As the DCP continues efforts to address the complex issue of homelessness and its impact on our downtown community, your support is crucial. The Downtown Community Partnership (DCP) is advocating for important changes to the City's proposed ordinance and resolution related to encampments on public property.

We're asking for your involvement in three key ways:

1. **Attend the City Commission Meeting** on Tuesday, Sept. 3 at 5 PM at City Hall. You do not need to speak — just your presence will make a significant impact.
2. **Reach Out to the City Commission.** It's important that the voices of our downtown community are heard. You can contact the City Commission to express your support for the DCP's recommended edits. Feel free to reference our letter or share your own thoughts.
3. **Sign Up to Speak (If Interested).** If you would like to speak at the meeting, you need to sign up by noon on Sept. 3. The City limits the number of speakers to 12, so signing up early is crucial.

Your participation in this process is vital to ensuring that our downtown remains a safe, vibrant, and inclusive place for everyone.
