2023 RULES SHEET

~ Safety Rules ~

1. Participants must follow all safety rules.
2. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times while on the course.
3. Your shotgun chamber must be open and unloaded at all times unless you are on the stand to shoot.
4. Always keep the gun in front of you and pointed at the ground.
5. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
6. No more than two shells may be loaded at any time.
7. Each participant must sign waiver of "Acknowledgment of Risk."

~ General Rules ~

1. You must indicate who you would like to shoot with when you register.
2. **If you are replacing another shooter the day of the event, please change this on your squad's scorecard by crossing out the person you are replacing, then print your name (first, last and company).**
3. Shotgun minimum barrel length is 18". (*No short barrel or sawed-off shotguns*).
4. Each shooter is responsible for their own ammunition (100 rounds).
5. Ammunition must be no larger than 7-1/2 shot. Lead or steel shot may be used. No magnum or high brass loads are allowed.
6. Empties must be discarded into the barrels provided at the shooting stations.
7. Shooters will rotate as to who will shoot first at each stand.
8. The only instance in which you are permitted to re-shoot or take another turn is when the throwing machine or your shotgun malfunctions.
9. Trappers will be at each station to launch birds and help with pace of tournament so that we move along quickly & smoothly. Please keep up with teams in front of you.
10. We are awarding 1st & 2nd Place Squads and 1st & 2nd Individuals (M & F).
11. Winners will be determined based on highest number of hits out of 100 rounds fired.
12. In case of a tie, the shooter/squad with the longest consecutive string of hits will be the winner.
13. Event prizes and door prizes will be presented at lunch immediately following the tournament.
14. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED ON THE RANGE.** Once all shooters have completed the course, beer will be available during lunch.
