Key Responsibilities

- Travel to DWTU stations and other assigned locations to perform routine operational duties.
- Collect process and compliance samples.
- Perform preventive maintenance and minor repairs under the direction of the Licensed Operations Supervisor.
- Monitor and record operational information, including flow rates, chemical levels, and equipment status.
- Respond to system alarms and troubleshoot basic operational issues.
- Escalate more complex equipment or system concerns when necessary.
- Complete equipment inspections and operational checks.
- Maintain accurate field documentation, including photos, data logs, reports, and compliance forms.
- Communicate regularly with the operations team and provide required daily updates.
- Follow all company safety procedures and applicable environmental regulations.
- Participate in on-call responsibilities as needed for urgent system alarms or repairs.
