Tournament Rules

The Tournament will be a four-person scramble. Each team member hits his or her drive. Each player must have their drive used once each 9 holes. Up to two Mulligans per golfer can be used at the golf tournament which will allow you to "cheat". If you have a bad stroke, you will be able to hit again without counting the stroke against you. Range balls are included in your fees, so you will be able to hit a few before you tee off.

Please read and observe all of the Tournament guidelines.

TOURNAMENT POLICIES

- Fivesomes are not allowed at any time.
- No wading in lakes, ponds or marshes.
- Practice on the course is not allowed.
- Each player must have a bag and a set of clubs—Rental clubs are subject to availability.
- Personal coolers are not allowed on the golf course. There is a fully stocked beverage cart on the golf course.
- Walking spectators are not allowed on the golf course.
- Riders and Volunteers with golfers/and or golf group are subject to cart availability, appropriate rates, dress codes and course rules and regulations.

TOURNAMENT DRESS CODES

- The dress code applies to the golf course and all practice facilities.
- Inappropriate attire includes jeans of any kind or color, tee shirts, shirts without collars, halter-tops, tank tops, and gym shorts.
- The dress code is the discretion of the golf professional on duty.

PACE OF PLAY

For the enjoyment and consideration of all players, eighteen-hole rounds of golf will be completed in 4 hours and twenty – five minutes or less. We reserve the right to ensure this pace of play by removing any player or group that cannot maintain pace of play.

The Tournament group or event coordinator are responsible for proper conduct and attire of all participants, use and care of the golf course and all other facilities and equipment, including golf carts.
