FLORIDA APARTMENT ASSOCIATION NATIONAL APARTMENT ASSOCIATION DELEGATE SELECTION POLICY

This policy is designed to be used as a guideline for selecting members to serve as a delegate to NAA. This policy shall remain flexible to ensure that members of the Executive Committee who are members of local associations that may not otherwise qualify for representation be taken into consideration. Further, this policy must remain flexible to take into consideration the increase or decrease in the number of Florida delegates allocated to FAA by NAA.

The NAA Assembly of Delegates is composed of up to 250 Delegates. Allocation allows one delegate for each state and the District of Columbia; the balance of 199 delegates is apportioned by the total dues received by NAA from each Region in April of the previous year. NAA provides the number of delegates allocated for the state in June of each year. The incoming FAA President and Executive Vice President will determine the distribution of delegates based on the following guideline no later than September 1st:

- The primary allotment of FAA's delegates will be divided among, and chosen by, the local associations based upon their unit count as a percentage of FAA's total membership:

Affiliate's Percentage of FAA's Total Membership (unit count)	Allocated NAA Delegates/ Alternates
More than 15%	3 Delegates/3 Alternates
10% - 14.99%	2 Delegates/2 Alternates
Less than 10%	No Delegate Allocated

- The balance of the FAA delegation will be selected from the current FAA members by the FAA President and Executive Vice President with special consideration being given to candidates from smaller affiliates.

An alternate will be appointed for each delegate. Each delegate shall serve a 1 year term, effective January 1 of the calendar year.
