

RULES & HIGHLIGHTS

**** THE COURSE & 18 HOLES THAT YOU ARE PLAYING ARE LISTED ON YOUR SCORECARD! ****

4-Person Scramble Format - Each player plays a tee shot. Select the best shot and the foursome hits their second shot from that point. Continue this procedure until the ball is holed.

Ball Placement - Each player may place their ball within one club length, no nearer the hole except on the green where the ball selected is putted from the exact spot. Maintain the same condition as the ball chosen when moving within a club length. If the ball is in the rough, it must remain in the rough, if it is in the sand, it must remain in the sand, etc.

2-Putt Rule - each foursome will have a maximum of two putts on any green. After each golfer in the foursome has attempted one putt, the 2nd putt will be conceded and the foursome needs to move to the next tee.

Max Score - maximum score of bogey (1 over par).

Mulligan - Limit one mulligan per golfer to be used anywhere on the course except on the Hole-in-One hole on #17 on the Dunes and #17 on the Knolls.

Hole-in-One #17 Dunes and #17 Knolls - Make a Hole-In-One and win \$5,000 Cash!

Ball-in-the-Circle #17 Dunes and #17 Knolls - Hit in the circle on the green and win a sleeve of balls.

USGA & Local Rules All USGA rules are in effect. Local rules are on the scorecard.

Tees. Men: Dunes - **Blue** Knolls - **White** | Women: Dunes - **Red** | Knolls - **Red**

Drink Tickets - Each player will receive two drink tickets. (Ticket will have CRA Logo.) These are good at the clubhouse and any beverage cart out on course.

Raffle Prizes - This year, we have randomly placed raffle prizes in your Goody Bags. Don't toss the bag before looking to see all the great items that were donated and be sure to also check if you won a raffle gift card, golf balls, etc.

Tournament Winners - We will be paying 1st to 3rd on both courses.

Other Covid-19 Related Reminders!

- By registering for the tournament, you acknowledge awareness that your participation may involve exposure to all the risks of playing golf outdoors including exposure to the COVID-19 virus.
- Wear a mask, clean your hands often, and cover your coughs and sneezes.
- Do not touch anything at the golf course except for your own equipment. Bunker rakes, ball washers, water coolers, sand/seed bottles, and other common touch items have been removed from the course.
- No touching or removing the flagsticks.
- The Pro Shop is open and available for purchases. The maximum amount of people allowed in the Pro Shop at one time is 8. **Masks are required.**
- Please do not congregate at the clubhouse or pro shop; maintain physical distancing at all times. If possible, we recommend one person from your foursome enter the pro shop pick-up any items you may need/have forgotten.
- Food and Beverage: The current gathering and capacity restrictions do not allow buffets. This restriction will mean that all events will have to have **BOX LUNCHESES. Those lunches will be handed out by our Food and Beverage staff in the restaurant before or after the round. There cannot be any gatherings larger than the maximum capacity of the restaurant or outside seating area.**
- When the round is over, we advise that everyone heads to their cars. There will be no awards ceremony. All scoring and winner certificates will be announced and sent out at a later date.
