## Contractors!

**CONTRACTORS** applying for CRA membership must also submit the following to be eligible:

1. A current roofing Class D contractor license (or Class A, B or C, if applicable) **AND** one issued a minimum of two years ago, both in the applicant's name, from a Colorado municipality or jurisdiction that requires a written test to qualify for the license or two roofing Class D contractor licenses from municipalities that do not require a written test.
2. Documentation of current Colorado Worker's Compensation Coverage reflecting satisfactory payroll in roofing or sheet metal classifications (i.e., 5535, 5538 or 5551) to include certificate of insurance **AND** endorsement/declaration page of your policy that shows this information and reflects a minimum of 1 person working at Colorado minimum wage for 1 year (2080 hours). *If you do not have Workers' Comp. Insurance coverage, you will not qualify for membership in the CRA. Exemption letters are not accepted.\**
3. A Certificate of Insurance showing current general liability protection of at least \$500,000.00.\*  
*\* Certificates of insurance must be mailed/emailed/faxed directly from your insurance agent and list CRA as the certificate holder.*
4. Evidence of passing a nationally recognized examination that meets current building code mandates and that addresses roofing work on residential and/or commercial property (*National Building Contractor A, B, C & Standard Roofing from IBC or ICC accepted. Current code requirement is 2018 version or newer.*).
5. Sign, date and return the CRA Code of Ethics with your membership application.
6. Sign, date and return the CRA Continuing Involvement Form (CIU) with your membership application.
7. You must have a fixed address with a physical location in Colorado.
8. Submit four (4) satisfactory business references in Colorado in letter form - one (1) from a customer, one (1) from a manufacturer, and two (2) others from a supplier/vendor. \* Must be sent on their letterhead or email with identifying company signature; please have them include the following information and answer the following questions:

## Code of Ethics

Revised & Adopted on Dec 1, 2022.

**The Member** will not perform, or caused to be performed, any act which would tend to reflect negatively on, or bring into disrepute, any legitimate part of the roofing industry. However, the member may enforce his contractual and other legal rights related to a project.

**The Member** will constantly seek to provide the best value possible to the consumer.

**The Member** agrees to treat all their employees in a fair and ethical manner.

**The Member** will not knowingly enter into any contract, the terms of which may imperil the rights of either labor or the suppliers of material to receive a fair return for services or goods furnished.

**The Member** will aspire to elevate the standards of their vocation by exercising a high degree of care in the execution of all work, correct any defective work as a direct challenge to his/her ability and integrity, and to do work which will be wholly satisfactory and bring credit to the members, the Association and the industry.

**The Member** agrees to apply all work in accordance with original specifications or written change orders and will fairly convey and honestly explain any and all proposed or executed roofing warranties.

**The Member** vows to protect and defend the public from unethical practices affecting the roofing contractor industry and will not purposely misrepresent themselves, his/her company nor will they otherwise knowingly engage in any type of fraud. Unethical practices are actions that violate federal, state and local statutes, rules or regulations that govern the roofing industry.

**The Member** will operate their business in accordance with the laws of constituted authority at all levels and comply with all rules and regulations prescribed by law for the health and **safety of their employees, the community and the environment**. These include but are not limited to: Employment & Labor, Internal Revenue Service, Occupational Safety & Health Administration, Colorado Division of Insurance, SB12-038, HB13-1062, Colorado Statutes (C.R.S. 6.22.101 -6.22.105, C.R.S. 10.3.111.5 & C.R.S. 10.3.111.6, C.R.S 18.13.119.5), local Building Departments and HOA's, etc.)

**The Member** will attain and retain General Liability of at least \$500,000 and Workers' Compensation insurance reflecting roofing or sheet metal classifications as required by CRA, federal, state and local authorities and attain and retain permits, licensing and/or registration as required by federal, state and local authorities.

**The Member** takes pride in their business, and will endeavor constantly to improve the roofing contracting industry of which he/she is a part. He/She will support the activities of his/her Association and participate in its projects and programs. He/She will respect his/her fellow roofing contractors and refrain from any disparaging statements concerning them.

**The Member** will address any and all formal complaints received from consumers regarding the Member's company within 30 days following notice to the Member by phone or email of such complaint against them. Failure to address a complaint may be cause for termination of membership.

**As a member in good standing of the Colorado Roofing Association, we have read, understood and agree with the above stated Code of Ethics and PLEDGE ourselves, our company, and our employees to abide and be governed by them. Failure to do so will be cause for termination of membership in accordance with the CRA Bylaws.**

# Continuing Involvement Requirement for Members 2026

## Continuing Involvement Units (CIU) Table

The CRA Board continually seeks ways to enhance the value and benefits of CRA membership. Consistent with our Mission Statement, the Board encourages active participation in promoting the ethics, education, and image of the roofing industry in our state through member meetings and actions. To support this, the Continuing Involvement Requirement for Members (CIUs) was introduced in 2017, aiming to increase member engagement in association activities.

CRA recognizes the importance of continuing education in advancing and improving our profession. CRA CIUs help members stay up-to-date, master new knowledge and skills, plan for the future, and responsibly fulfill their role in the community and the roofing industry in Colorado. To remain in good standing, CRA members will be required to submit 8 CIUs between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026, for their company's renewal in 2027 and annually thereafter. This requirement applies to all current and new contractor members. Associate members are exempt from the CIU requirement but are encouraged to participate for their personal and professional benefit. Records will be maintained for all members.

Continuing Involvement credits must be earned through CRA-approved activities, including seminars, workshops, trainings, events, and other learning formats. Credits are calculated per individual and then totaled for each company.

*Example: XYZ Roofing Contractor sent two of their guys to the Trade Show (2), the owner attended a ½ day pinpoint (4) and two people attended the Awards Dinner (2) for a total of 8 CIUs.*

- Members will be required to check-in/sign-in at each event in order to validate that participation was completed.
  - \* In the instance where any of the above qualifying events/seminars are held virtually, each person will need to log-in separately for tracking purposes and no partial credits will be given; participant must stay on virtual call/webinar the full time to receive CIU credit.
- CIU must be earned by your company employees.**
- The CRA Board of Directors will have final approval on all CIU's submitted.
- Failure to fulfill this requirement will result in cancellation of membership. Cancellation of membership requires a waiting period of one calendar year before the company will be eligible to reapply for membership.
- The CRA Membership Committee may grant exemptions for hardships on a case-by-case basis. Contact the CRA Office for assistance.
