
Welcome

Cancellation at any time will result in a \$200.00 non-refundable fee.

- ightarrow No exhibitor may assign, sublet, or share the space allotted.
- \rightarrow All representative names must be submitted before Feb. 10, 2026.
- → Set up is from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on Tuesday, Feb 24. There are no exceptions to this rule. Staff will not be on hand after 5:00 pm to assist and doors will be locked.
- → Load and unload in marked areas only.

- → All exhibit materials, equipment, signs, etc. must be contained in the space provided (10x6) with an 8-foot height limit. An additional booth can be purchased if needed.
- $\,\,\rightarrow\,\,$ Take down shall not occur before noon on Thursday, Feb 26.
- $\,\rightarrow\,\,$ Exhibitors are responsible for staffing the booth at all times.
- ightarrow DRWA is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged exhibit goods or materials.

- → The Delaware State Fairgrounds is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged exhibit goods or materials
- → Do not attach, suspend, or add weight to any part of the booth framework.
- → Do not deface any property not belonging to you including Conference promotional materials.
- \rightarrow There shall be no obstructions, tripping hazards, etc. in aisleways.
- → Games must be contained to a reasonable space in your exhibit area.
- → Adjacent booth spaces must be visible to all attendees at all times, do not block visibility nor entry to adjacent spaces.
- → No alcohol or illegal substances can be distributed.
- → Be courteous to other exhibitors should you have noisemaking equipment or electronics.
- → Smoking and vaping are allowed outside only and in designated areas.

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LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:

All property of the exhibitor remains under his/her custody and control in transit to and from the Dover Building areas and while it is in the confines of the Dover Building areas. Neither DRWA staff, its service contractors, the management of the Dover Building, nor any of the officers, staff members, or directors of any of the same area responsible for the safety of the property or exhibitors from theft, damage by fire, accident, vandalism or other causes, and the exhibitor expressly waives and releases any claim or demand he may have against any of them for any damage to or loss of any property of the exhibitor.
