BUBBLE BLIZZARD PENGUIN Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker

Dish soap

Water

2 small cups

Drinking straw

Small and medium round brushes



Glaze Colors

Dark Gray, Light Gray, Bright Blue, White, Black, Red, Orange Writer bottles in White and Black

Directions


- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
- 2. In a small cup, mix equal parts water and Dark Gray with 3–4 drops of dish soap. Use a straw to blow bubbles into the mixture and let it overflow the cup and fall onto the plate. (Be careful not to tip the cup to avoid spilling liquid on the plate.) Allow to dry.
- 3. Repeat step 2 using Light Gray. Allow to dry.
- 4. Paint the penguin with 3 coats of Black. Paint the belly with 1 coat of slightly watered-down Bright Blue.
- 5. Paint the hat with 3 coats of Red and the brim with 3 coats of White.
- 6. Paint the candy cane stripes with 3 coats, alternating Red and White.
- 7. Paint the fish and the beak with 3 coats of Orange.
- 8. Use a White writer bottle to make the snowflakes and the eyes.
- 9. Use a Black writer bottle to add pupils to the eyes and make the lines near the top of the plate.
- 10. Splatter paint snow dots with watered-down White. Allow to dry.
- 11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

I LOVE YOU FOR ALL TIME MUG Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Large mug Pattern Tissue Paper Sharpie

Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Red, Light Teal, Taupe, Teal Writer Bottle in White

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the hourglass design (including the interior heart designs) onto the mug with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
- 2. Paint the background of the mug with 3 coats of Light Teal. Do not paint the handle yet.
- 3. Paint the big heart and the handle with 3 coats of Red.
- 4. Paint the inside of the mug and the top and bottom rims, and the underside of the base with 3 coats of Taupe.
- 5. Trace the lettering on the mug using the tissue paper technique.
- 6. Fill in the "I love you" with a White writer bottle
- 7. Fill in the "so much" with a Red writer bottle.
- 8. Add a few small hearts near the bottom of the hourglass with a Red writer bottle. Allow to dry.
- 9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.



LOVE BUG Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Oval plate

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker

Small and medium round brushes



Glaze Colors

Yellow, Red, Pink, Dark Pink, Peach, Golden Yellow, Black, Gray, Pale Blue, White Writer bottle in Golden Yellow

Directions


- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Do not trace the lettering onto the plate yet.
- 2. Paint the car with 3 coats of Yellow.
- 3. Paint the heart balloons with 1–2 coats of Red, Pink, Dark Pink, and Peach, alternating colors and overlapping some of the hearts.
- 4. Using a small brush, outline the car, fenders, and door with 1 coat of Golden Yellow.
- 5. Paint the tires with 2 coats of Black. Paint the inside of the tires and the door handle with 2–3 coats of Gray.
- 6. Paint the background of plate Pale Blue.
- 7. Paint the windows 1 coat of White, painting over the heart balloons.
- 8. Trace the lettering onto the car using the tissue paper technique. Fill in the letters with a Golden Yellow writer bottle. Allow to dry.
- 9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

REINDEER EXPRESS Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Square coupe charger

Pattern Pencil

Sharpie marker Contact paper

Scissors Sponge Toothbrush

Small and medium round brushes



Glaze Colors

Pastel Blue, White, Red, Teal Blue, Taupe, Medium Brown, Gray Brown, Cream, Maroon, Black, Dark Gray, Light Gray.

Writer bottles in Dark Brown, Black, White

Directions

Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)

- 1. Trace the whole pattern onto the tissue paper with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker—for now, trace only the bus outline (but not the tires).
- 2. Using the same technique, trace the outlines of the windows and of the lettering onto contact paper. Cut out and stick to the plate following the pattern. Number the windows if needed to match correct window sizing.
- 3. Sponge paint the background of the plate, up to the edges of the bus, with 2 coats of Pastel Blue.
- 4. Dip a toothbrush in White and speckle over the sponge-painted area.
- 5. Paint the bus with 3 coats of Red. Once dry, peel up the window and banner stickers.
- 6. Paint the banner space with 3 coats of Teal. Allow to dry.
- 7. Reposition the traced pattern over the bus and transfer the reindeers. Santa, and lettering.
- 8. Paint the reindeers with 2 coats of Taupe, Medium Brown, and Gray Brown, following the sample for color placement.
- 9. Paint Santa with 2 coats of Cream for skin; White for hat brim, mustache, and beard; maroon for jacket and hat; and black for glasses. Outline the beard in Gray.
- 10. Paint the bus grille Light Gray. Add the grille lines in Dark Gray.
- 11. Paint REINDEER EXPRESS with a White writer bottle.
- 12. Using Black writer bottle, paint the tires in scribble lines (no solid coverage). Allow to dry.
- 13. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Glaze Colors

Light Teal, White, Light Gray, Coral, Dark Teal, Black Writer bottles in Teal, Dark Teal, Brown, Black, Pink, Orange

Directions


- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
- 2. For the background, paint a wash of 2 coats of Light Teal. Paint a piece of bubble wrap with White, and quickly press this onto the blue painted background.
- 3. Paint the snowman with 1–2 coats of White. Outline each section of the snowman (the two outer rings) with Light Gray.
- 4. Paint the scarf with 2 coats of Dark Teal. Using a Teal writer bottle, make stripes along the scarf and outline the scarf edges.
- 5. Paint the hat with a Teal writer bottle. Outline the hat with a Dark Teal writer bottle.
- 6. Paint the stick arms with a Brown writer bottle.
- 7. Paint the tongue with a Pink writer bottle. When dry, outline with a Black writer bottle and also use this for the eyes.
- 8. Make a carrot nose with an Orange writer bottle.
- 9. Using a Light Teal writer bottle, paint snowflakes in various sizes.
- 10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

SNOWMAN'S COUNTDOWN TO CHRISTMAS Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker Small sponge dotter

Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Black, Red, Bright Green, Green, Orange, Pink, Teal Writer bottles in Green, Black, Red, White

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering yet.
- 2. Paint the hat with 3 coats of Black.
- 3. The bowtie is composed of holly leaves and berries. Alternating between Bright Green and Green, paint a leaf on each side with 3 coats. When dry, outline the Bright Green leaves with a Green writer bottle.
- 4. Paint the berries with 3 coats of Red. When dry, outline with a Black writer bottle.
- 5. Paint the nose with 3 coats of Orange. When dry, outline with a Black writer bottle.
- 6. Dip a sponge dotter in Pink and make two dots for the cheeks. If necessary, repeat this step to achieve a brighter color
- 7. Paint the eyes and smile with a Black writer bottle.
- 8. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering to the hat. Fill in the letters with Red, Green, and White writer bottle
- 9. Paint the small areas of the background Teal. This will help define the shape of the snowman's head.
- 10. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
- 11. After firing, use a dry erase marker to write the countdown number on the holly berries.

Bisque: Coupe charger

Pattern Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker

Small and medium round brushes

Small sponge dotter



Glaze Colors

Light Yellow, Pea Green, Olive Green, Yellow, Light Gray, White, Red, Black, Cream, Golden Yellow Writer bottles in Golden Yellow, White, Black

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering yet.
- 2. Water down some Light Yellow and paint the background with a wash coat of this around the tree and the gnome.
- 3. Paint the tree in alternating sections with 3 coats of Pea Green and of Olive Green.
- 4. Paint the star with 3 coats of Yellow.
- 5. Using short, quick brushstrokes, fill the beard with Light Gray. Add White to the same brush and layer this on top of the Light Gray using the same brushstrokes. Do not aim for solid coverage.
- 6. Paint the hat with 3 coats of Red.
- 7. Paint the shoes with 3 coats of Black.
- 8. Paint the nose with 2 coats of Cream.
- 9. Paint the sock stripes with 2-3 coats, alternating Red and White.
- 10. Using Golden Yellow writer bottle, paint the shoe buckles.
- 11. Add lines shooting off the star with a White writer bottle.
- 12. Reposition the tissue tracing and transfer the lettering onto the tree. Fill in the letters with a White writer bottle.
- 13. Using the White writer bottle to add a wonky square to the hat as a patch.
- 14. Dip a sponge dotter in White and add dots in the Light Yellow background.
- 15. Using a Black writer bottle, outline the tree, hat, patch, nose, beard, and sock.
- 16. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Supplies

Bisque: Square coupe charger

Pattern Tissue paper Pencil

Sharpie marker

Pattern printed on plain paper

Scissors

Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Off-White, Olive Green, Red Writer Bottle in Pea Green, Olive Green, Red, White, Light Brown

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the lettering yet.
- 2. Dip a brush in of Off-White and water and paint the entire plate with a wash coat of this.
- 3. Cut out the tree and window shape from the plain paper pattern.
- 4. Paint the paper window with a coat of Off-White and place on the traced window design on the plate. Add a little Off-White to the window edges to seal the paper to the plate.
- 5. Paint the tree cutout with a heavy coat of Olive Green. Add a little Off-White to the left side of the tree cutout to seal the paper to the plate.
- 6. Paint the house with 3 coats of Red.
- 7. Remove the paper cutouts as soon as the Red area is painted.
- 8. Using an Olive Green writer bottle, add a few circles in the window for the wreath design. Use a Pea Green writer bottle to add V-shaped branches. Add Red and White dots as berries on the wreath.
- 9. Using a Taupe writer bottle, outline the edge of the house with a sketchy line.
- 10. Reposition the tissue tracing on the plate and transfer the lettering to the plate. Fill in the lettering with a White writer bottle.
- 11. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Pattern Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker

Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Yellow, Pink, Golden Yellow Writer bottles in Golden Yellow, Cream



- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.)
- 2. Paint the heart shape with 2 coats of Yellow.
- 3. Paint the syrup/frosting drips with 2 coats of Pink.
- 4. If the pattern of waffle squares does not show through the Yellow, lightly sketch squares in rows.
- 5. Using a Golden Yellow writer bottle, make the lines of the squares.
- 6. Using a Cream writer bottle, add sprinkles on the pink area.
- 7. Fill in the letters with a Golden Yellow writer bottle.
- 8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Glaze Colors

Pink, Olive Green, Tan, Taupe, Red, White Writer bottle in Black

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Note that the bow continues onto the handle. Use a pencil to fill in any missing design lines.
- 2. Paint the background with 2 coats of Pink.
- 3. Paint the inside of the mug with 3 coats of Olive Green.
- 4. Paint the cat with 2-3 coats of Tan.
- 5. Paint the mouse with 2–3 coats of Taupe.
- 6. Paint the bow with 3 coats of Red.
- 7. Paint all the eyes White. Once dry, add an Olive Green dot. Let dry and add a small Black dot.
- 8. Using a writer bottle or a small brush, paint the mouths, noses, ear lines, and body outlines with Black.
- 9. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.



YOU STOLE A PIZZA MY HEART Pottery Painting Project

Supplies

Bisque: Coupe plate
Pattern
Tissue paper
Sharpie
Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Tan, Red, Yellow, Bright Light Blue, Bright Light Green Writer Bottles in Black, Red, Coral, Taupe, Green

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Don't trace the letters yet.
- 2. Paint the crust with 2-3 coats of Tan.
- 3. Water down Red and paint the "sauce" with 1 coat.
- 4. Water down Yellow and paint the "cheese" with 1 coat.
- 5. For the background, paint 2-3 coats around the heart shape about 1" out in Bright Light Blue.
- 6. Dip the same brush into water and then Bright Light Green, and blend from the painted blue area to the edge of the plate.
- 7. Reposition the tissue paper tracing and transfer the lettering to the plate. Fill in with a Black writer bottle.
- 8. Using a Red writer bottle, paint the pepperoni heart shapes. Add dots on to these with a Coral writer bottle.
- 9. Use a Taupe writer bottle to add mushrooms.
- 10. Use a Black writer bottle for the olives.
- 11. Use a Green writer bottle for green peppers.
- 12. Outline the pizza heart with a Black writer bottle.
- 13. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.

Tissue paper

Pencil

Sharpie marker

Sponge

Small and medium round brushes

Glaze Colors

Brown, Black, Red, Green

Writer Bottles in Dark Brown, Black, Gray, Red

(Note: The sample shown used Duncan Shimmer Ruby underglaze for the red nose.)

Directions

- 1. Place tissue paper over the pattern and trace the design with a pencil. Position the tissue tracing on the bisque and retrace the design with a marker. (The marker will bleed through the tissue, transferring the design.) Note that the pattern divides the plate into equal 8 sections.
- 2. Sponge-paint the outside edge with 1–2 coats of Green.
- 3. Paint the reindeer heads with 3 coats of Brown.
- 4. Paint 7 noses with 3 coats of Black. Paint one nose Red.
- 5. Paint the antlers with a Dark Brown writer bottle.
- 6. Paint the eyes with a Black writer bottle.
- 7. Fill in the letters using writer bottles in Gray and Red.
- 8. Glaze and fire to Cone 06.





JOLLY TREE & COMPANY PLAQUE Clay Project

Supplies

Low-fire white clay with light grog

Pattern

Wooden skewer

Picture of finished project as sculpting and painting guide

Round brushes in assorted sizes

Toothbrush for scoring

Twine, ribbon, fun wire, or wired tinsel for hanging

Glaze Colors or Acrylic Paint Colors

Green, Red, White

Directions

- 1. Roll out 2 slabs of clay about 8"x10" each. Trace the tree on one slab and the van on the other and cut out with a skewer.
- 2. Using the skewer, draw the window and tire outlines on the van.
- 3. Clay glue the tree on top of the van at a slight angle.
- 4. Use a skewer to add to holes at the top of the plaque for hanging.
- 5. If using glazes, paint with glazes and then fire to cone 06. Or fire to cone 04, then paint with glazes, then dip and fire to cone 06.
- 6. If using acrylic paints, fire to cone 04 or cone 06, then paint.

PEPPERMINT CANDY HANDS Clay Project

Supplies

Low-fire white clay with light grog
Wooden skewer
Pattern
Dessert-size Chinet plate
Picture of finished project as sculpting and painting guide
Round brushes in assorted sizes
Toothbrush for scoring



Glaze Colors or Acrylic Paint Colors

Your choice!

Directions

- 1. Roll out a 10"x10" slab of clay.
- 2. Turn the paper plate upside down and press down slightly to create a circle imprint on the clay.
- 3. Align the beginning of the left palm at the edge of the imprinted circle. Press the fingers down in the clay. Repeat on other side with the right hand. NOTE: Do not press the thumb into clay, only fingers.
- 4. Place the upside-down plate on the circle again. Using a skewer, trace around the plate along the top and bottom section and around the lines where the handprints are.
- 5. Cut out along the traced lines. Smooth the edges.
- 6. Place the cut-out design into the paper plate, centering the circle of the cutout on the plate. Press the center of the clay into the plate.
- 7. NOTE: When drying the clay, the "wrapper" (finger-imprinted edges) needs to be propped up with rolled paper underneath until fully dry.
- 8. If using glazes, paint with glazes and then fire to cone 06. Or fire to cone 04, then paint with glazes, then dip and fire to cone 06.
- 9. If using acrylic paints, fire to cone 04 or cone 06, then paint.



SNOWMAN Canvas Painting Project

This project can easily be adapted to pottery painting.

Supplies

12"x12" canvas

Pencil

Pattern

Graphite paper

2"x2" bubble wrap

Assorted square (large and medium) brushes and small liner brush

Acrylic Paint Colors

Light Blue, White, Black, Gray, Red, Orange

Directions

- 1. Trace the pattern on the canvas with graphite paper.
- 2. Paint the snowman body Light Blue. Paint the edges of the snowman White.
- 3. Paint the bubble wrap White. Press the painted side on the snowman body and repeat until the whole body is covered with bubble dots.
- 4. Paint the hat Black. Paint the hat outlines Gray.
- 5. Paint the background Red. (This may take 2 coats.)
- 6. Paint the eyes, mouth, and buttons Black.
- 7. Paint the nose Orange.
- 8. On the background, paint the snowflakes and small snow dots White.

WINTER BIRDHOUSE Canvas Painting Project

This project can easily be adapted to pottery painting using the painted paper technique for the house.

Supplies

12"x12" canvas

Pattern

Graphite paper

Pencil

Assorted colors of tissue paper, cut into 2" squares

Clear school glue

Assorted square (large and medium) brushes and small liner brush

Acrylic Paint Colors

Light Blue, White, Gray, Black, Red

Directions

- 1. Trace the pattern onto the canvas with graphite paper.
- 2. Background: Paint the top section Light Blue. Add White to the Light Blue and paint the middle section. Paint the bottom section White. To create snowflakes, dip the brush in water and then White and speckle the background.
- 3. House: Paint the roof and the post Gray. Add White to the Gray and paint the house part. Paint the circle entrance Black.
- 4. Bird: Paint the bird body Red. Paint the egs and beak Black. Add dot of White paint for the eye.
- 5. Tear the tissue paper squares into smaller pieces. Paint the house under the roof area with a light coat of glue. Press the tissue paper shapes into the glue until the entire house is covered. The torn tissue pieces should touch and some will overlap, but use the cut edges of the papers along the edge of the house to keep a straight line.

HONEY BEE MINE Board Art Painting Project

Supplies

14"x14" wood plank pallet Pattern Graphite paper Sharpie Baby wipes Assorted brushes

Acrylic Colors

Light Yellow, White, Black, Red

Directions

- 1. Place the board with the planks running vertically. Trace the design onto the pallet using graphite paper.
- 2. Wipe Light Yellow over the entire surface with a baby wipe to create a wash background.
- 3. Paint a few of the honeycomb shapes a solid Light Yellow.
- 4. Using a small brush, paint the honeycomb pattern White.
- 5. Paint the bee details Black, including lines of hearts for the stripes. Paint the wings White.
- 6. Paint a heart where the bees come together.
- 7. Using a small brush, paint the lettering Black.

Pattern

Graphite paper

Pencil

Sharpie

White, Red, Bright Blue, Black

Directions

- 1. Place board with planks running vertically.
- 2. Paint the background of the 3 rightmost planks White. Paint the leftmost plank Red.
- 3. Once dry, trace the design onto the White background using graphite paper.
- 4. Paint the mittens Bright Blue.
- 5. Paint the footprint details Black.
- 6. Use a sponge dotter to create a scalloped edge along the Red plank by connecting the edges of the dots. This painted area overlaps onto the White background.
- 7. With a small paint brush, stipple a little White along the prints to blur the edges slightly and give the effect that the prints are in the snow. Also paint the "Ho Ho Ho" in the mitten shapes.
- 8. Using chalk or graphite paper, write out the word "Believe" and paint the letter Bright Blue. This are can easily be customized with a family name or another saying.

- 9. With a small brush, paint a sketchy Black outline around the buttons and nose.
- 10. With chalk, write the quote on the Black background. With a small brush, paint the letters White.
