

## 2021 Fall Sporting Clay Tournament Rules Sheet

## ~ Safety Rules ~

- 1. Participants must follow all safety rules.
- 2. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times while on the course.
- 3. By registering for the tournament, you acknowledge awareness that your participation may involve exposure to all the risks of an outdoor sporting clay course including exposure to the COVID-19 virus. *Masks are encouraged if you are not vacinated, clean your hands often, and cover your coughs and sneezes.*
- 4. Your shotgun chamber must be open and unloaded at all times unless you are on the stand to shoot.
- 5. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 6. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 7. No more than two shells may be loaded at any time.
- 8. Each participant must sign waiver of "Acknowledgment of Risk."

## ~ General Rules ~

- 1. You must indicate who you would like to shoot with when you register.
- 2. Shotguns <u>must be 36 inches in total length</u> or longer when shooting Trap, Skeet or Sporting Clays. (*No short barrel or sawed off shotguns*).
- 3. Each shooter is responsible for their own ammunition.
- 4. Ammunition is restricted to #7 1/2, 8 or 9 shot, 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches, lead target loads.
- 5. Empties must be discarded into the barrels provided at the shooting stations.
- 6. Shooters will rotate as to who will shoot first at each stand.
- 7. The only instance in which you are permitted to re-shoot or take another turn is when the throwing machine or your shotgun malfunctions.
- 8. Winners will be determined based on highest number of hits out of 100 rounds fired.
- 9. In case of a tie, the shooter with the longest consecutive string of hits will be the winner.
- 10. Event prizes and door prizes will be presented at lunch immediately following the tournament.
- 11. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED ON THE RANGE**. Once all shooters have completed the course, beer will be available during lunch.
