



Leadership, Engagement, Advancement & Development Scholarship Programs FAQ

The Florida Apartment Association provides two different scholarships each year to equip, guide, and assist members in leadership roles within the association. One scholarship provides the recipient a spot in FAA's Leadership Lyceum program. The second scholarship provides the recipient resources to complete designation training such as CALP, CAM, CAMT, CAPS, etc.

Eligibility

Individuals with at least 1 year of experience in residential property management, including leasing, management, or maintenance are eligible to apply. While all members are welcome to apply for both scholarships, applicants who show a financial need will be given priority in the selection process.

Coverage

Scholarships will cover the following expenses for each recipient:

FAA LEAD Leadership Lyceum Scholarship

- Registration fees associated with FAA's Leadership Lyceum program, FAA's Legislative Conference, and FAA's Annual Conference.
- Travel costs (meal per diem, mileage/airfare, hotel) to attend all components necessary to complete FAA's Leadership Lyceum program (three program modules, FAA's Legislative Conference, FAA's Annual Conference).

FAA LEAD Designation Scholarship

- Designation program fees.
- Travel costs (meal per diem, mileage/airfare, hotel) to attend all components necessary to complete the designation. Please note: if a program is not offered in your immediate area, you must attend the next closest program.
- Registration for FAA's Legislative Conference and FAA's Annual Conference.

NOTE: Scholarship recipients will be required to complete the Leadership Lyceum program or designation program within one calendar year. Recipients of both scholarships must submit detailed travel receipts to be eligible for reimbursement.

Application Process

Scholarship candidates are required to complete a scholarship registration form. In addition to basic contact information, candidates will be required to submit a short essay outlining the candidate's reason(s) for applying for the scholarship. Candidates may also be required to supply a letter of recommendation.

Selection Process

The scholarship selection committee consists of the Florida Apartment Association Executive Committee and members of the LEAD Task Force.
