

As 2024 comes to a close, we reflect on the remarkable achievements of EB this year. Our membership grew to over 400 strong, and we hosted over 60 unique events that fostered meaningful connections and opportunities for personal and professional growth.

We kicked off the year on a journey of health and wellness – from a shared cycling experience to conversations on personal finance. In the spring, members laughed as we tossed pizza dough in the air – a sprinkling of flour falling on our hair. In the summer, we learned about homeownership in what one member stated was, "the best event of the year." Expert guest speakers taught us about personal branding and burnout; all the while, we explored venues in Fort Lauderdale and beyond, in many cases for the first time.

It reflects the deepened relationships among our members, made possible only because of EB, our dedicated volunteers, leadership, and the funders behind the mission.

At our Meet & Greet in December, several first-time members joined us, and a similar pattern emerged: young professionals, recently arrived from other states, looking to forge connections in their newfound home -- to meet like-minded people and explore the places and unique energy that Broward County has to offer.

Even for those of us who have always called South Florida home, a similar sentiment exists -- take our Billiards & Holiday Sweater activity, just this month. Two members – South Florida natives -- were engaged in lively conversation, seemingly old friends: "We met a few months ago at an EB event!" they enthusiastically shared, with plans already on the books for their next adventure together.

These are the similar stories we hear from the alumni members who met years ago... and in a year that has fostered growth for EB (especially in Board Engagement), we are confident that more of these memories will be made by our current membership. EB continues forward in a positive trajectory, thanks to you.


