

2022 Shooter Confirmation Email

Details, Time and more for CRA Clay Tournament on Fri, Sep 23 at Kiowa Creek

Hi –

We just wanted to take the opportunity to **confirm your reservation to participate** in the Colorado Roofing Association's 9th Annual Fall Sporting Clay Tournament this Friday, September 23, 2022. We are back at **KIOWA CREEK SPORTING CLUB** again this year

You are scheduled to shoot on Sep 23 - 9:00 am Shotgun (7:30 am registration/breakfast). This email is being sent to the main contact (Shooter 1) listed on your registration form for each squad and all shooters we have emails for, so please be sure to share this information with the other shooters on your squad just in case. If any person on your squad has been replaced since you registered, please email me the name changes for the check-in sheet.

We look forward to a great tournament and wanted to share a few reminders for Friday.

1. **The tournament is full.** We ask that if you know in advance that you or other players on your squad will not be playing; name changes to please let us know ASAP.
2. **Address and directions - Kiowa Creek Sporting Club** is located at 46700 E County Rd 30 Bennett, CO 80102. Directions: Please use [Google Maps](#) or [MapQuest](#) to get directions from your location to the range.
3. **Be on time!** Registration will begin at 7:30 a.m. and will be located outside the clubhouse in front of the pavilion. We are sold out and have 170 shooters this year and are asking that everyone be at Kiowa Creek no later than 8:00 a.m. This will allow us to get everyone checked in for our safety meeting at 8:30 am and an **on-time** start at 9:00 a.m. *We ask that if you know in advance that you or other players on your squad will not be playing to please let us know ASAP. **Squad station assignments will be posted to [CRA Sporting Clay Registration page on website by Noon Thursday, Sept 22.](#)***
4. **Waiver.** All participants and/or volunteers will be required to sign an 'Acknowledgement of Risk' waiver. [Use this link to view and sign the waiver in advance.](#) Otherwise, there will be a QR Code at the reg table that participants can use on their phones to sign the waiver. *Note, if you signed it last year, you won't need to do it this year.*
5. **Main Shooter #1/Safety Monitor:** The main shooter listed with each group on your registration form must own his/her own shotgun, have shot before and agree to act as the Safety monitor for their squad and specifically for any NEW/FIRST TIME shooters on their squad.
6. **Rules.** All participants and/or volunteers will be required to abide by the tournament rules. [Click to view here.](#)
7. **Shotgun.** **Shooters are required to provide a shotgun.** Shotguns **must be 36 inches in total length** or longer when shooting Trap, Skeet or Sporting Clays. Rentals are available at the clubhouse with advanced reservations at (303) 644-4627. *(Do not bring a sawed-off/short barrel shotgun).*
8. **Ammunition:** **Each shooter is responsible for providing their own ammunition.** Minimum 100 rounds for the tournament (bring an extra 20 for practice). Ammunition needs to be 7 1/2, 8 or 9 shot, 2 3/4 inches, lead target loads. (Shells can be purchased at the clubhouse.)
9. **Eye & Ear Protection.** Eye and ear protection is required for all participants. Arapahoe Roofing & Sheet Metal has donated these items and you will find them in your goody bag at registration.
10. **2022 Course. This is a walking course, gun carts/wagons are allowed. No golf carts or UTVs please.** The course is congested with the size of our tournament and we want to limit these vehicles to tournament staff/volunteers. Participants must follow all

safety rules which will be reviewed and provided to you at the start of the tournament. The shooting grounds are laid out in stations with each station representing one type of bird or a combination of game (i.e.: a rabbit and a grouse). The course features 15 stations that are fully automated including a 60' tower and a 20' elevated platform that is sure to challenge all shooters. Targets are regularly changed on the course to assure a continuous variety for shooters. Restrooms and water will be available along the path.

11. **Photos.** Be sure to get your group photo taken with the CRA Volunteer on the course. Be creative with your poses!
12. **Coffee & Pancake Breakfast.** **Complimentary coffee and breakfast** are being provided during registration to all participants compliments of our **Breakfast Sponsors: American Roofing Supply, Black Roofing & Waterproofing, Kudu Roofing and Metal Roofing Solutions.** Breakfast will be served from 7:45 am – 8:45 am.
13. **Lunch. Lunch & Drinks.** A BBQ lunch and drinks will be provided upon completion of the course compliments of the following **Lunch sponsors: B&M Roofing of Colorado, CLS West, Old Town Media and United Materials.** **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the range** but will be available once shooters are finished shooting for the day. 14. **Grand Prize Door Prize.** Valued at \$1,000 - you won't want to miss out on this. This raffle ticket is included in your registration fee. Each shooter will receive a ticket at registration. Winner will be drawn at lunch. You will have the opportunity to buy extra chances at registration and from a few of our volunteers out on the course.
