- 7. Use White and Black writer bottles to add dots, dashes, or sketchy outline to the painted stars.
- 8. Add a dot pattern around the edge of the plate with a Red writer bottle. Let dry.
- 9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.







- 7. Dip the back end tip of a paintbrush into each color and fill the center of the bowl and edge along the top with colored dots. Let dry.



- 3. Following the traced pattern, paint the back of the first icy paper shape with a heavy coat of Purple. Position the painted shape on top of the corresponding traced pattern color side down. Tap the painted paper onto the mug to remove any air bubbles, but be careful not to squeeze out the paint along the edges. If this happens, dip a paintbrush in water and use it to carefully clean up the edges and then wiping away with a sponge. Repeat this step with each color following the paint sequence of Red, Bright Blue, Orange, Green, Purple, and Red. Leave all the paper shapes in place for now
- 4. Dip a damp sponge into Bright Yellow and sponge paint the mug background, avoiding the traced shapes.
- 5. With White writer bottle, fill in the package area around the icy shapes.
- 6. Remove the painted paper shapes.
- 7. With Black writer bottle, outline the edges of the icy shapes and the packaging. Let dry.
- 8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

- 6. Paint the detail stripes on the flags with 3 coats of Red.
- 7. Paint the top flag with 3 coats of Red.
- 8. With Medium Blue writer bottle, paint a heavy coat of wave lines.
- 9. Retrace the lettering on the flag, if necessary, and fill in the letters with a Black writer bottle.
- 10. With the Black writer bottle, outline the flags, mast poles, and the outer edge of the whale.
- 11. Dip the back end of a paintbrush in Dark Blue and add dots on the belly of the whale. Do not make dots right under the face or at the tip of the tail.
- 12. Dip brush in water and slight water down Medium Blue. Paint the areas inside the wave lines with 1 light coat.
- 13. Dip brush in water and slightly water down Light Blue. Paint the areas inside the wave lines with 1–2 light coats.
- 14. With Light Blue writer bottle, paint dots around the rim from one water edge to the other water edge. Let dry.

- 2. Cut out the UFO light rays from the pattern and set aside.
- 3. Paint the hand with Bright Yellow and position the fingers so they each fall within one of the UFO light rays.
- 4. With a damp sponge, sponge paint Light Blue over the entire background, avoiding the traced pattern. Place the coordinating pattern cut outs over the light rays to keep them clean, and sponge up to the paper cutouts. This will especially help when painting the small blue sections between the light rays. While paper is in place, dip the same sponge in Dark Blue and sponge 1 coat on the background area.
- 5. Lightly draw an outline around the handprint with pencil, leaving white space in between the line and the handprint.
- 6. Paint the UFO ship with 3 coats of Bright Green, painting up to the traced handprint line.
- 7. Paint the UFO light rays with 3 coats of Bright Yellow, painting up to the traced handprint line.
- 8. With a Medium Green writer bottle, outline the UFO and the light rays.
- 9. With Medium Green, Bright Green, and Orange writer bottles, paint alternating stripes in the bottom section of the UFO.
- 10. Reposition the tissue tracing on the plate and transfer the lettering. Fill in the letters with a Bright Yellow writer bottle. Let dry.
- 11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
