## TOURNAMENT



### RANGE SAFETY RULES

- All guns will be pointed down range at all times.
- As a precaution, always assume that the gun is loaded.
- All shooting will be done from the ready line. No loaded shotguns behind the firing line.
- While any Range Personnel or Shooter is down range, all shotguns must be unloaded and kept open.
- Only shoot at your target.
- Only load one shell at a time.
- You are responsible for your own gun.
- Chambers must be opened and empty unless you are on the shooting range.
- Always be safe

### RULES

- This is a trap shooting format, 25 targets per shooter per event. Every shooter will shoot a total of 50 targets between the 16 yards event and the handicap event.
- \*First Round Team Total Score will determine handicap yardage; break for lunch and continue with Second Round.
- No Skeet or Sporting Clays targets are thrown (i.e. Crossers, rabbits)
- Each shooter needs two (2) boxes of shells for a total of 50 for the tournament.
- Hunting loads of shot size larger than 7.5 are not allowed. Ammunition will be verified prior to shooting.
- Reloads are allowed IF shot size does not exceed 7 ½.
- 20 gauges are allowed.
- Emphasis on safety at all times when on the shooting line.
- All Shooters will be provided a wristband at registration and must be worn at all times till conclusion of shoot.
- **No alcoholic beverages may be consumed by any shooter until after the event.**
- Tents, canopies, ice chest, grills are allowed.
- Practice rounds may be purchased inside the clubhouse prior to the event.
