Important dates

- Session started Monday January 9, 2023
- Session ended Monday May 8, 2023
 - OConstitutionally mandated less than 120 days



Bills of Interest

• There were 617 bills introduced in 2023

- O 311 in the House
- O 306 in the Senate
- All legislators are allowed to introduce 5 bills per session
- O Colorado Contractors Coalition followed 46 bills closely
 - Oppose 5
 - OAmend 3
 - O Support 10
