GATHER ITEMS FOR YOUR ONLINE SUBMISSION (cont.):

4. Project Details:

- **Roofing System Description:**
 - Describe the roofing system used for the project, starting from the deck and working upward. This includes all layers, materials, and any specialized systems used (e.g., insulation, waterproofing, membrane types, etc.).
- **Safety Considerations:**
 - Detail the safety measures put in place to protect the crew and the public during the project. This could include fall protection, worksite signage, PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), etc.
 - Address how these measures impacted the project's execution, timeliness, and costs.
- **Job Conditions/Site Restrictions/Unique Circumstances:**
 - Describe any special job conditions or restrictions that set this project apart. This could include:
 - Access issues (e.g., tight spaces, high-rise buildings)
 - Strict deadlines or budget constraints
 - Design challenges (e.g., complex roof shapes, unique materials)
 - Acting as the general contractor
 - Working on a multi-employer worksite
 - Government restrictions or permits
 - Public exposure or safety concerns
 - 3rd party inspections or certifications
 - Challenging weather conditions

5. Proof Your Content

- Review the content for clarity, accuracy, and coherence.
- Correct any grammatical errors or inconsistencies.

6. Team Review

- Have your team or key stakeholders review the content to ensure accuracy and completeness.

7. Enter Information into CRA's Online Awards Platform

- Once everything is proofed and reviewed, log into the Awards Force CRA awards platform.
- Enter your information, upload any required files (such as photos or documentation), and finalize the submission.
