This report is an estimate of total U.S. supply and demand for processed tomato products.

Reports are based on voluntary pack and inventory reports furnished by participating U.S. processors.

2010-2011 pack year statistics based on reports from processors handling 93.62% of U.S. tonnage.

2011-2012 pack year statistics based on reports from processors handling 94.13% of U.S. tonnage.\*

All positions are stated on a “raw product tons” equivalent basis.

CLFP “Pack Year” begins June 1<sup>st</sup> and ends May 31<sup>st</sup>.
