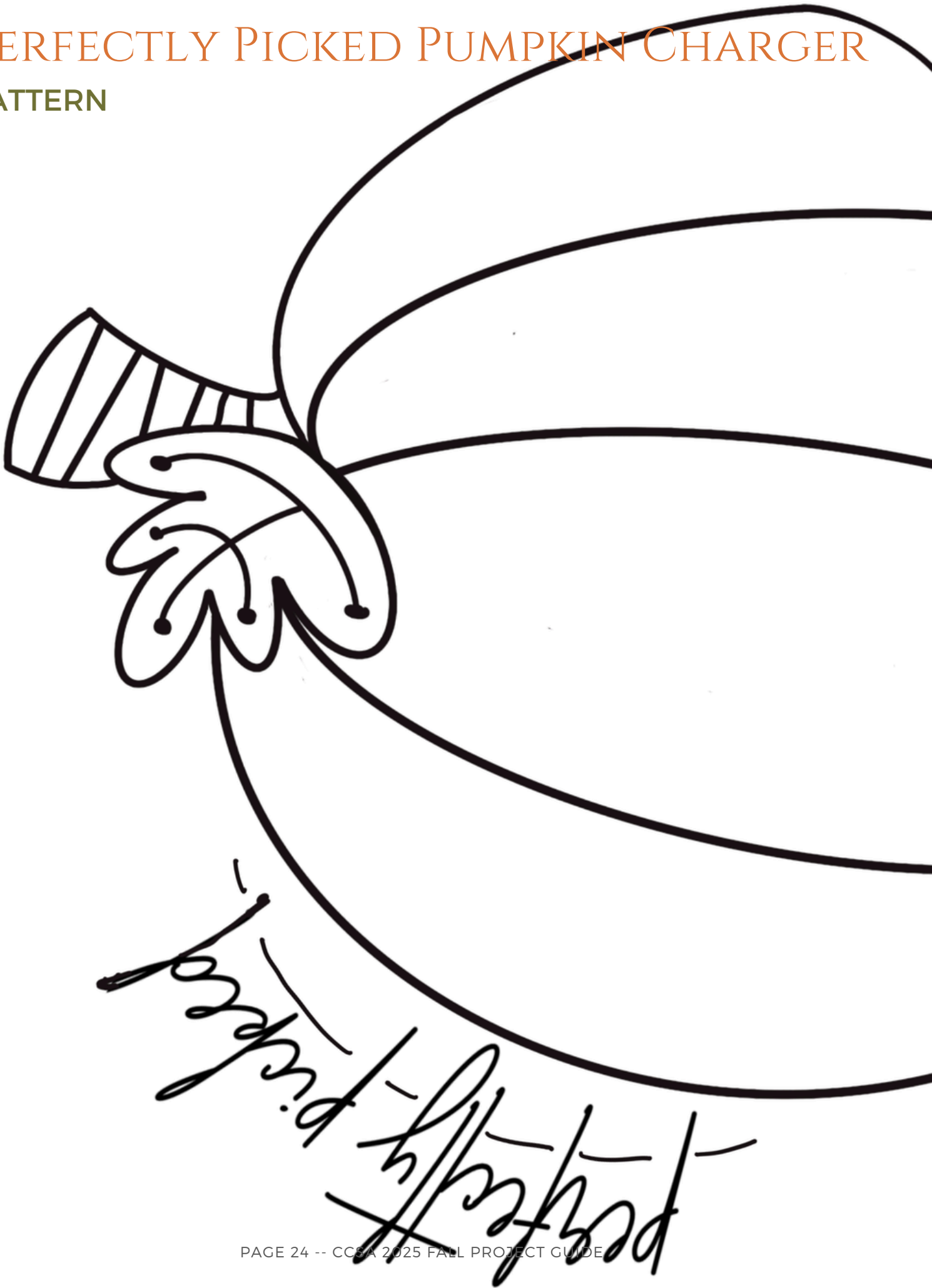
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Just trace the outlines for now—don't trace the pumpkin details or the lettering onto the plate yet.
2. Slightly water down Cream. Paint the background area from the top of the pumpkin to the bottom of the pumpkin with long brushstrokes, keeping the brushstrokes in curved motion to create a large "C" around the pumpkin.
3. Paint the pumpkin with 3 coats of Pumpkin.
4. Paint the inside stripes of the stem with 3 coats of Light Teal Blue.
5. Paint the leaf with 3 coats of Dark Olive Green.
6. Paint the remaining stripes on the stem with 3 coats of Taupe.
7. Once pumpkin is dry, reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the pumpkin details and lettering. Fill these in with a Taupe writer bottle. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

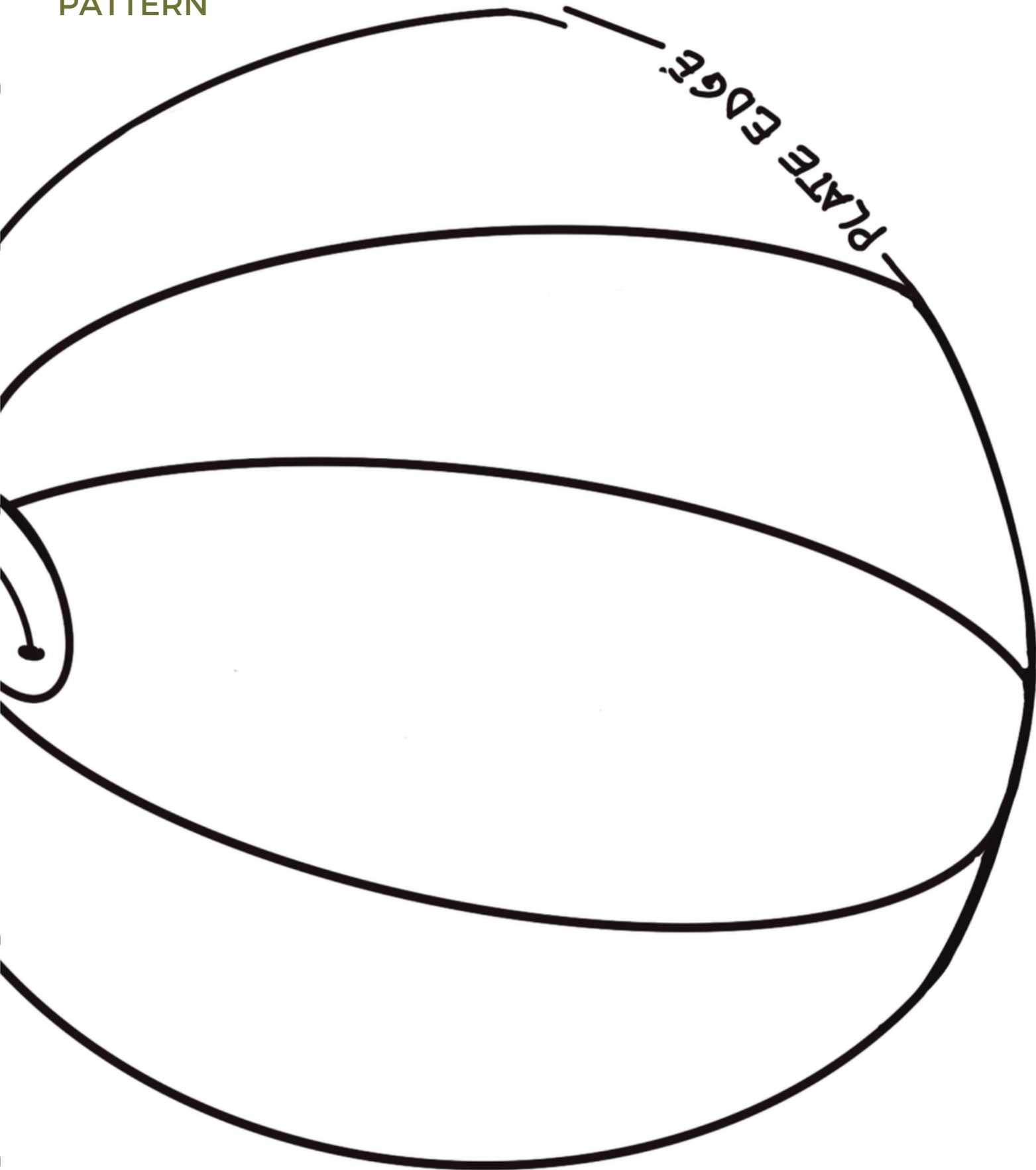

PUMPKIN PATCH PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Square dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Marker
Small and medium liner brushes
Water

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Pumpkin, Taupe
Writer bottle: Pumpkin



DIRECTIONS

1. Slightly water down Taupe. Keeping brushstrokes all going in one direction, paint 1 coat over the entire plate.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Paint the pumpkins with 2 coats of Cream.
4. Paint the bows with 2 coats of Pumpkin.
5. With a small brush or writer bottle, outline the pumpkins and add the details on each pumpkin. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

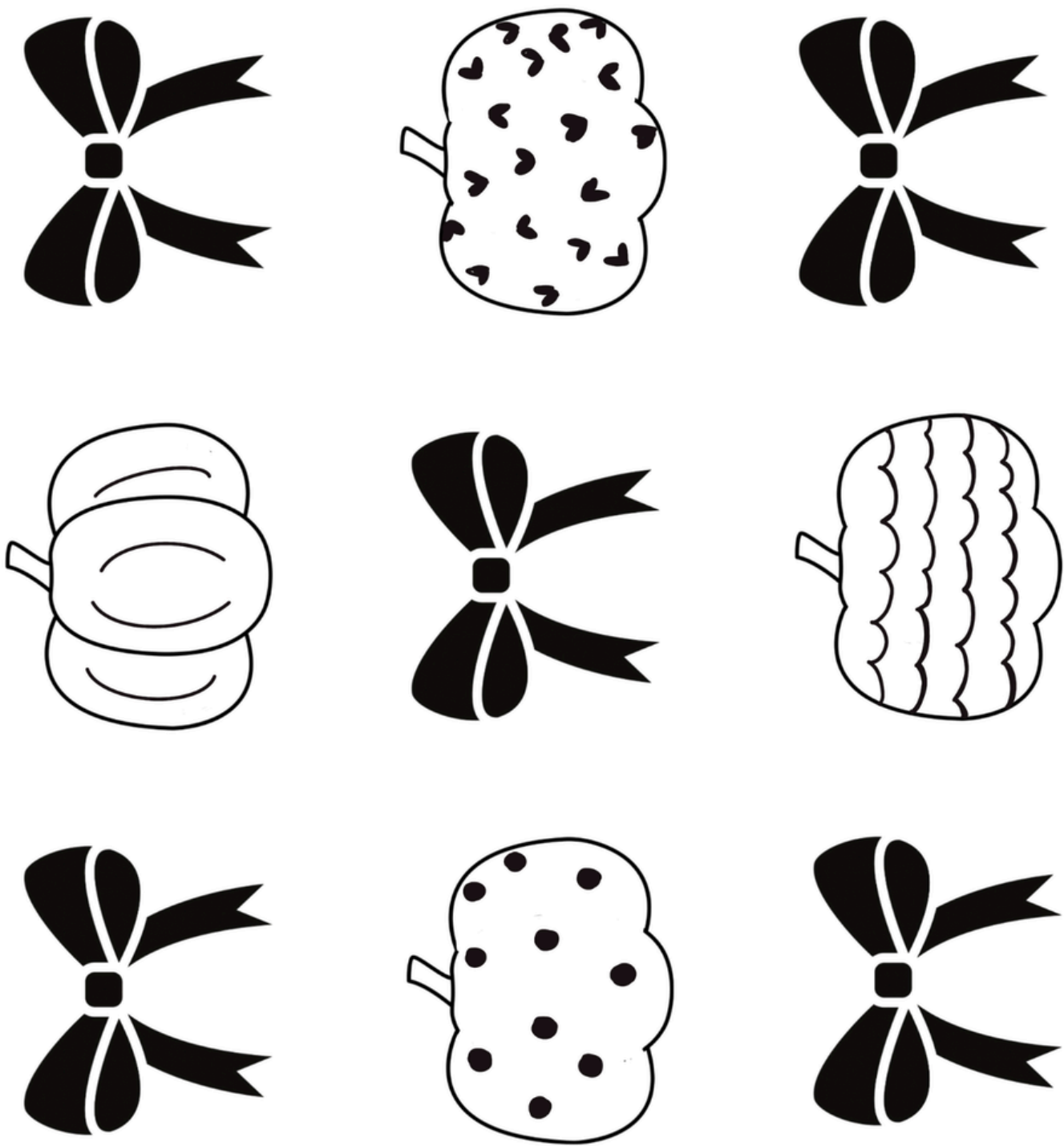

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Red, Orange, Bright Yellow, Kelly Green, Teal, Bright Blue, Grape

Purple, Berry Purple, Tan, Dark Gray

Writer bottles: White, Black



DIRECTIONS

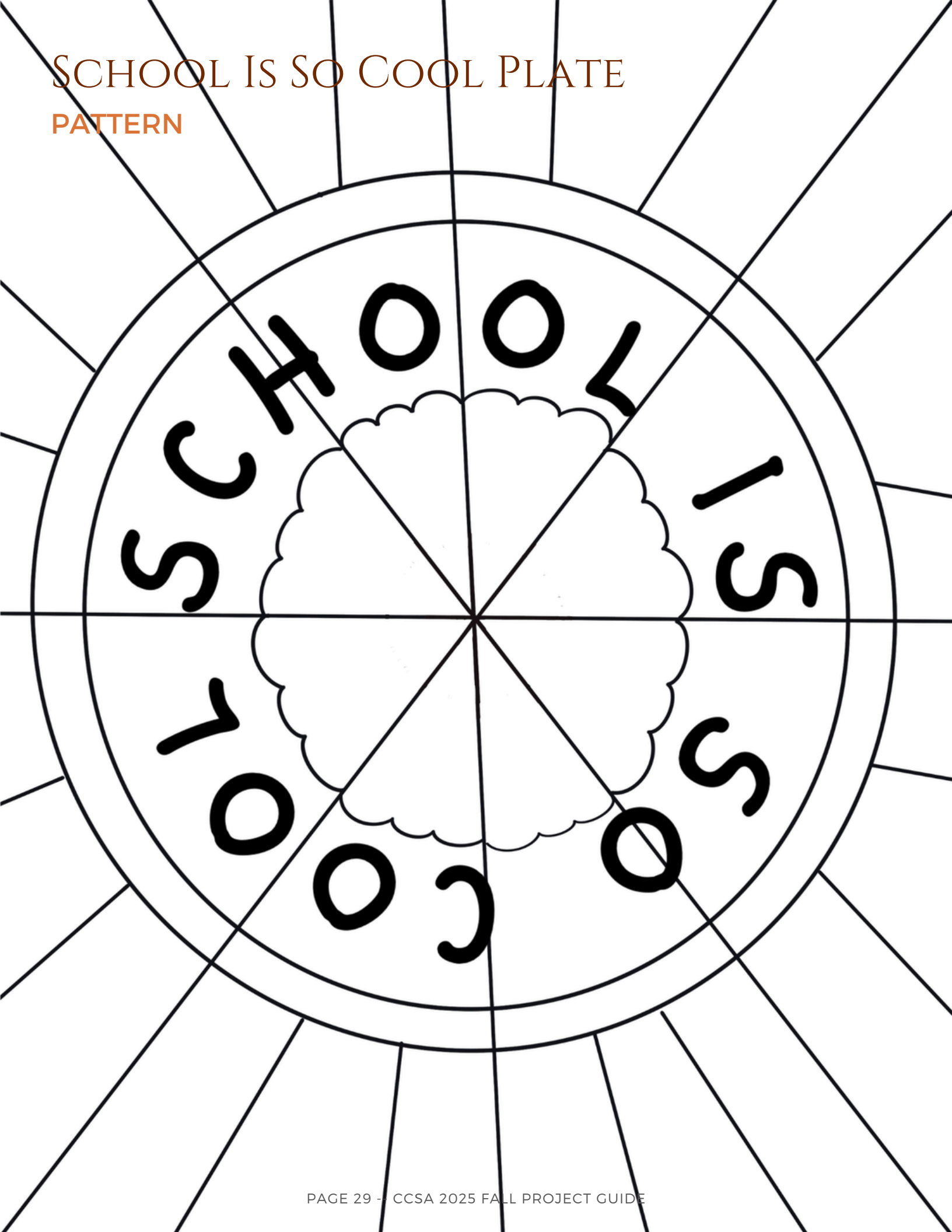
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't transfer the lettering onto the plate yet.
2. Paint each colored pencil with 3 coats of each color following the sample. This includes the point of the pencil too. Paint up to the traced pattern lines on each pencil. If you paint over the lines, use a sgraffito tool to scrape the line clean within each pencil, or else go over them with a thin line from a White writer bottle.
3. Paint the wood section of each pencil with 2-3 coats of Tan.
4. Paint the metal band with 2-3 coats of Dark Gray. Let dry.
5. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering to the plate.
6. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the letters, outline the metal band, and add a line between each pencil. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SNACKIN' SKULLY DIPPIN' SET

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate and 2" sauce dish

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Lavender, Black, Bright Lime Green

Writer bottles: White, Bright Lime Green



DIRECTIONS

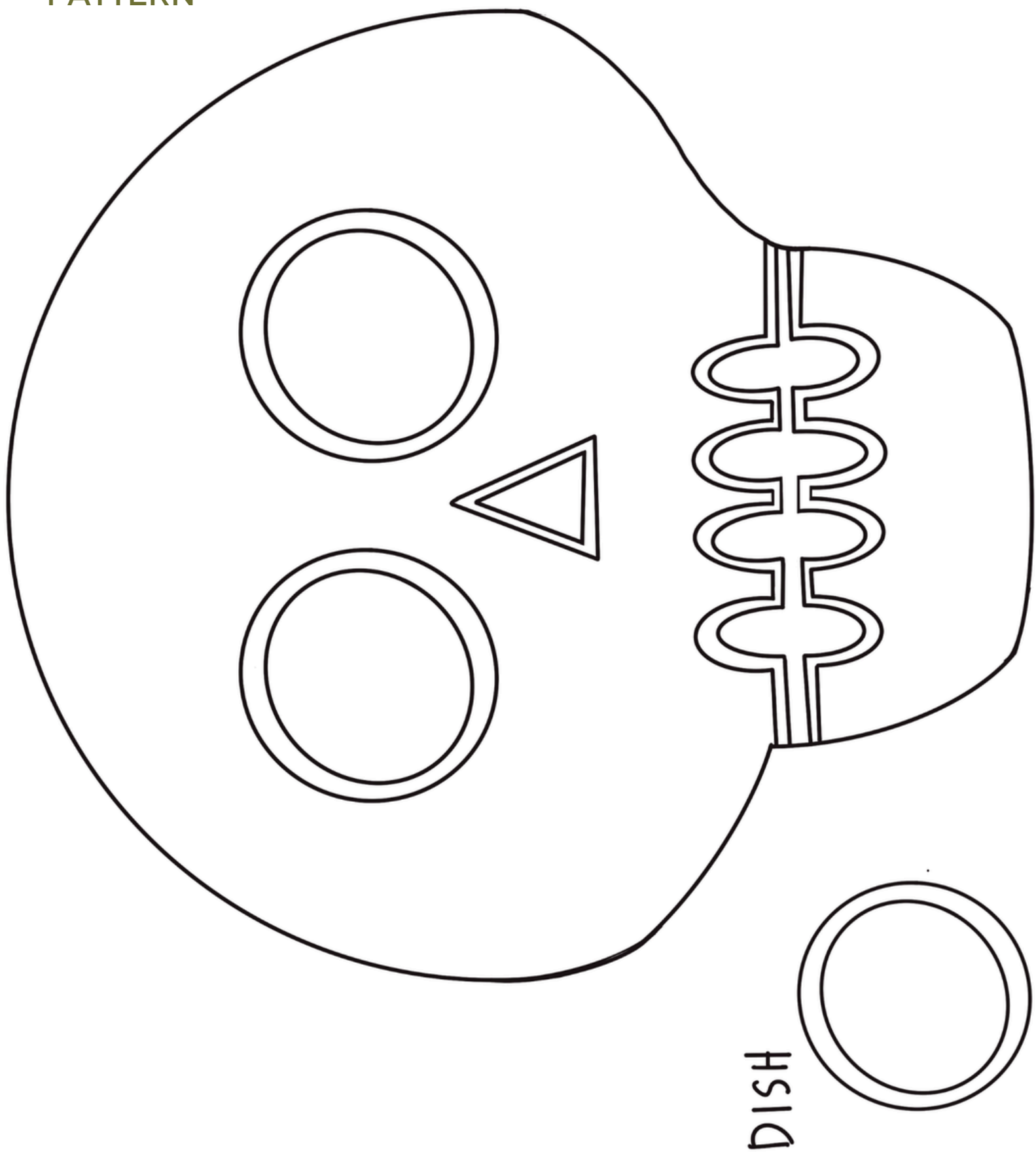
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the skull with 2–3 coats of Lavender.
3. Paint the eyes, nose, and mouth with 3 coats of Black.
4. With liner brush or writer bottle, make a thin outline around the eyes, nose, and mouth.
5. With the back end of a paintbrush, make alternating dots around the edge of the plate using all three colors, beginning and ending at the skull shape. To keep dot size uniform, be sure to dip the brush into color each time.
6. Paint the entire sauce dish, except for the lip of the dish, with 2–3 coats of Lavender. Paint the bottom inside circle with 3 coats of Black. Paint the lip of the dish with 2–3 coats of Bright Lime Green. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06. **NOTE: The pieces should be fired separately, not fused together.**

SWEATER WEATHER MUG

SUPPLIES

Bisque: 12-ounce mug

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Bright Teal Blue, White, Taupe

Writer bottle: Taupe



DIRECTIONS

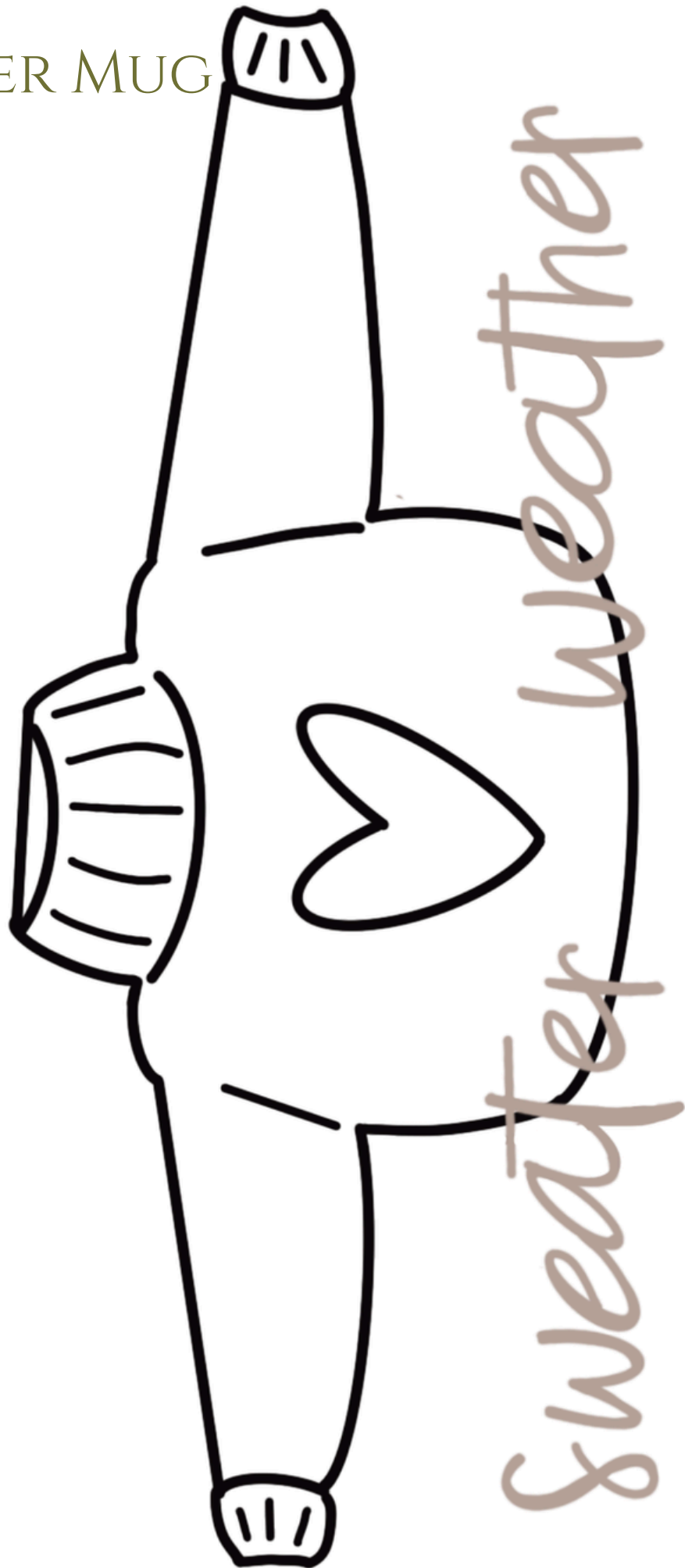
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Be sure the cuffs align near the mug handle. Don't transfer the lettering or the sweater details onto the mug yet.
2. Paint the sweater with 3 coats of Bright Teal Blue. Let dry.
3. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the heart, the sweater lines, and the lettering onto the mug.
4. Paint the heart and the sweater lines with 3 coats of White.
5. Using Taupe with a writer bottle or liner brush, outline the sweater and the heart, and fill in the lettering.
6. Dip the fat tip of large paintbrush into Bright Teal Blue and make random dots inside the mug and in the background of the outside. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Marker

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Pumpkin, Tan, White, Black

Writer bottles: White, Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the entire plate with 1 coat of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't transfer the lettering to the plate yet.
3. Paint the piecrust with 3 coats of Tan.
4. Paint the pie area with 3 coats of Pumpkin, avoiding the whip cream center.
5. With a liner brush or writer bottle, paint just the outside edge of the whip cream White. Let dry.
6. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering to the plate.
7. Fill in the lettering with Black using a writer bottle or liner brush. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
