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City Commission Acts on Downtown Safety Measures

I wanted to update you on the recent City Commission meeting and actions taken to provide for a more positive customer experience in Downtown Fargo .

At the meeting, Chief Zibolski recommended that two ordinances (Urinating in Public and Consuming Alcohol in Public) be amended to become arrestable offenses. The DCP spoke in support of this change, which provides officers the tools and the discretion to address behaviors impacting the Downtown experience. The City Commission voted 4-1 in favor of the amendments and also directed the City Attorney to explore additional ordinances to support these efforts.

A special thank you to Chief Zibolski, Mayor Mahoney, and Commissioners Piepkorn, Kolpack, and Turnberg for their continued support of Downtown Fargo.

The DCP is working with city leaders on increasing the police and enforcement presence this summer and extending this coverage into early spring and late fall, which is beyond the additional efforts seen last summer. The DCP will continue collaborating to improve safety and ensure a positive experience for everyone.
