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# Berry Sweet Bowl

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Bowl with 3" side

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Red, Taupe, Coffee, Green

Writer bottles: Black, White



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering onto the bowl yet. Be sure to trace the design on both sides of the bowl.
2. Paint the bottom portion of the bowl with 3 coats of Red, avoiding the banners.
3. Paint the inside of the banners with 1 coat of Taupe.
4. Paint the outside of the border of the banners with 1 coat of Coffee.
5. Paint the inside of the bowl and the scalloped edge of the design around the outside of the bowl with 3 coats of Green.
6. Reposition the tissue tracing and trace the lettering onto the banners.
7. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the lettering, and outline the banner and the Green scalloped edge.
8. With a White writer bottle, paint with dots in the Red portion of the bowl. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06

# Best Dad Award Plate

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe charger  
Pattern  
Tissue paper  
Pencil  
Sharpie  
Small and medium liner brushes  
Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Golden Yellow, Red, Black  
Writer bottles: Black, Golden Yellow, Red



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the award and make five highlight lines above the cup with 2-3 coats of Golden Yellow, avoiding the lettering as much as possible on the cup part of the design.
3. Paint the letters DAD and assigned stripes on the award with 3 coats of Red.
4. Paint the word BEST and AWARD with 2-3 coats of Black.
5. With a Black writer bottle, outline the award cup, the striped sections, and the word DAD.
7. With a Golden Yellow writer bottle, paint star shapes and a few dot clusters on the plate background.
8. With a Red writer bottle, paint single dots on the plate background.
9. With a Black writer bottle, create a light, sketchy outline around the five Golden Yellow highlight lines above the cup. Let dry.
10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

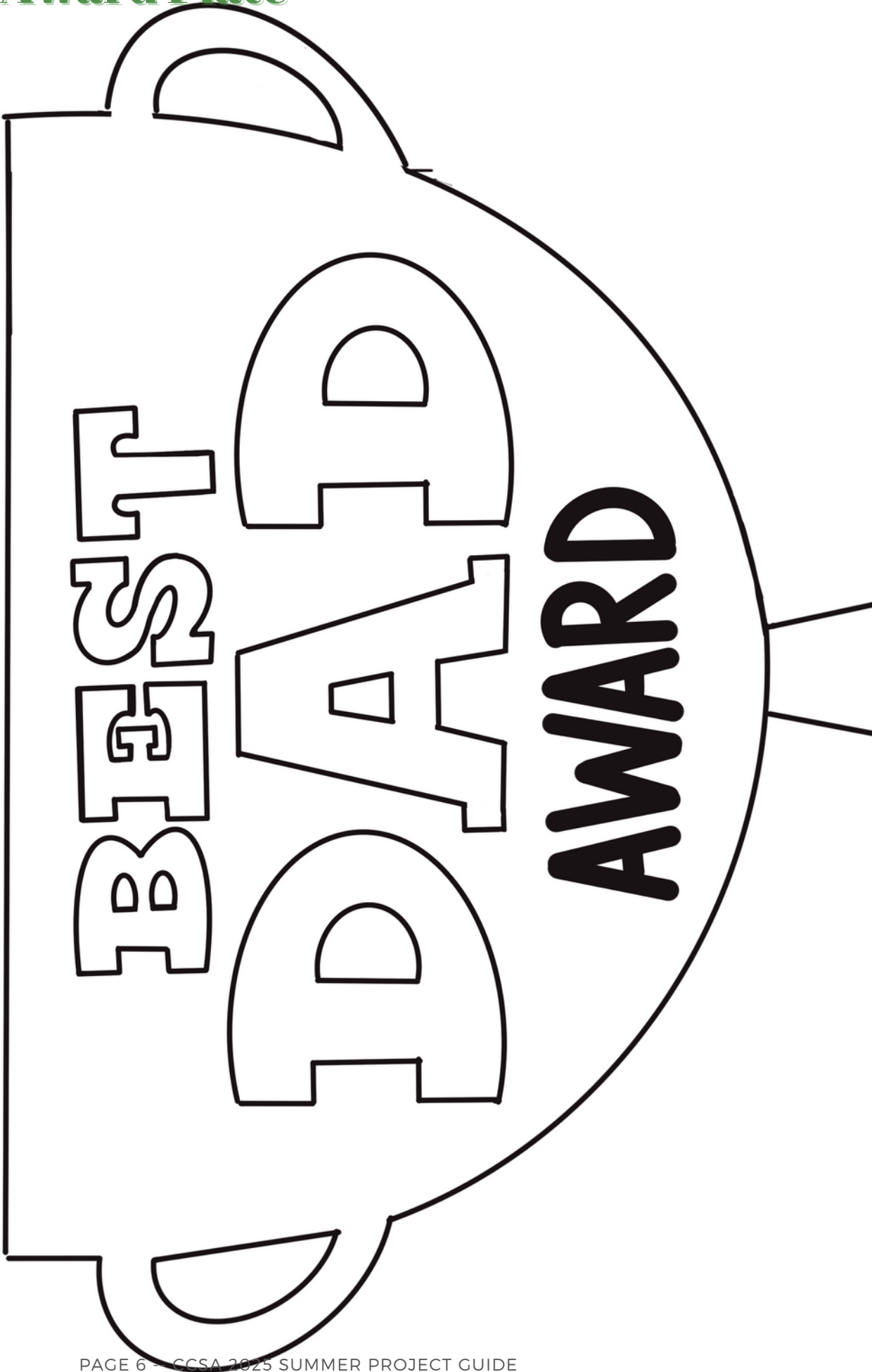

# Blues-berries Plate

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Coupe salad plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

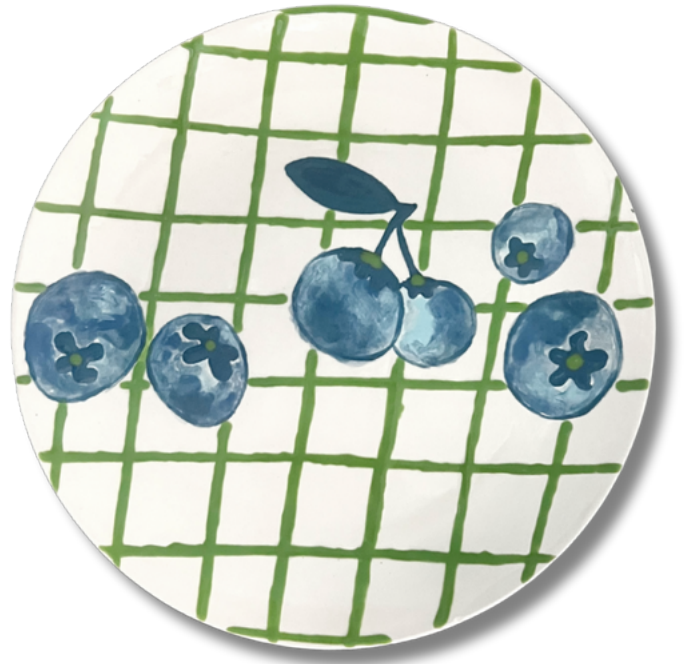
Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

### GLAZE COLORS

Dark Blue, Medium Blue, Bright Light Blue

Writer bottles: Dark Blue, Kelly Green



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Mix water with Dark Blue using two times as much water as glaze. Dab the paint inside the blueberry shapes. Focus along the inside edges of the berries. Repeat this step with Medium Blue. Paint areas can overlap and blend randomly; do not follow any pattern.
3. Dip a wet paint brush in Bright Light Blue and dab into any remaining blank sections in the berries. Focus the Bright Light Blue around the stem flower shape.
4. With a Dark Blue writer bottle, paint the leaf, stems, stem flower shapes, and outlines of each blueberry.
5. If desired, sketch the plaid pattern on the plate with washable marker or pencil.
6. Paint the plaid lines with a Kelly Green writer bottle.
7. Paint a Kelly Green dot on each stem flower shape. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

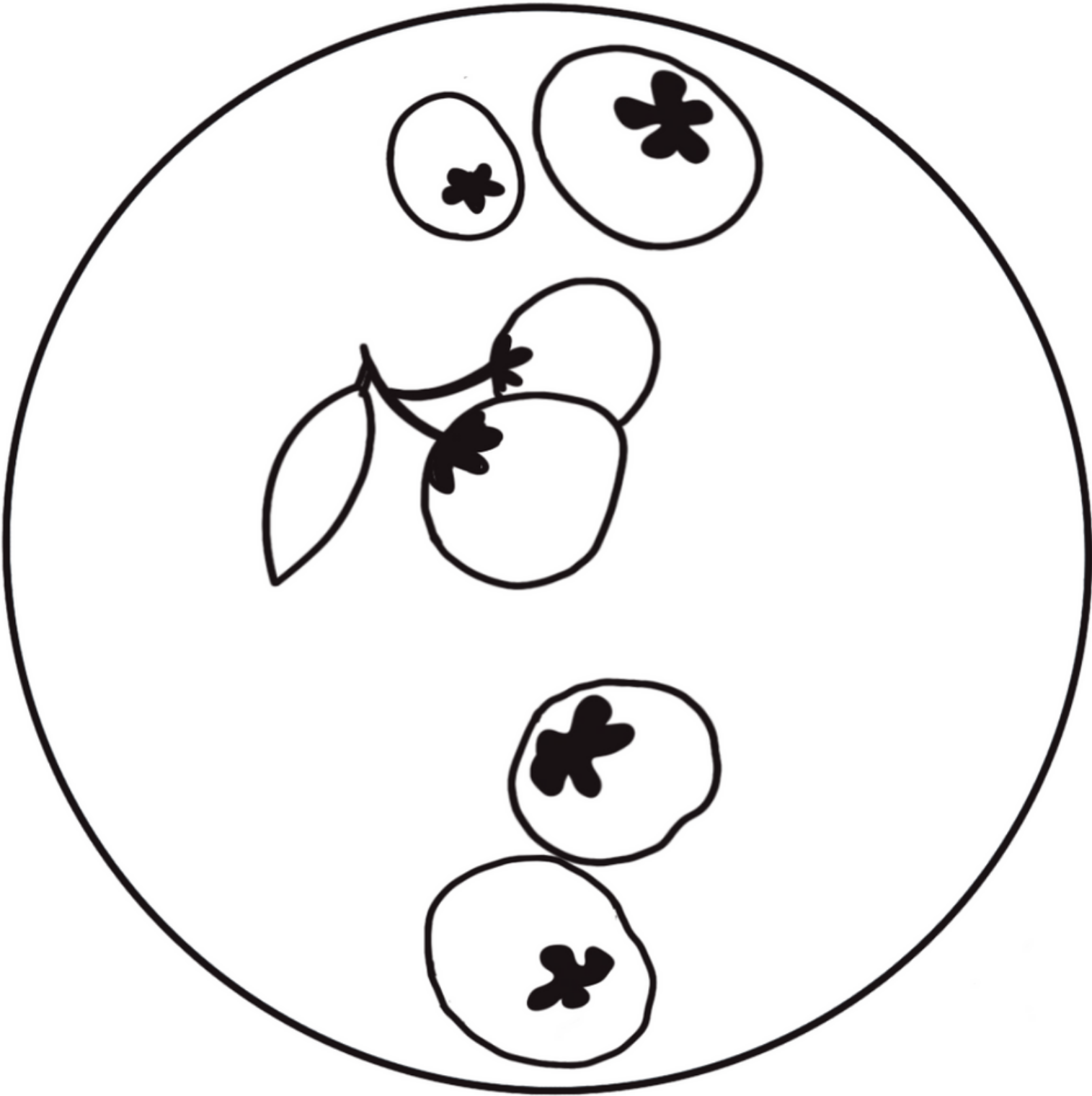

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: 12-ounce mug

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

Paper



### GLAZE COLORS

Tan, Green, Brown, Red, Golden Yellow, Olive Green, Cream

Writer Dark Green, Burgundy, Dark Brown

### DIRECTIONS

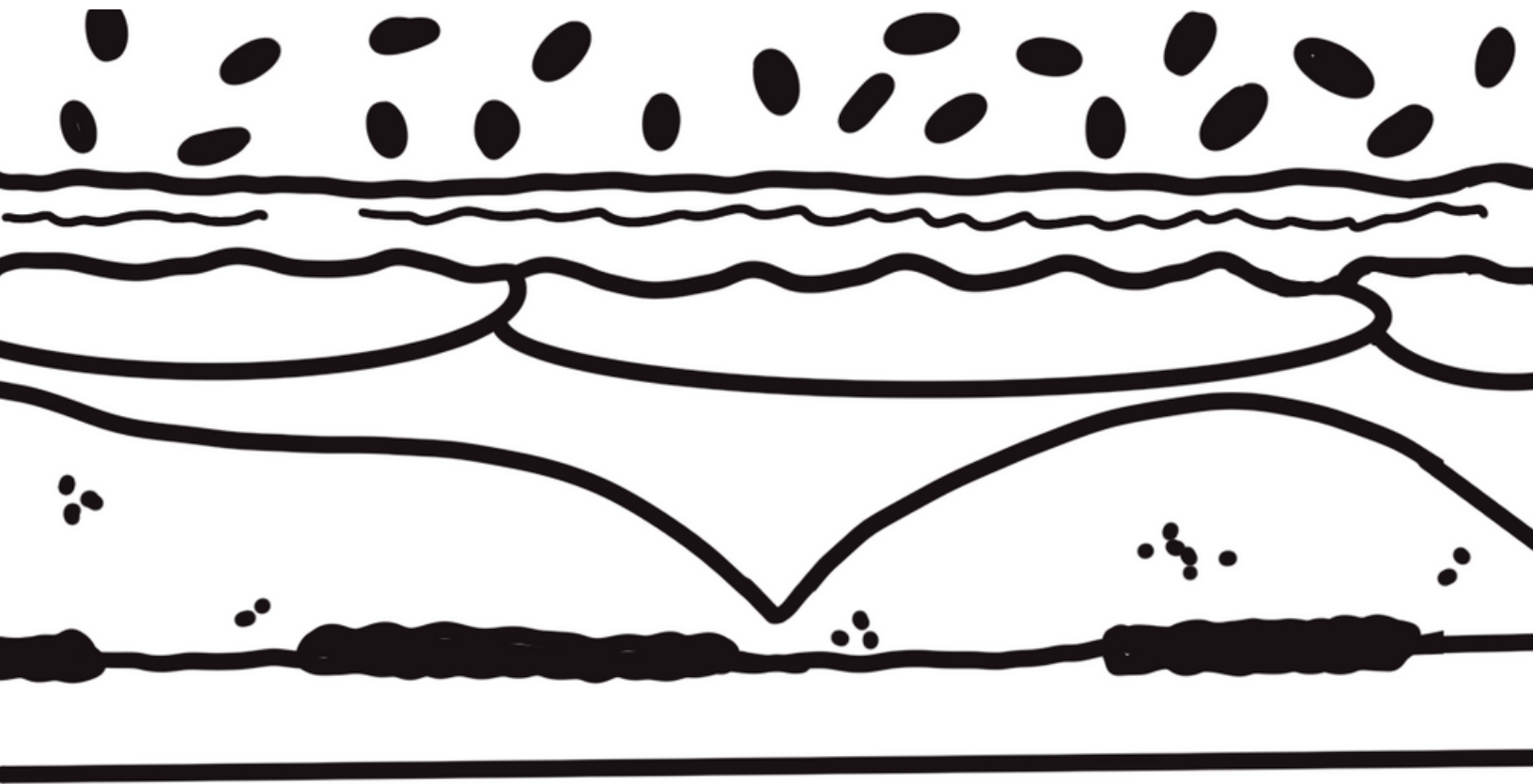
1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the bun at the top and bottom of the mug with 2–3 coats of Tan.
3. Paint the lettuce with 2–3 coats of Green.
4. Paint the burger with 2–3 coats of Brown.
5. Paint the tomato with 2–3 coats of Red.
6. Paint the cheese with 2–3 coats of Golden Yellow.
7. Paint the pickle slices with 2–3 coats of Olive Green.
8. Paint the oval sesame seeds on the top bun with Cream.
9. With a Dark Green writer bottle, make squiggly lines and outline the lettuce section.
10. With a Burgundy writer bottle, outline only the bottom edge of the tomato.
11. With a Dark Brown writer bottle, paint 2–3 dot clusters around the painted burger section. Let dry.
12. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

# Cherries Jubilee Plate

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Square salad plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Sponge

Small and medium liner brushes

Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Pale Blue, Dark Blue, Red

Writer bottle: White



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Using a damp sponge, paint the entire plate with 1 coat of Pale Blue.
3. Paint the cherry shapes with 3 coats of Dark Blue.
4. Paint the bow with 3 coats of Red.
5. With a White writer bottle, paint small stars on the right cherry, paint the stitch line, outline the cherry, and paint the highlight lines on the red bow.
6. With a Red writer bottle, paint the lettering along the bottom of the plate. Let dry.
7. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

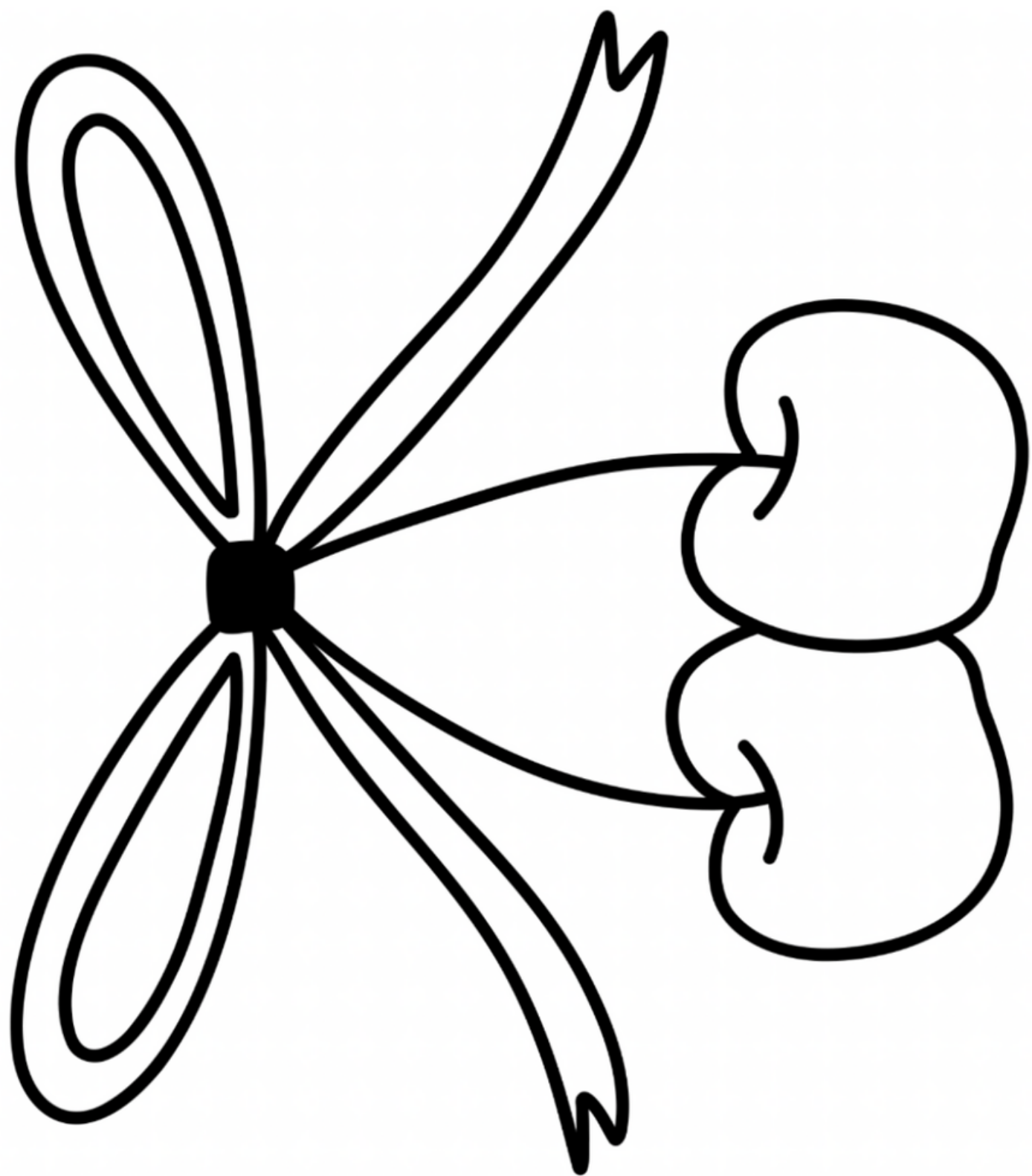

# Colorful Cone Mug

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Tall mug  
Pattern  
Tissue paper  
Pencil  
Sharpie  
Small and medium liner brushes  
 $\frac{3}{4}$ –1" blue painter's tape  
Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Bright Teal Blue, Salmon Pink, Teal Green, Bright Orange, Yellow  
Writer bottles: Coral Pink, Green, Dark Orange, Golden Yellow



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place first piece of blue painters tape slightly below the top edge of the mug. Repeat tape placements on the rest of the mug, leaving a small space in between the taped areas.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Paint the lines between the tape and along the top edge with 3 coats of Bright Teal Blue.
4. Once stripes are dry, paint the cones the designated colors: 3 coats of Salmon Pink, 3 coats of Teal, 3 coats of Bright Orange, and 3 coats of Yellow.
5. With writer bottle, outline the cone design and the ice cream as follows: Dark Pink with Salmon Pink ice cream, Kelly Green with the Teal Green ice cream, Dark Orange with the Bright Orange, and Golden Yellow with the Yellow ice cream. Paint the highlight line and dot on each corresponding ice cream. Let dry.
6. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

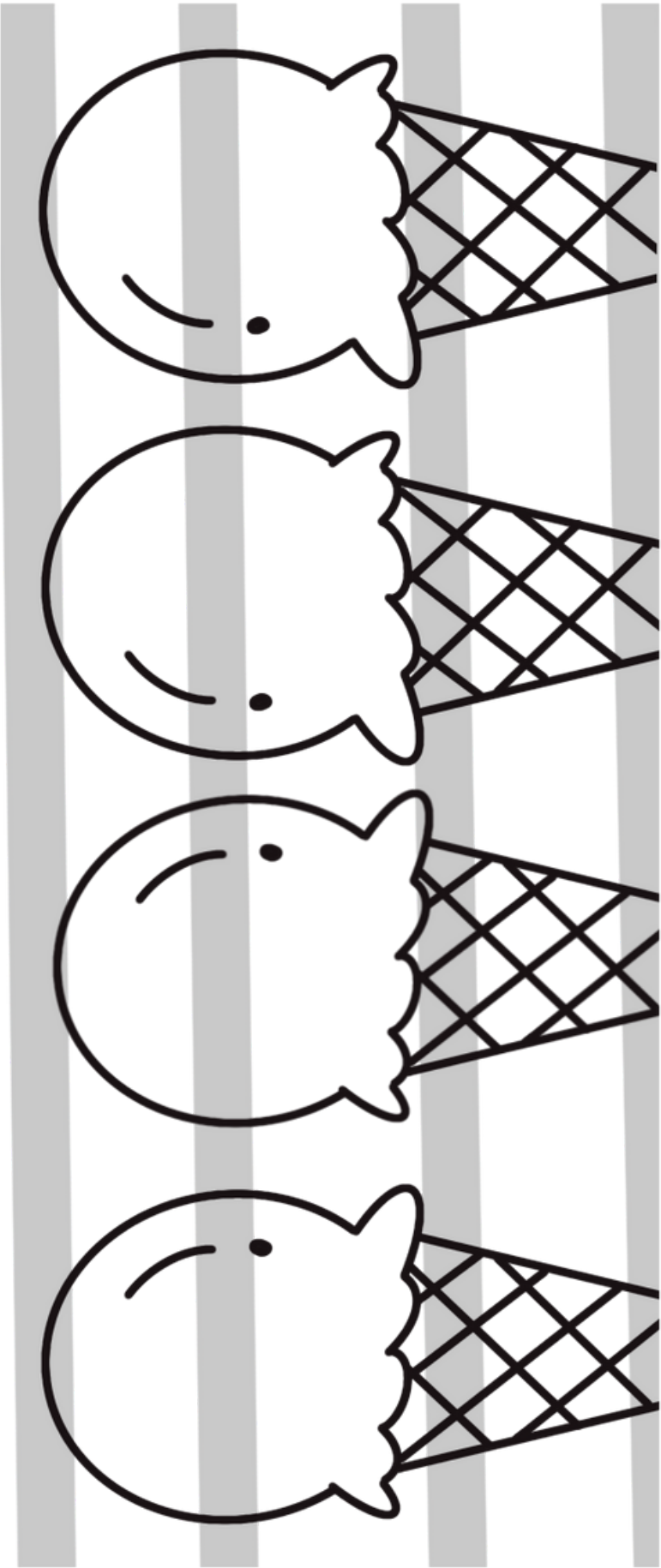

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Mug

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Light Pink, Bright Teal Blue, Red

Writer bottle: Red



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the boots and the inside of the mug with 2–3 coats of Light Pink.
3. Paint the background and the handle with 2–3 coats of Bright Teal Blue.
4. With a Red writer bottle, outline the boots, fill in the heels, and add the details on each boot. Also paint the heart designs in between the boots. Let dry.
5. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

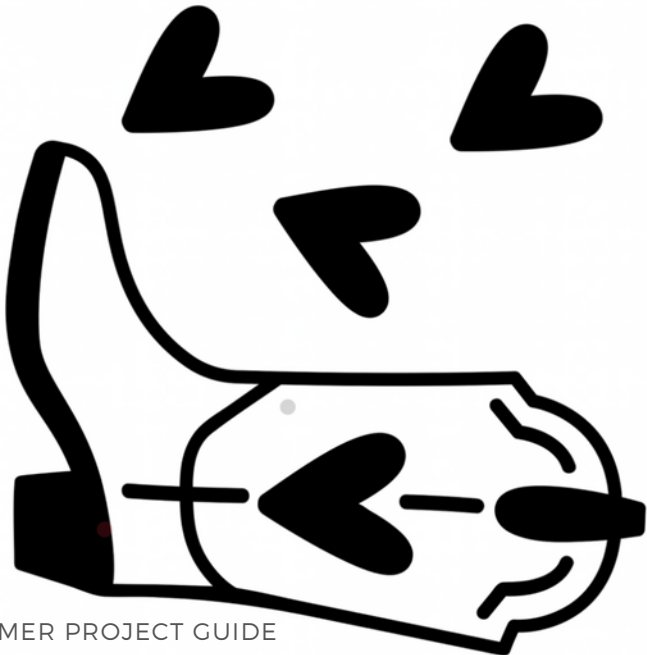
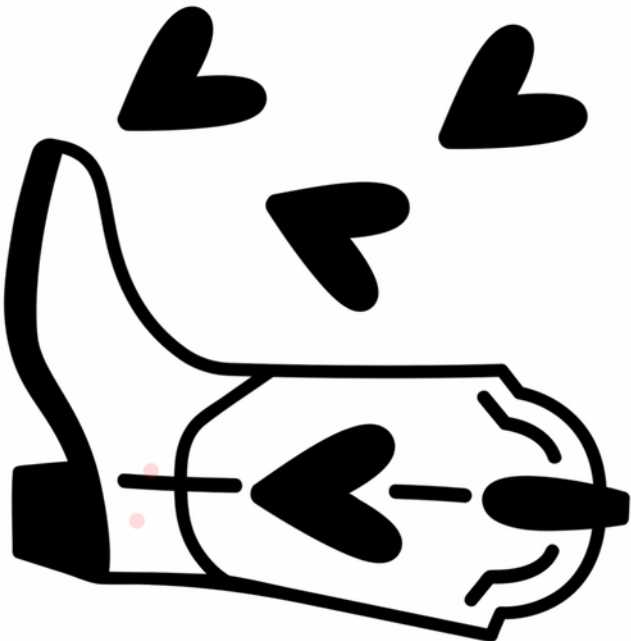
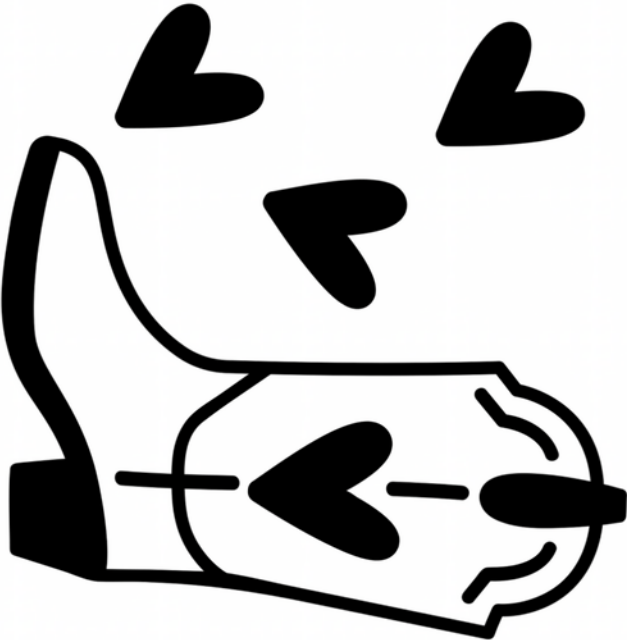

# I'm Just Here for the Cookies Plate

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rim dinner plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

Square flat brush

Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Light Brown, Medium Brown, Black

Writer bottles: Dark Brown, Black



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint each cookie with 3 coats of Light Brown. Leave a thin line between each cookie so you know where each one will be outlined.
3. Paint the chocolate chips with a Dark Brown writer bottle.
4. Outline the cookie shapes with the Dark Brown writer bottle.
5. With small brush, paint Medium Brown squiggles here and there on the cookie shapes.
6. With small brush or writer bottle, fill in the lettering with Black.
7. With a flat square brush, paint the stripes around the plate edge with 3 coats of Black.
8. With a Black writer bottle, outline the inside edge of plate rim. Let dry.
9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

## POTTERY

*Note: There is no color pattern to follow for this project. Just be sure that no two leaves next to each other are painted the same color.*

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: 12-ounce mug

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

### GLAZE COLORS

Teal Green, Dark Teal Green, Moss Green, Olive Green

### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint each leaf with 3 coats of one of the colors. Just be sure that no 2 leaves next to each other are painted the same color. Let dry.
3. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

# Make a Wish Plate

## POTTERY

*NOTE: This project requires an extra day for preparing the paint crumbles.*

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Square dinner plate  
3–4 sheets wax paper, each about 12" long  
Pattern  
Tissue paper  
Pencil  
Sharpie  
Small and medium liner brushes  
Scissors  
Ziplock baggies  
Small cup or plate for paint crumbles

### GLAZE COLORS

Paint crumble colors: Red, Green, Yellow, Orange, Pink, Blue, Teal  
White, Bright Teal Blue, Red, Yellow, Dark Blue  
Writer bottles: White, Orange



### DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING THE PAINT CRUMBLES

1. Lay the wax paper sheets on a flat surface.
2. Pour the desired paint color onto the wax paper and brush a line of paint about 2" wide by 10" long, leaving space so colors do not touch.
3. Repeat the paint pours until all desired colors are used. Let dry for about 24 hours.
4. If you want each color to remain separate when crumbling, cut the wax paper in between the colors.
5. Bend the wax paper to loosen the dried paint and place the pieces in plastic baggies.
6. Break up the paint pieces to create the crumbles.
7. If you're not worried about keeping specific colors separate, you can mix them all in one baggie and break up accordingly.

### DIRECTIONS

1. Cut out the cake pattern and cut out the candles separately.
2. Paint the plate with one good coat of White.
3. Paint the cake cutout with 1 coat of White. Lay the cutout on the plate painted side down. Repeat this step for each candle cutout.

# Make a Wish Plate

## POTTERY

### DIRECTIONS CONT.

4. Paint the edges of the paper cutouts with a mix of water and White paint to seal the paper edges down on the plate.
5. Paint the entire plate with 2 coats of Bright Teal Blue, painting over the paper cutouts. Let dry.
6. Turn plate over and paint with 2-3 coats of Bright Teal Blue.
7. Prepare the paint crumble cup/plate for use.
8. Once the Bright Teal Blue is dry, remove the paper cutouts with a pin.
9. With a small round brush, paint one stripe of White across the cake shape starting at the top.
10. While the paint is still wet, sprinkle the paint crumbles into the wet paint, then lightly pat the crumbles into the White to ensure they stick to the plate. Repeat this step until the entire cake shape is covered in crumbles.
11. Paint the candles with 1 good coat of White. Make 4 or 5 stripes on each candle with desired colors using writer bottles.
12. Paint the flames with 1-2 coats of Yellow.
13. With a White writer bottle, make the sparkle lines and dots coming off the candles.
14. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the lettering. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
15. Fill in the letters with an Orange writer bottle. Let dry.
16. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

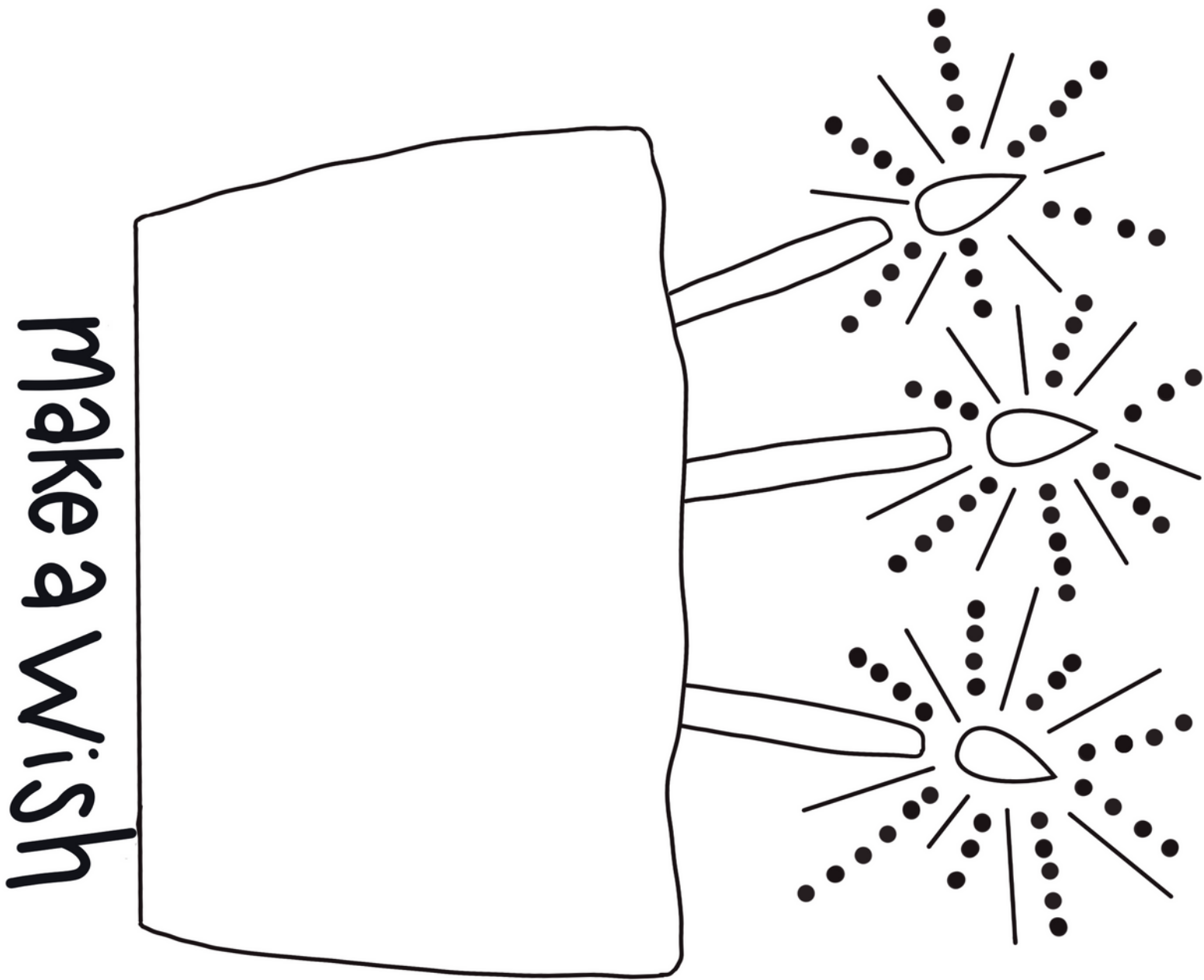

# Pancake Plate

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: Rim salad plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie

Small and medium liner brushes

Sponge

### GLAZE COLORS

Tan, Brown, Deep Yellow, Dark Brown

Writer bottle: Dark Brown



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the butter pat with 2–3 coats of Deep Yellow.
3. With a damp sponge, paint 1 coat of Tan about 1" into the inside of the plate from the inside edge of rim.
4. Dip the same sponge in Brown and sponge the inside of the plate overlapping the Tan ring. Also paint right up to the edge and slightly overlap the painted butter pat.
5. Slightly water down Brown and paint along the edge of the pancake to create a watercolor edge.
6. Take the tip off the Dark Brown writer bottle and paint a swirl syrup line over the center of the pancake.
7. Paint the lettering with a Dark Brown writer bottle. Add small dots along the inside edge of the rim up to the lettering on each side. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

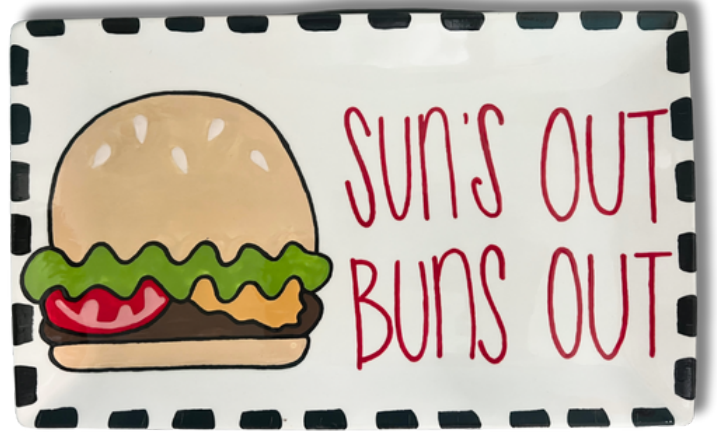

### GLAZE COLORS

Tan, Green, Red, Golden Yellow, Dark Brown, Pink, Cream, Black

Writer bottles: Red, Black

### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
2. Paint the bun with 3 coats of Tan.
3. Paint the lettuce with 3 coats of Green.
4. Paint the tomato with 3 coats of Red.
5. Paint the cheese with 3 coats of Golden Yellow.
6. Paint the burger with 2 coats of Dark Brown.
7. Paint the tomato details with 2 coats of Pink.
8. Paint the seeds on the bun with 1 coat of Cream.
9. Fill in the lettering with a Red writer bottle.
10. Outline the burger details with a Black writer bottle.
11. Lightly sketch lines along the edge to create border sections. Place an x in the areas to be painted Black. Paint those areas with 2–3 coats of Black. Let dry.
12. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

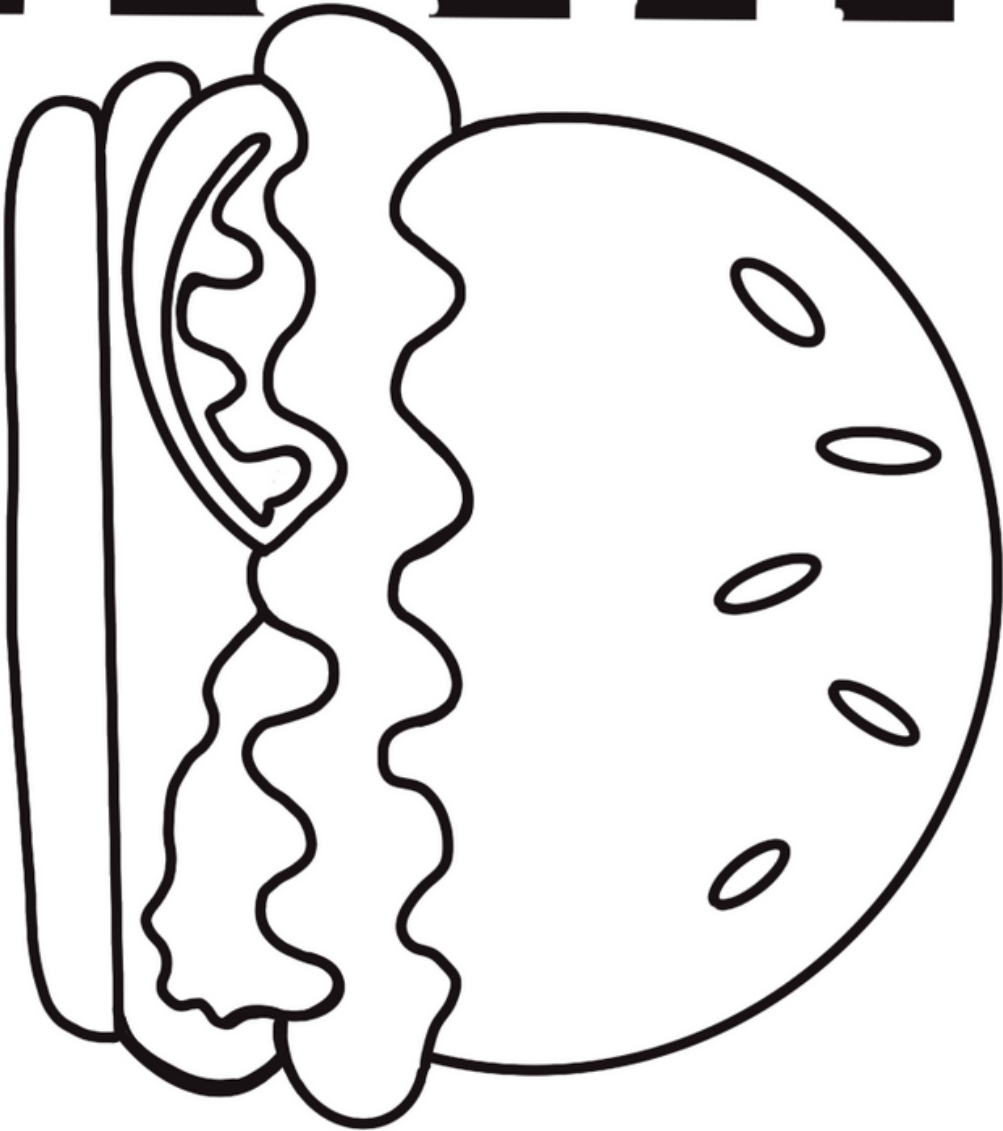

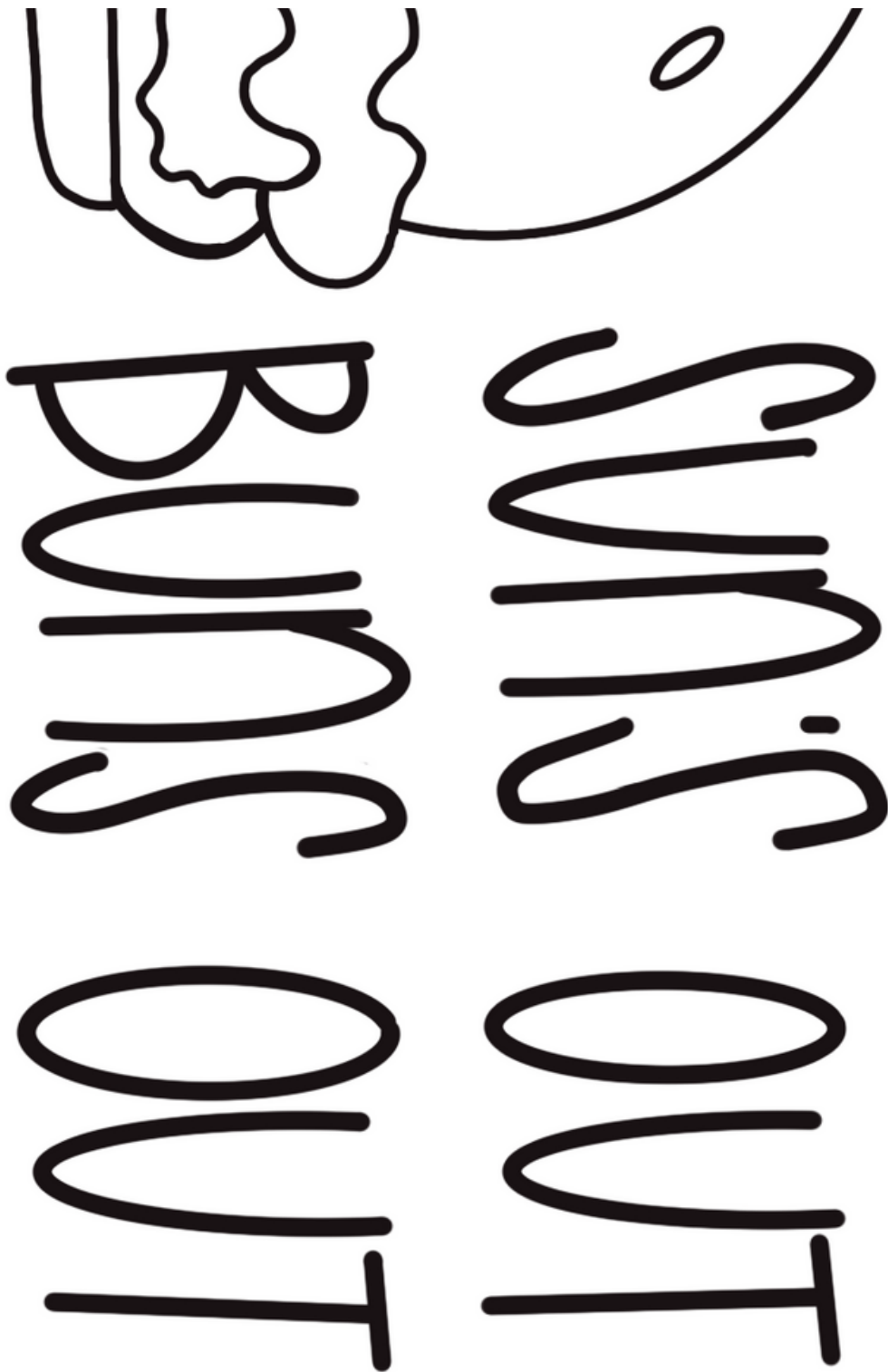

# We Go Together Like Milk & Cookies

## POTTERY

### SUPPLIES

Bisque: 12-ounce mug  
Pattern  
Tissue paper  
Pencil  
Sharpie  
Small and medium liner brushes  
Paper

### GLAZE COLORS

Blue, Light Blue, Light Tan, Dark Brown, Cream  
Writer bottle: Black



### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering onto the mug yet at this step.
2. Paint the handle, the inside of the mug, and the top edge of the mug with 3 coats of Medium Blue.
3. Paint the cookie on the left with 3 coats of Light Tan.
4. Paint Dark Brown dots on that first cookie.
5. Paint the other cookie with 2 coats of Dark Brown.
6. Paint Light Tan dots on that second cookie.
7. Paint just below the Blue painted area 3 coats of Light Blue.
8. With a Black writer bottle, outline the cookies and give them faces. Let dry.
9. Paint the milk section with 1 coat of Cream, avoiding the cookies. Paint the second coat of Cream over the entire Cream section, including over the cookies.
10. With a Black writer, paint the line around the mug that connects the cookies along the edge where the Cream and Light Blue painted sections meet.
11. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering onto the mug. Fill in the letters with a Black writer bottle. Let dry.
12. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

### GLAZE COLORS

Taupe, Light Pink, Dark Pink, Cream  
Writer bottle: Taupe



### DIRECTIONS

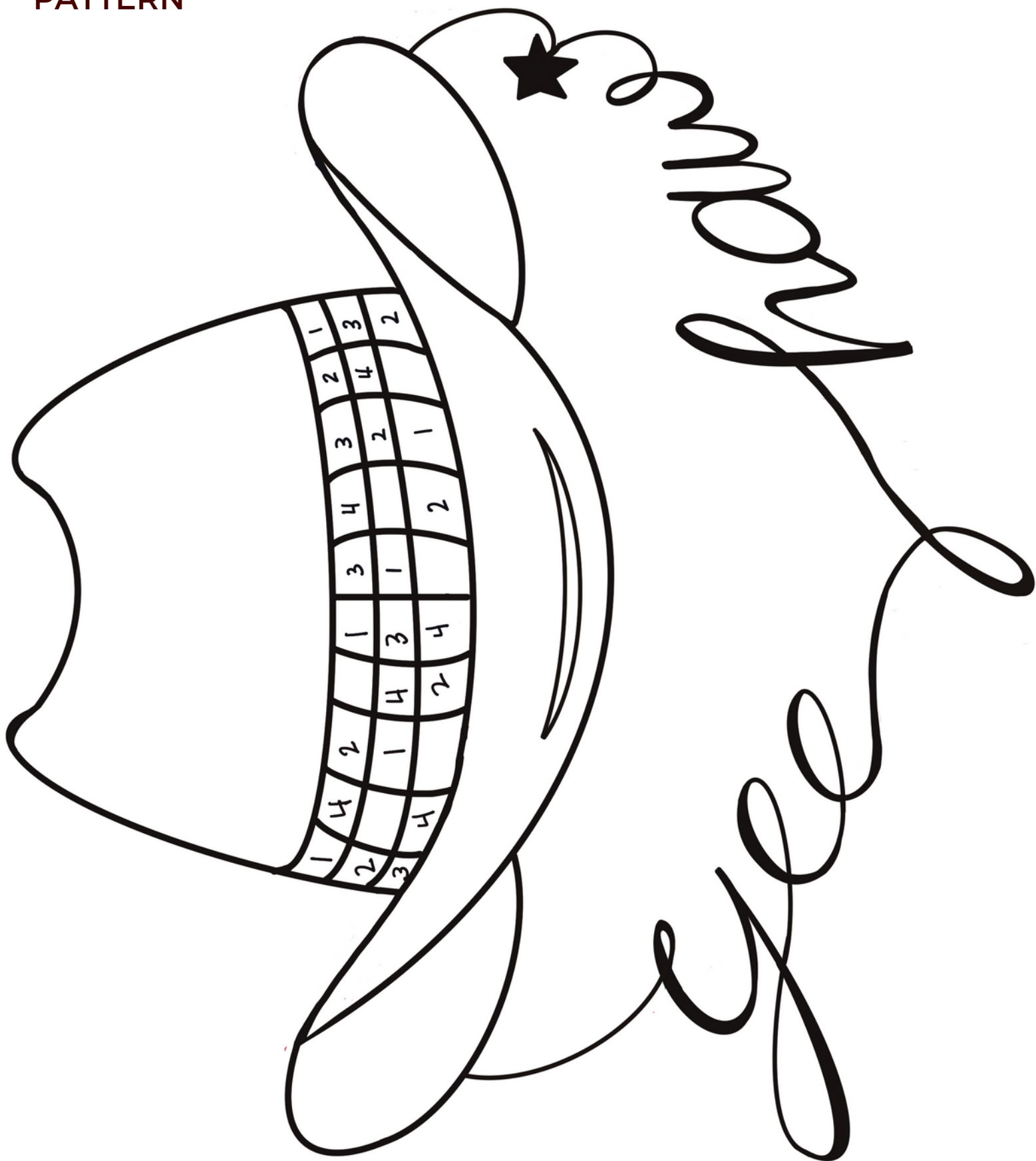
1. Paint the entire plate with 1 light coat of Taupe. Let dry.
2. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
3. Paint the top of the hat top and the folded down part of the brim with 3 coats of Light Pink.
4. Paint the areas underneath the brim with 3 coats of Taupe.
5. Following the checkered number pattern, paint the section with 3 coats of corresponding colors: 1 = Dark Pink, 2 = Taupe, 3 = Cream, 4 = Light Pink. Any remaining sections not numbered are the background color.
6. With a liner brush or writer bottle, fill in the lettering. Paint the star in the lettering Light Pink.
7. Create a border around the plate edge with a repeating pattern of a Taupe line and Light Pink star. Let dry.
8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

### DIRECTIONS

1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering onto the mug yet at this step.
2. Paint the area above the fish (where the lettering will be added) with 3 coats of Pale Blue.
3. Paint the fishing pole handle with 3 coats of Dark Blue.
4. Paint the reel with 3 coats of Green.
5. Paint the reel handle with 3 coats of Bright Green.
6. Paint the fishing rod with 3 coats of Gray.
7. Paint the inside of the fish D A D parts with 3 coats of Medium Blue. Paint the inside parts of D A D with 3 coats of Yellow.
8. Paint the remaining fish body with 3 coats of Teal Green.
9. Paint dots on the reel Gray.
10. On the Dark Blue handle, add an inside a stripe of Medium Blue.
11. Add a highlight line and a few dots along the Gray pole with a White writer bottle.
12. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering onto the plate.
13. With a Black writer bottle, fill in the letters and outline the design details. Let dry.
14. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
