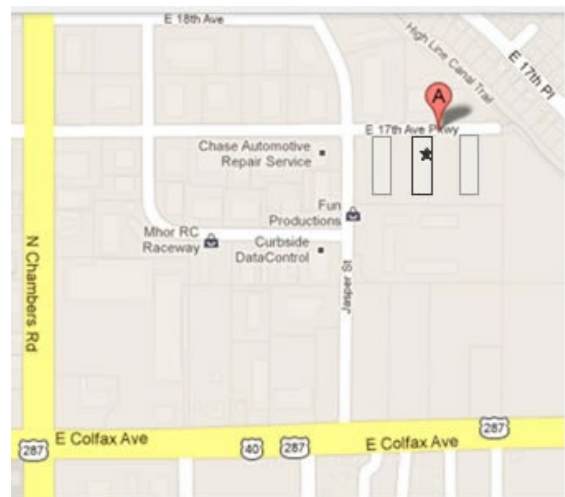




East on 17<sup>th</sup> past Jasper St, 2<sup>nd</sup> Building on the right. 2<sup>nd</sup> door on east side of building.
