Antonin "Tony" Aeck formerly served as managing principal and chairman of the architecture, interiors, planning and preservation practice for Lord Aeck & Sargent, which has offices in six U.S. cities and has completed projects in 35 states and five countries. Today, Tony remains a senior principal with the firm, which was acquired in 2018 by Menlo Park start-up "unicorn" Katerra Inc. Challenged by Katerra's ambitious mission to disrupt how projects have traditionally been delivered in the U.S., Asia and the Middle East by combining manufacturing, supply chain, logistics, design, construction and technology, he is excited to be working on this "new chapter" with the combined Katerra companies operating from 40 locations in seven countries.

Although the focus of Tony's four decade career has been mainstream institutional, governmental and housing projects, his experience includes such specialized commissions as the historic restoration of two Georgia capitols, a new national mosque for the nation of Nigeria, an anti-terrorism first-responder center at the U.S. Pentagon and a sustainable transit station in Beijing. A recognized, innovative leader of his profession who was elected to the College of Fellows of the American Institute of Architecture in 2001, he has also served a wide variety of community organizations.

Tony holds bachelor's degrees in science and architecture from Rice University, where he graduated magna cum laude as a member of Phi Beta Kappa. A former hot air balloon maker and licensed pilot, Tony's recent recreational focus centers on hosting community events in a backyard outdoor amphitheater he built overlooking the Chattahoochee River.
