Typical Costs for Health-Related Repairs & Replacements:

- \$3,500 Install new ADA-compliant bathroom
- \$3,000 Replace leaking siding on 1000 sq. ft. home
- \$2,200 Replace failed gas/oil heater
- \$2,000 Replace leaking roof on 1000 sq. ft. home
- \$1,500 Install new wheelchair ramp
- \$1,000 Replace leaking hot water heater
- \$500 Repair unsafe handrails, steps
- \$250 Install safe, new front door
- \$225 Replace broken toilet
- \$150 Replace failed sump pump
