## **Nonprofits** in Fla. on rebound as pandemic in decline

Almost 60% of Florida nonprofits served as many or more people in 2022 as they did in 2019, before the COVID-19 pandemic began to cause financial, op-erational and staffing challenges across the sector

Almost half have fully returned to in-person work and about 33% are confi-dent they will still be in existence in two years, compared to only 18% with such optimism during the height of the pan-demic in 2020, according to a survey conducted by the Jacksonville-based Florida Nonprofit Alliance. But one-third of the ones still around

in two years will need to find new leadership, as that many CEOs and

FNA continues to publish relevant research for our sector on an annual basis. In 2022, FNA released a statewide compensation report, state of the nonprofit sector and giving in Florida.
