Reminders!

- Please confirm the names on the scorecard are correct. If not, write in any player substitutions.
- **Poor behavior/conduct during the tournament will not be tolerated.** Participants are expected to conduct themselves with proper etiquette for the duration of the event. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including abusive language, club throwing, disrespect to volunteers, officials or fellow competitors, excessive alcohol abuse/inebriated behavior, abuse of golf course property and/or improper golf cart use, or other conduct/activities deemed to be harmful to the CRA and golf course will be grounds for automatic removal of participant from event. Participants will be asked to leave immediately and will forfeit 100% of their entry fee.

Tees: Men: Dunes - ■ (Square) | Knolls - ● (Circle) **Women:** Dunes & Knolls - ▲ (Triangle)

Pace of Play Policy: It's simple. Keep up with the group in FRONT of you.

4-Person Scramble Format - Each player plays a tee shot. Select the best shot and the foursome hits their second shot from that point. Continue this procedure until the ball is holed.

Ball Placement - Each player may place their ball within one club length, no nearer the hole except on the green where the ball selected is putted from the exact spot. Maintain the same condition as the ball chosen when moving within a club length. If the ball is in the rough, it must remain in the rough, if it is in the sand, it must remain in the sand, etc.

2-Putt Rule - each foursome will have a maximum of two putts on any green. After each golfer in the foursome has attempted one putt, the 2nd putt will be conceded and the foursome needs to move to the next tee.

Max Score - maximum score of bogey (1 over par).

Mulligan - No mulligans.

USGA & Local Rules All USGA rules are in effect. Local rules are on the scorecard.

Fruit by Foot Rolls - Purchase during registration on patio. The rolls may be used to measure a ball near the hole to count as a "holed" shot from prior stroke. Once that distance is used, the measured amount must be eaten/discarded. (i.e., your team's 3rd shot is hit within 1 foot of the hole. The team can use 1 foot of the roll to score a 3 on the hole. The team then has 1 foot of roll left to use on other holes.) Each Fruit by the foot roll is 2 feet. **Maximum of 4 rolls per team.**
