#### Choosing Designed Medical Providers

Pinnacol's recommended 5 steps employers should follow when selecting a designated provider.

#### First Fill Form

A paper copy of the injured worker's pharmacy card. This card should be provided by the employer to an injured worker when an injury is first reported so medication can be filled and billed to Pinnacol. The injured worker will eventually receive a hard copy of the pharmacy card in the mail to replace this copy.
