Antonin "Tony" Aeck formerly served as managing principal and chairman of the architecture, interiors, planning, and preservation practice LORD AECK SARGENT, which has offices in six U.S. cities and has completed projects in 35 states and five countries. Today, Tony remains a senior principal with the firm, based in its Atlanta office. Although the focus of Tony's four-decade career has been institutional, governmental and housing projects, his experience includes such specialized commissions as an anti-terrorism first-responder center at the U.S. Pentagon, the historic restoration of two Georgia capitols, a new national mosque for the nation of Nigeria, and a sustainable transit station in Beijing.

A recognized, innovative leader of his profession who was elected to the College of Fellows of the American Institute of Architecture in 2001, Tony has also served a wide variety of community organizations.
