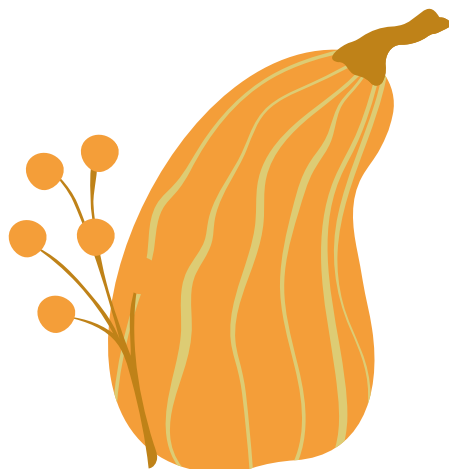
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BACK TO SCHOOL MUG

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Regular mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Blue painter's tape
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Light Blue, Red, Green, Brown, Pink
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Place the blue painter's tape in between the small stripes.
3. Paint the stripes with 2-3 coats of Light Blue. Remove the tape when dry.
4. Paint the vertical stripe and the apple with 2 coats of Red.
5. Paint the leaf with 2 coats of Green.
6. Paint the stem with 2 coats of Brown.
7. Paint the dots on the apple with 2 coats of Pink.
8. With a Black writer bottle, outline the apple elements and add a name to personalize the mug. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

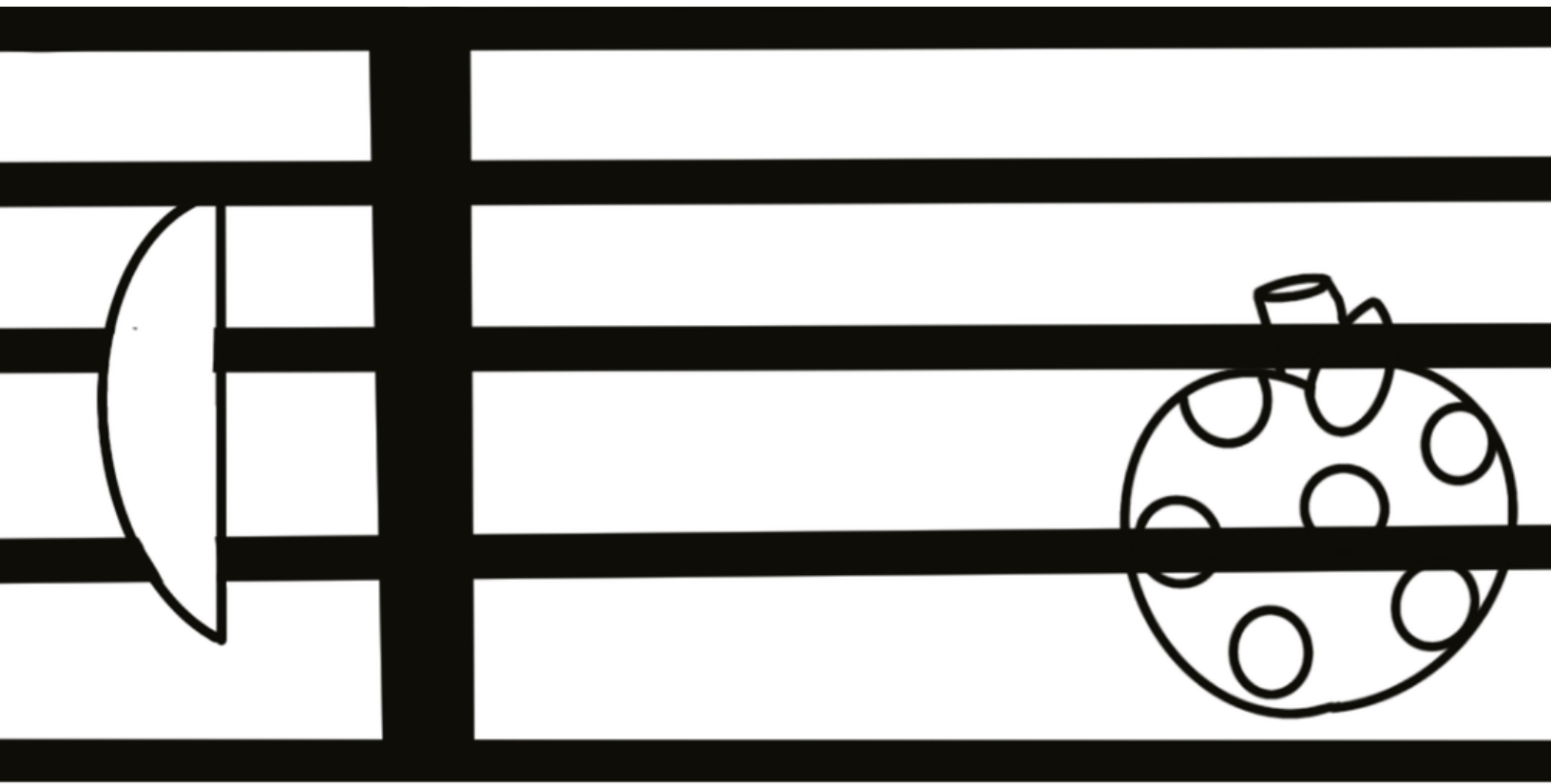

CANDLE CELEBRATION PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rim charger
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Bright Teal Blue, Bright Green, Yellow, Orange, Black
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint 2 of the candles Bright Teal Blue, 2 candles Bright Green, 2 candles Yellow, and the center candle Orange. (NOTE: Be sure candles of the same color are not painted adjacent to each other. The candle design is not meant to be a solid feature but to have whimsy and swirly edges.)
3. Paint the top banner on one Green candle with 2 coats of Orange.
4. Paint the top banner on one Yellow candle with 2 coats of Bright Green.
5. Paint the top banner on the other Yellow candle with 2 coats of Bright Teal Blue.
6. Paint the on the candle flames a mix of Yellow and Orange.
7. Mark off the rim of the charger in sections to create wide stripes. Mark each stripe very lightly in pencil with a letter to indicate color (e.g., Y for Yellow) around the rim to keep the color order when painting the stripes. Paint each stripe with 2 coats of the designated color.
8. Using Black with a small brush or writer bottle, paint a swirly design on each candle, and outline the banner tops on the candles that have them. Also make the design on each candle flame.
9. Dip the back end of a paintbrush into each color and make random dots in the center area around the candles.
10. With the Black writer bottle, make small dots all around the inside rim of the plate at the inner edge of the stripes. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

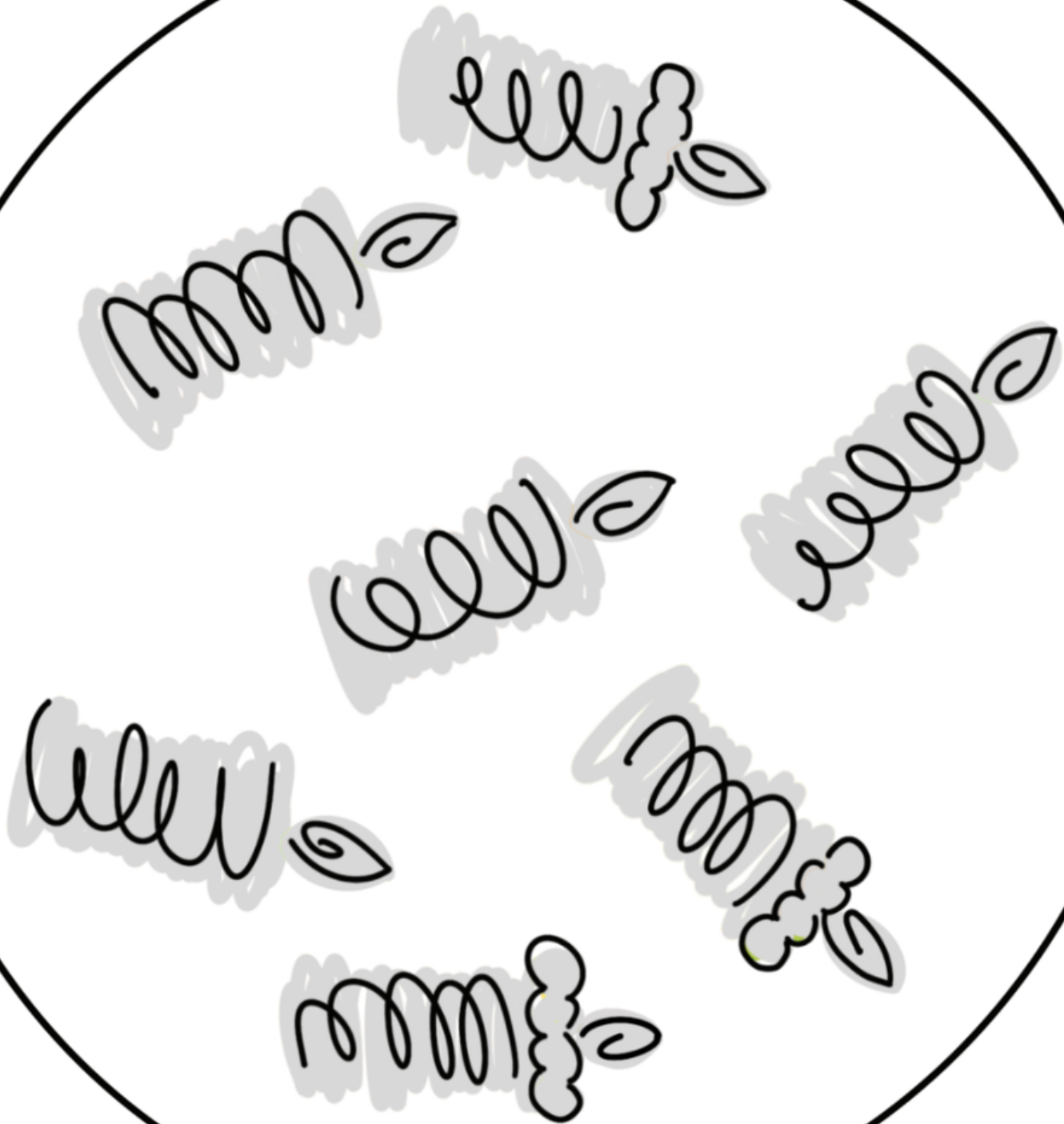

FALL BOWL

This pattern can be sized to fit various bisque types. The sample shown was enlarged, and utilized only two rows of the pattern.



SUPPLIES

Bisque: 4" tapered bowl
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes
Small square brush

GLAZE COLORS

Taupe, Pumpkin, Tan, Golden Yellow, Dark Olive Green
Writer bottles: Light Tan, Dark Olive Green, Pumpkin

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker and trace the design on the bowl. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) NOTE: It may be easier to trace the line sections of the pattern onto the bowl, and then cut out the small designs and place these cutout sections separately to trace them onto the bowl.
2. Paint the stripes with 2 coats of Taupe.
3. Mushrooms: Paint the mushroom top with 3 coats of Pumpkin and the stem with 2 coats of Tan. Once dry, outline the mushroom and make the details with a Light Tan writer bottle.
4. Two-leaf design: Paint the leaves with 2 coats of Golden Yellow. Once dry, outline the leaves with a Dark Olive Green writer bottle.
5. Three-leaf design: Paint the leaves with 2 coats of Dark Olive Green. Once dry, outline the leaves with a Pumpkin writer bottle.
6. In the remaining open square sections, use a writer bottle to make dots in Dark Olive Green.
7. If desired, splatter the inside of the bowl with Dark Olive Green. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

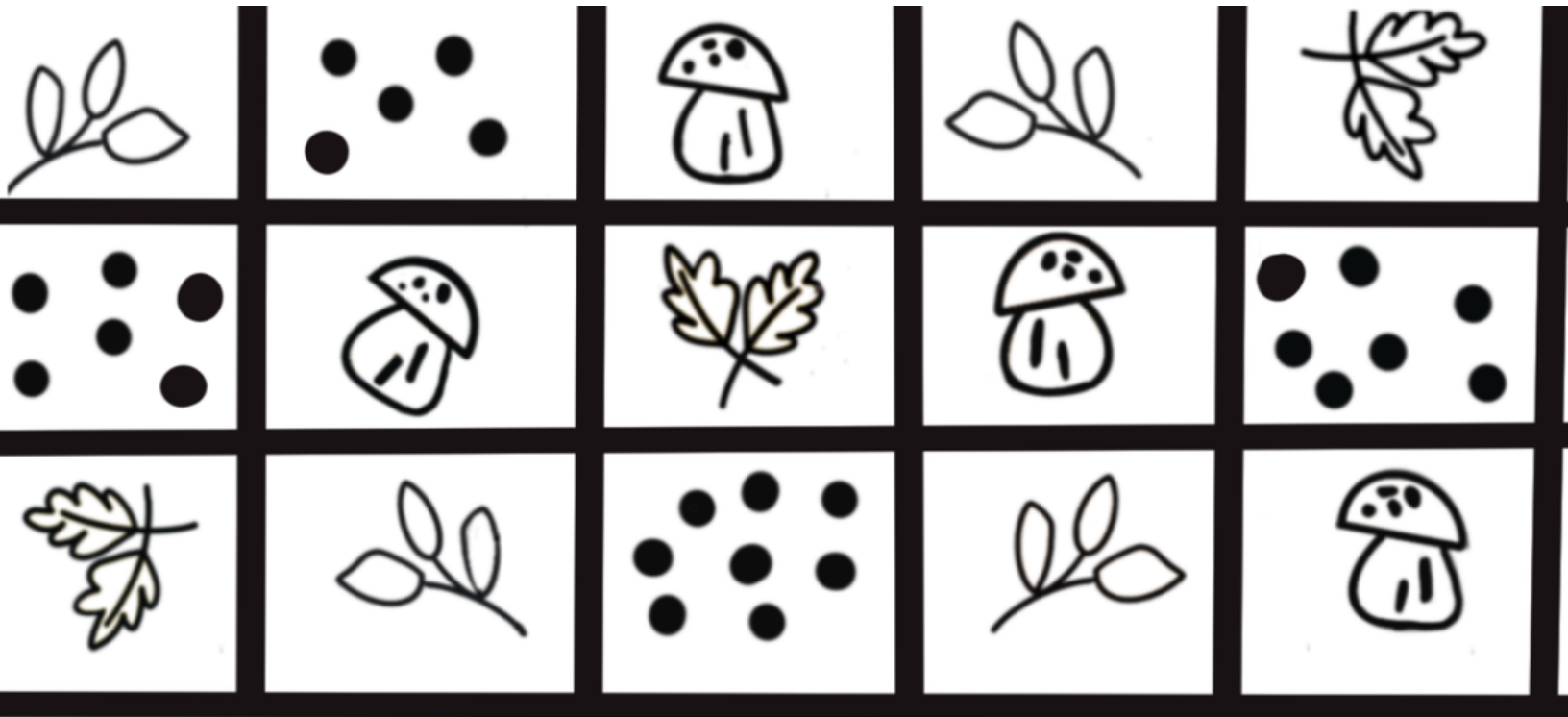

FALL FAMILY PORTRAIT PLATE

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Square dinner plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium brushes
Fan brush
Water

GLAZE COLORS

Bright Teal Blue, Pink, Mint Green, Teal Green, Black, Gray
Writer bottles: Black, White



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the ghost on left with 2 coats of Bright Teal Blue.
3. Paint the ghost on the right with 2 coats of Pink.
4. Paint the small ghost in the middle with 2 coats of Mint Green.
5. Paint the spider and the ghost features with 2 coats of Black.
6. Paint the bow with 2 coats of Teal Green.
7. Once all of the painted areas are dry, water down Gray. Using a fan brush, paint over the entire design from left to right, lightly covering the entire plate with 1 coat.
8. With the Black writer bottle, outline each ghost and make sketchy, wavy lines around the edges of the plate.
9. With a White writer bottle, add 2 dots for eyes on the spider. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe salad plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

White, Brown, Green, Gray

Writer bottles: Golden Yellow, White



DIRECTIONS

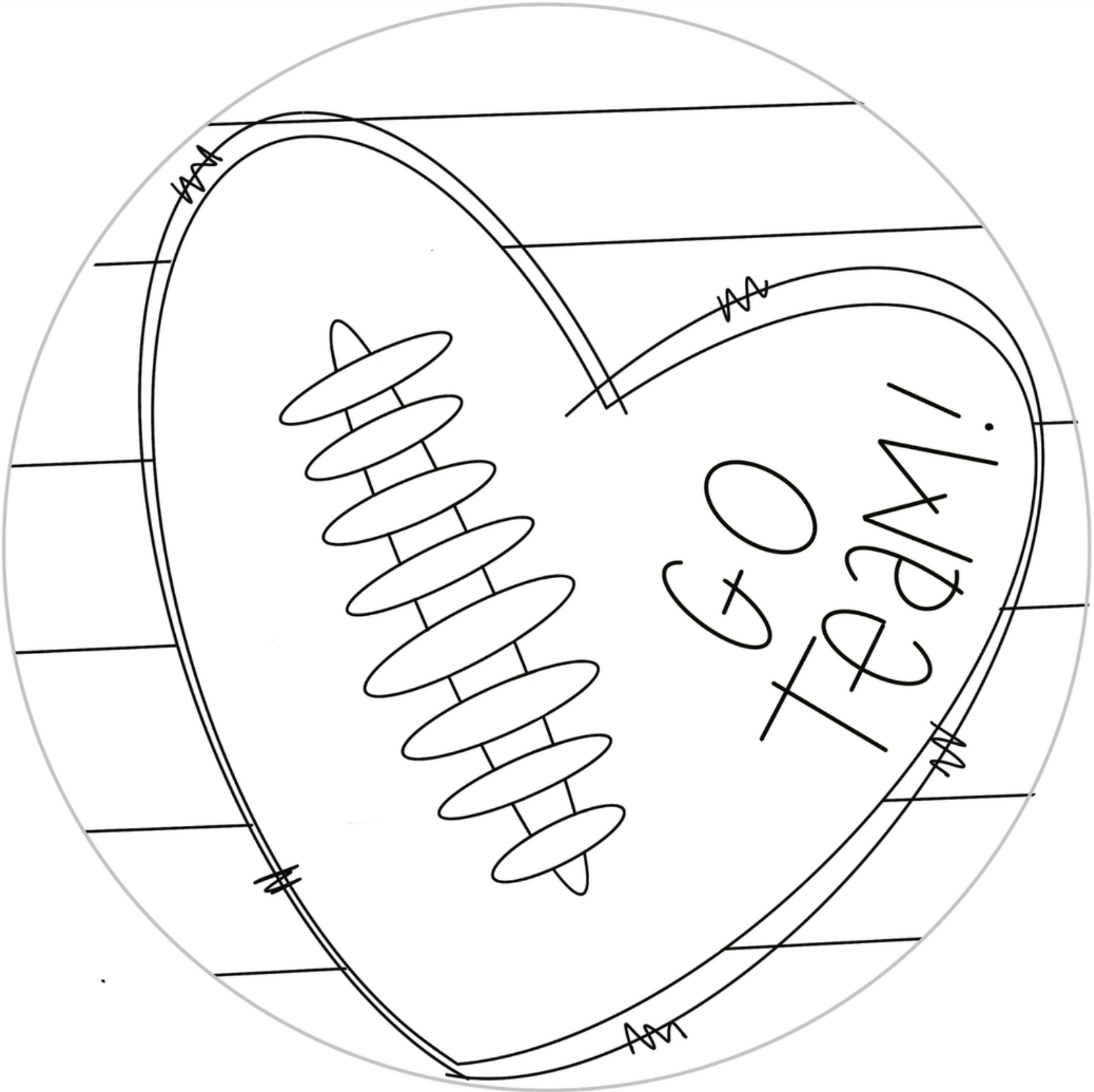
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering, the football cross-stitching lines, or the heart outline onto the plate yet. (You'll do this in step 5.)
2. Paint the center line on the football with 2 coats of White.
3. Paint the heart shape with 3 coats of Brown.
4. Paint area surrounding the heart with 3 coats of Green.
5. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering, the cross-stitching lines, and the heart outline to the plate.
6. Paint the stitching lines with 2 coats of Gray.
7. Fill in the lettering with a Golden Yellow writer bottle.
8. With a White writer bottle, outline the heart and add squiggles in the outline. Also, paint the field lines across the green background. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

HAP-PIE THANKSGIVING PLATTER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rounded-corner platter
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Dark Tan, Pumpkin, Golden Yellow
Writer bottle: Dark Brown



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering or the detail lines onto the plate yet. (You'll do this in step 6.)
2. Paint the whipped cream center with 2 coats of Cream.
3. Paint the crust with 2–3 coats of Dark Tan.
4. Paint the pie with 2–3 coats of Pumpkin.
5. Paint the bow with 3 coats of Golden Yellow. Let dry.
6. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering, the bow details, and the pie details to the plate.
7. Using a Dark Brown writer bottle, fill in the lettering and outline all the design elements and add the details. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

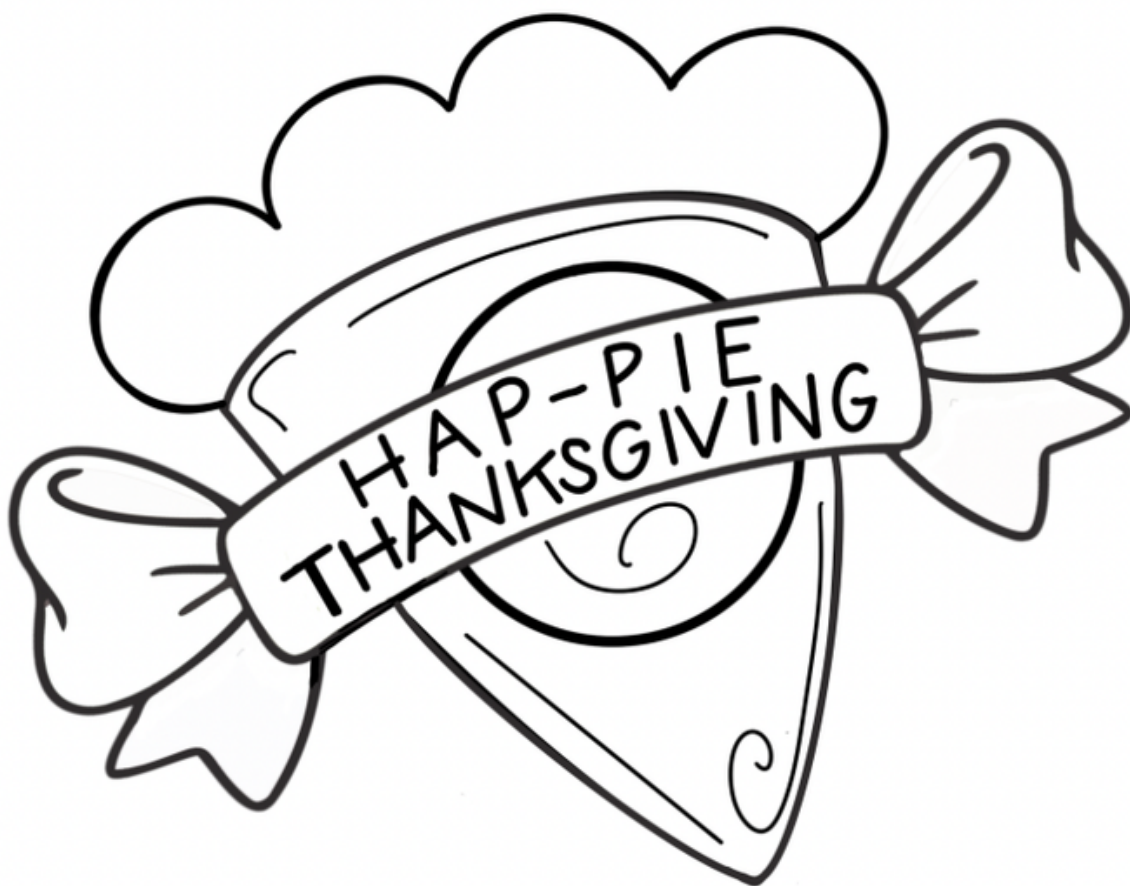

HAPPY FALL PLATTER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rounded square platter

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes



GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Olive Green, Pumpkin, Golden Yellow, Orange, Dark Olive Green, Brown

Writer bottle: Black

DIRECTIONS

1. Basecoat the platter with 1 coat of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering, the leaf veins, or the stitching onto the platter yet. (You'll do that in step 9.)
3. Paint the center shape with 2 coats of Olive Green.
4. Paint the leaf with 2-3 coat of Pumpkin.
5. Paint the sunflower petals with 3 coats of Golden Yellow.
6. Paint the berries with 3 coats of Orange.
7. Paint the leaf on the berry stem with 3 coats of Dark Olive Green.
8. Paint the sunflower center with 2 coats of Brown. Let dry.
9. Reposition the tissue tracing on the platter and transfer the lettering, the leaf veins, and the stitching.
10. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering, the leaf veins, and the stitching, and outline the all the elements. Let dry.
11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

HUDDLE UP PITCHER

Patterns of several sizes are provided to accommodate various bisque shapes.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Mason jar pitcher or mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Black, Green
Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque so that the stripes cover about a third of the bisque surface and the remaining pattern covers two-thirds, and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. With a small brush or writer bottle, fill in the lettering on the banner in Black.
3. Paint the bows on the banner pole and the #1 finger shape Green.
4. Using the Black writer bottle, add the various details and shapes and outline the Green shapes.
5. Paint every other stripe with 3 coats of Black. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

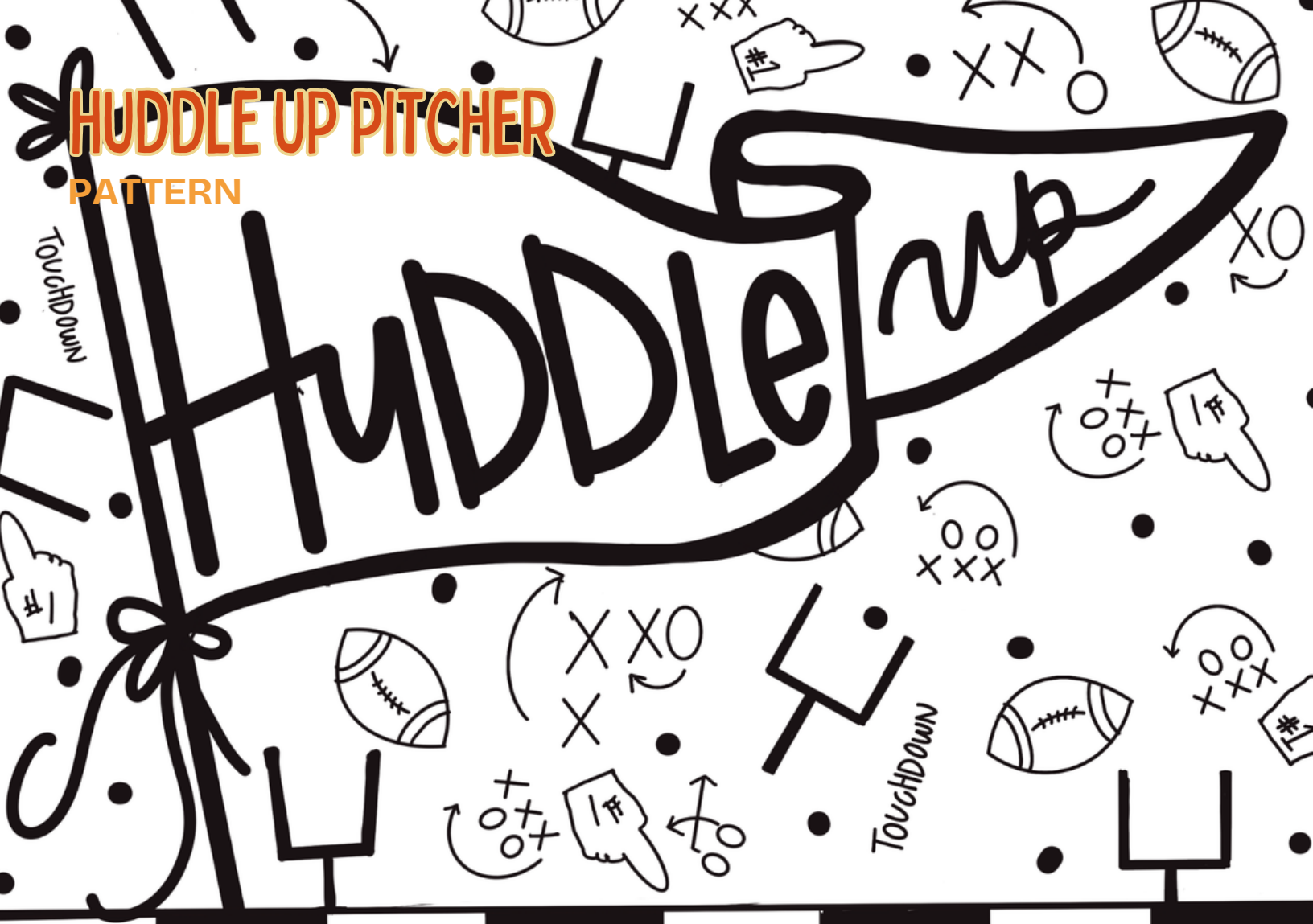

LET'S GO SERVER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rectangular server tray
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Contact paper (or ¼" blue painter's tape)
Scissors
Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Medium Green, Black, Brown
Writer bottle: White

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Trace only the field goal on this step. (You'll trace the rest in step 4.)
2. Trace the field goal sections onto contact paper and cut out. To conserve materials, do not cut out the field goal in one large design as it will cause a lot of waste, so reposition the tissue tracing to trace the separate segments next to each other. Adhere the cutout segments (or painter's tape) over the traced areas on the bisque.
3. Paint the entire plate with 2 coats of Medium Green.
4. Once dry, reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering and all the other design elements to the bisque.
5. Remove the field goal stickers.
6. Paint the lettering with 2 coats of Black.
7. Paint the football with 2 coats of Brown.
8. Using White writer bottle, trace the stitches on the football, the play details, and the lines on the field. (NOTE: the top lines differ from the lines along the bottom of the tray.) Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

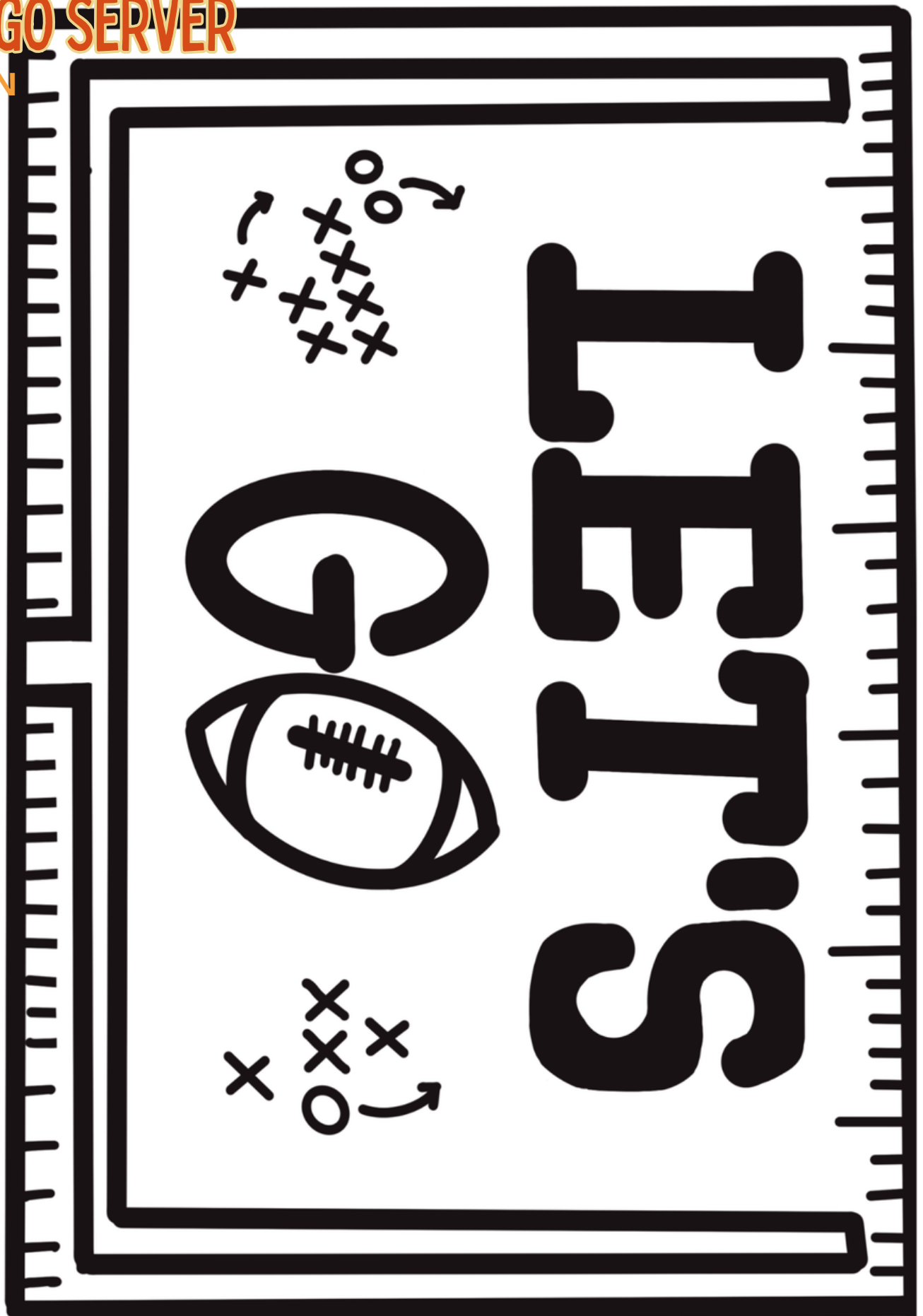

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Oval coupe server
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium liner brushes
Chippy craft brush

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Taupe, Coffee Brown,
Writer bottle: Cream



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the background of the bisque with 1 coat of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the bird details to the bisque yet. (You'll do that in step 5.)
3. Paint the birds with 3 coats of Taupe.
4. Paint the branches with 2-3 coats of Coffee Brown. Avoid painting over the little lines on each branch.
5. Once dry, reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the bird details onto the bisque.
6. Using the Cream writer bottle, fill in the designs on the birds. Notice the different sizes of dots on each design.
7. Using the Cream writer bottle, make the sets of four lines on each branch. (NOTE: The lines should not touch entirely.)
8. Once everything is dry, dip the tip of the chippy brush in Coffee Brown and drag it across the server using horizontal brushstrokes. The goal is to give a worn, aged look along the edges and small areas in the design. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

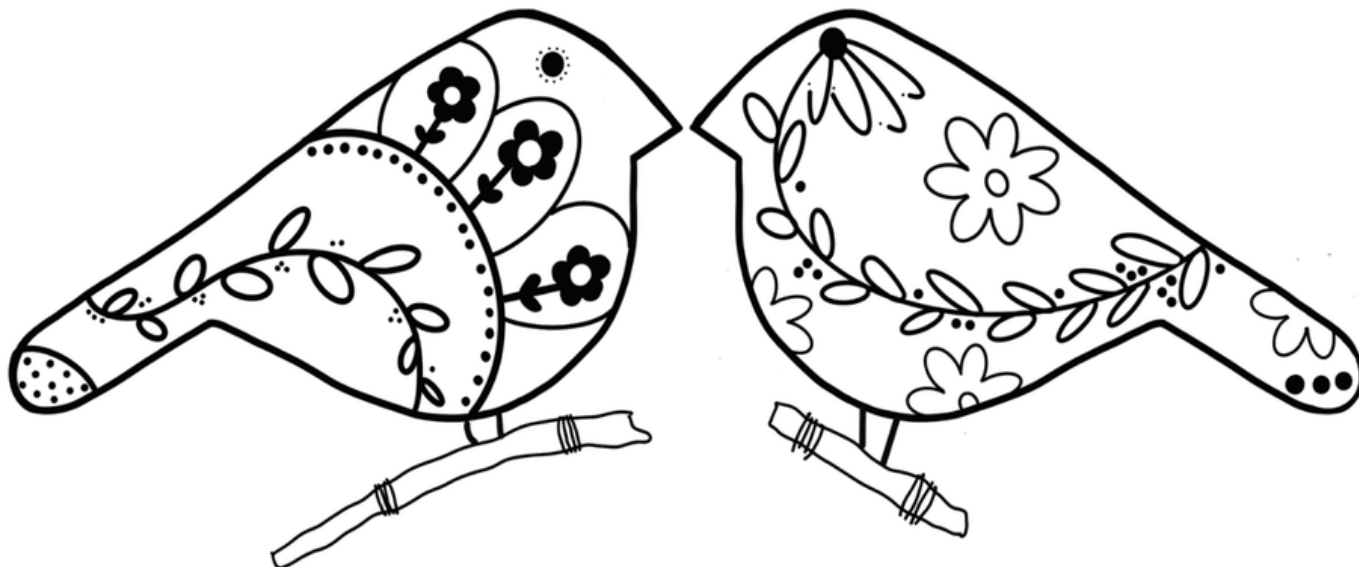

MELLOW MUSHROOM MUG

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Regular mug
Pattern
Tissue paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Small and medium liner brushes
½" sponge dotter



GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Dark Brown, Coffee Brown, Olive Green
Writer bottles: Olive Green

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the tops of the mushrooms with 1 coat of Cream.
3. When the Cream is dry, paint the mushroom tops with 3 coats of Dark Brown, painting around the polka dot shapes.
4. Paint the stems with 3 coats of Coffee Brown.
5. Paint the bows with 3 coats of Olive Green.
6. With small brush or writer bottle, paint a line in Olive Green that attaches all of the bows to the mushrooms.
7. Dip ½" sponge dotter in Olive Green and place half of the dotter along the top edge of the mug to make a half circle. Continue all the way around the mug, overlapping the dots slightly. Repeat this step for the bottom edge of the mug. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

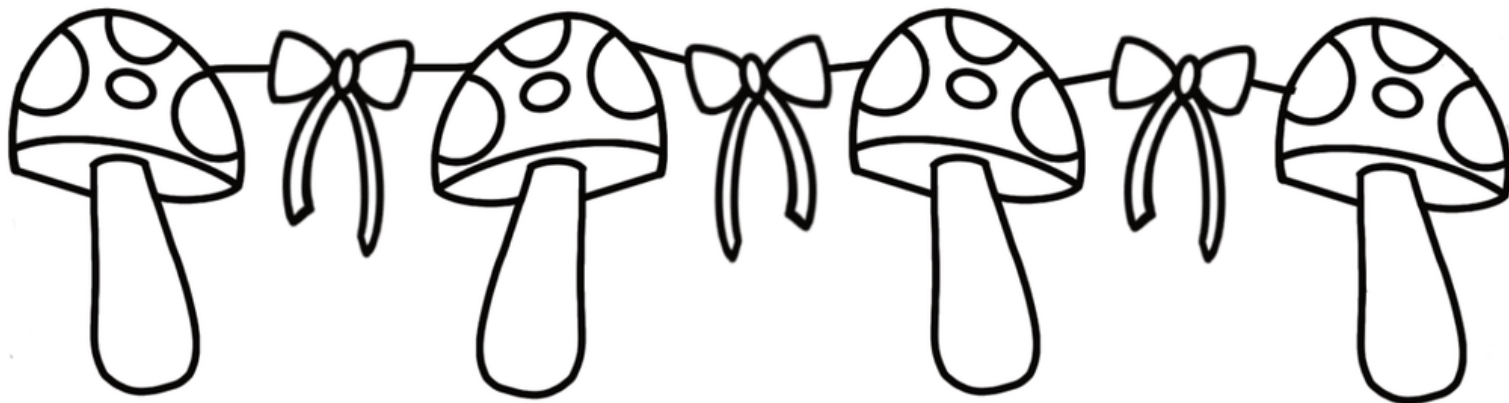

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe salad plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

3" Hydra sponge

Q-tip

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Medium Brown, Dark Brown

Writer bottle: Red



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the plate with 1 coat of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Dip the hydra sponge in Medium Brown, making sure it's loaded evenly. Stamp the sponge onto a traced cookie shape. Repeat this step for each cookie.
4. Dip the Q-tip in Dark Brown and add dots on the cookies for the chips.
5. With a small brush, outline the cookies. Don't make perfect outlines—the lines should be irregular and a bit uneven.
6. With a Red writer bottle, fill in the lettering. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

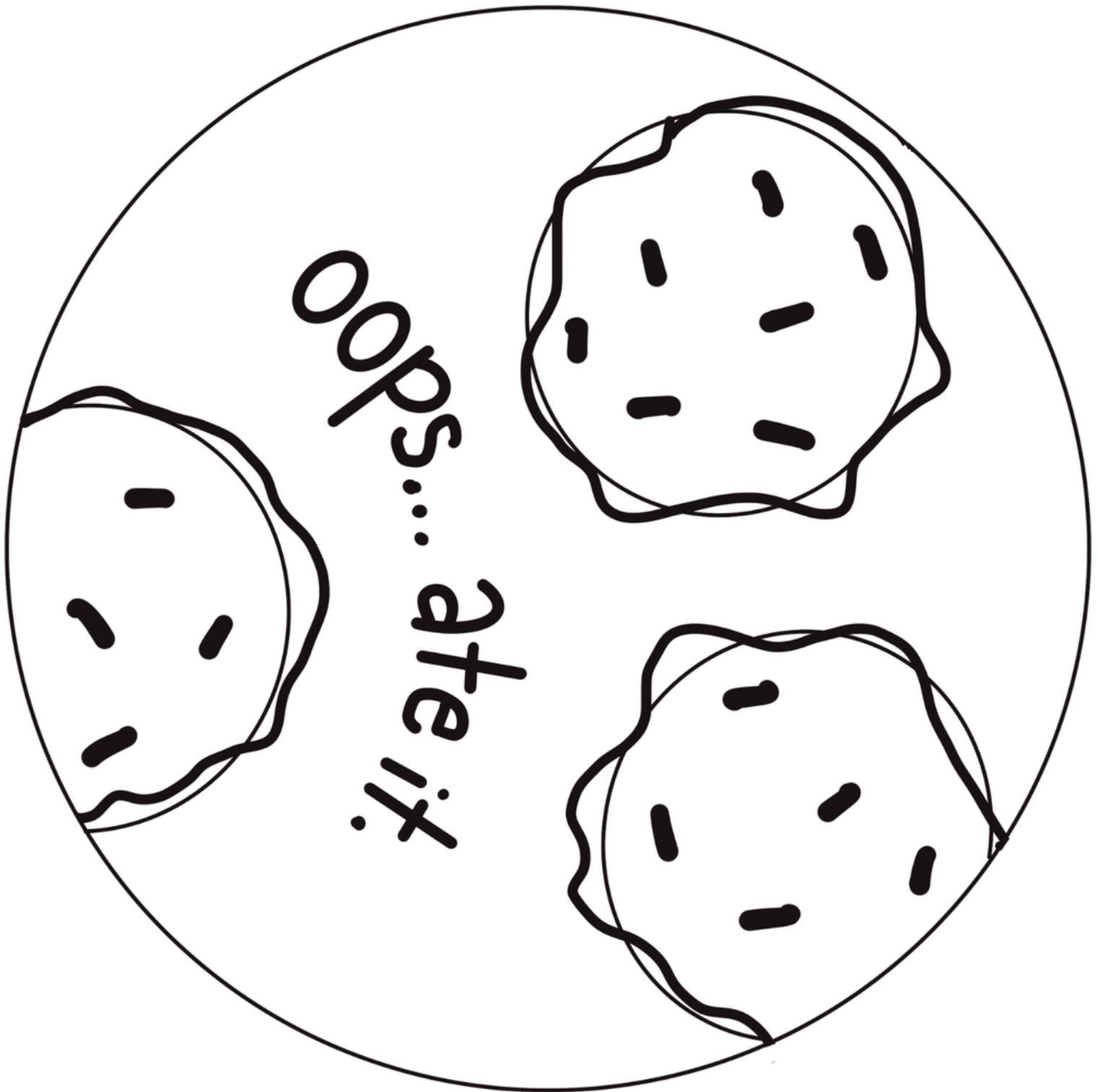

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Regular mug

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes



GLAZE COLORS

Medium Blue, Orange, Dark Blue, Burgundy

DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the leaves with 3 coats of Medium Blue.
3. Paint the pumpkins with 3 coats of Orange.
4. Paint the veins on the leaves Dark Blue.
5. Paint the lines on the pumpkins Burgundy.
6. Paint Orange dots on the background of the mug, spaced out between the leaves and pumpkins.
7. Paint the inside of the mug with 3 coats of Medium Blue. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe dinner plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

GLAZE COLORS

Cream, Gray, Brown, Burgundy, Red

Writer bottles: Golden Yellow, Dark Gray



DIRECTIONS

1. Paint the center of the plate with 2 coats of Cream.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Very lightly, in pencil, mark an X on the squares that will be Red.
4. Paint the fork with 2 coats of Gray.
5. Paint the meatball with 2 coats of Brown.
6. Paint the spaghetti sauce and drops with 3 coats of Burgundy.
7. With a Golden Yellow writer bottle, make the spaghetti. Be sure to leave space between the spaghetti strands on the fork.
8. Paint each square marked with an X with 2-3 coats of Red.
9. Once dry, outline the fork, the center circle, and the checkered pattern with a Dark Gray writer bottle. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

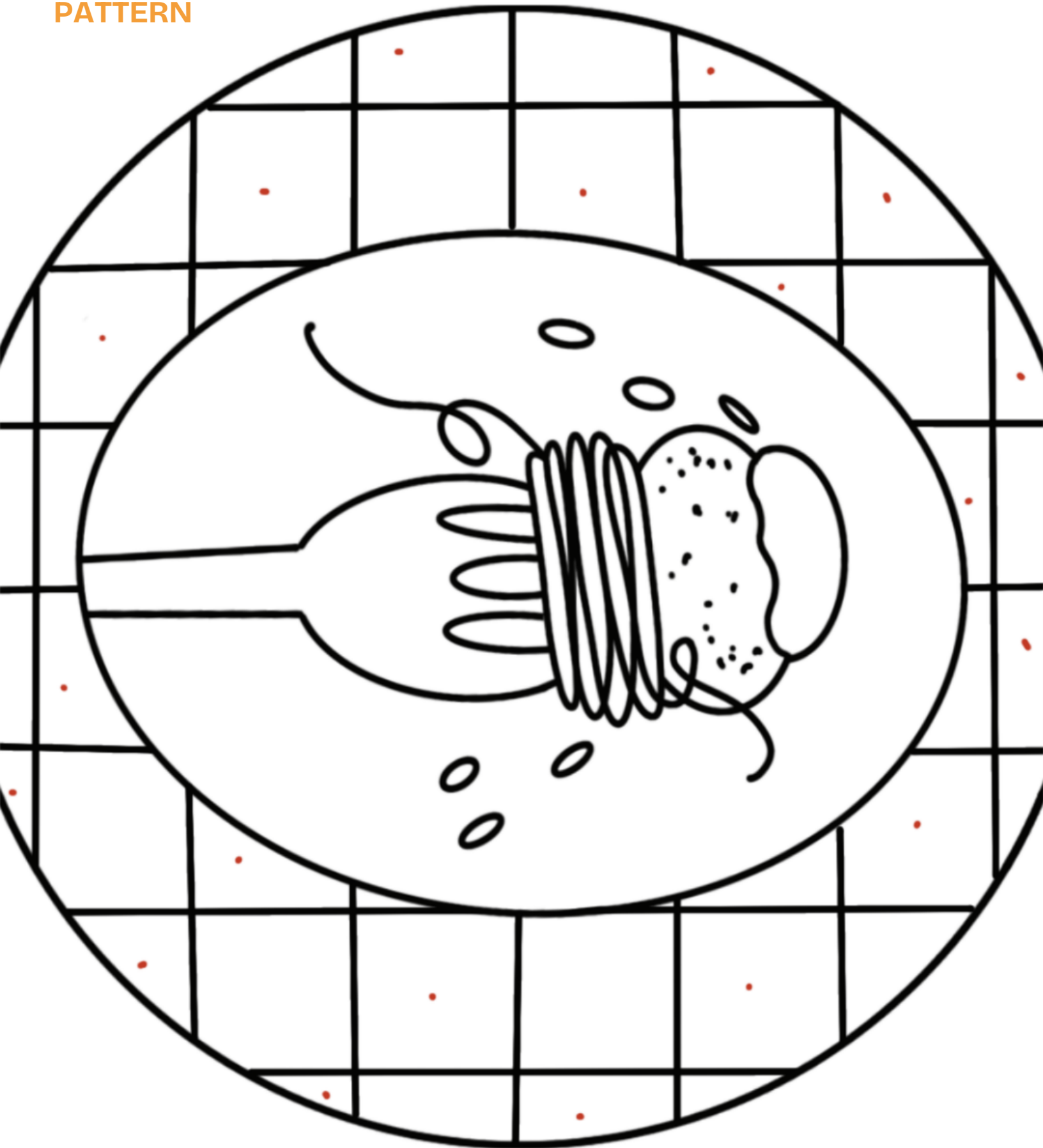

WITCHY BOW CHARGER

SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rim or coupe charger

Pattern

Blue painters tape

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

1" sponge dotter

¼" sponge dotter

GLAZE COLORS

Lavender, Black, Berry Purple

Writer bottle: Black



DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the background with 3 coats of Lavender.
3. Paint the hat sections with 3 coats of Black.
4. Paint the bow with 3 coats of Berry Purple.
5. With a Black writer bottle, outline the bow and add the central details.
6. Dip a 1" sponge dotter in Black and make dots in the background. Be sure to place the dotter down carefully—don't smash it down or it will distort the circle. (Tip: Follow the placement shown in the sample for a symmetrical arrangement.)
7. Dip a ¼" dotter in Berry Purple and make small dots, again following the sample as a guide. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
