Evaluate Your Readiness

Use the Preparedness Checklist to evaluate your readiness.

- Evaluate how prepared you are for a disaster by checking off the items you have available to you. The more items you check off, the more prepared you are.
- Make a list of needed improvements based on the Checklist. Work on the easiest items first.

Read The Guide

Read the Disaster Recovery Guide to make informed decisions.

- The Guide includes recommendations and explanations on how to improve your data center infrastructure, how to increase redundancy and resiliency, and a variety of things you should consider when creating your Disaster Recovery Plan and Site.

Create Your Plan

Use the DRP Template to create your own Plan.

- After using the Checklist and reading the Guide, copy the DRP Template to a Shared Drive.
- Work with your team to create your own working Disaster Recovery Plan. Test your plan every six months at a minimum. Maintain your plan by updating it after every test or incident.
