

LICENSE NUMBERS (ACTIVE)

- 4,380 drinking water treatment plant operators.
- 4,400 wastewater treatment plant operators.
- 4,762 water distribution system operators.
- **Total: 13,542 operators.**
- 520 awaiting licensure.



RECIPROCITY



- Reciprocity licenses issued.
 - 2024 = 74.
 - 2025 = 116.
 - Total Issued = 190.
 - Total Military Issued = 19.



RECENT UPDATES

- The Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP's) paperless initiative is moving forward.
 - Electronic issued licenses in effect since January 2025.
- A new look to PSI's candidate scheduling for exams on the website, but it's the same process.
- California State University at Sacramento (CSUS) created a Volume III of the Operation of Wastewater Treatment Plants.
 - This volume is divided into two DEP approved enrollments (enrollments A and B).
 - Volume III has replaced the Advance Treatment enrollment. Applicants will only be required to complete Volume III to be eligible for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Class B state exam.
 - This applies **only** to CSUS, not to any current approved coursework through other providers.




RECENT UPDATES

- As of Oct. 1, 2024, the Operator Certification Program (OCP) oversees some Onsite Sewage Program (OSP) functions.
- OCP will administer the exams for Registered Septic Tank Contractor and the Accelerated Certification Training (ACT) I, II and III.
- OCP will issue certifications to Registered Septic Tank Contractors.
- OCP will issue business authorizations to qualifying companies.

RULE CHANGES

- On Nov. 6, 2025, OCP adopted changes to Chapter 62-602, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- Why were changes made?
 - Senate Bill (SB) 162 was implemented July 1, 2023.
- OCP and associations worked together to write the rule for reciprocity to meet the SB 162 requirements.
- OCP opened multiple rules to make changes and update language.



RULE CHANGES (2)

- Rule 62-602.200, F.A.C. – Definitions.
 - Added:
 - Advanced Treatment Water Facility.
 - Potable Reuse.
 - Reciprocity.
 - Ward of the State.
 - Edited:
 - Approved County Health Department.
 - Domestic Wastewater Treatment Plant.
 - Experience.



RULE CHANGES (3)

- Rule 62-602.230, F.A.C. – Approval of Residence or Correspondence Courses.
 - Incorporated Water, Wastewater and Distribution Operator Knowledge Base Manual, DEP Form 62-602.230.
- Rule 62-602.250, F.A.C. – Criteria for Determining Eligible Experience.
 - Added paragraph explaining experience for advanced treatment water facilities.
- Rule 62-602.300, F.A.C. – Qualifications for Operator Licensure.
 - Deleted out-of-date language pertaining to distribution systems operators from 2007.



RULE CHANGES (4)

- Rule 62-602.360, F.A.C. – Licensing Requirements for Reciprocity.
 - Out-of-state, territory or tribal government reciprocity.
 - Incorporated the Application for Reciprocity, DEP Form 62-602.360(1).
 - Outlined requirements to be eligible for reciprocity.
 - Military reciprocity.
 - Outlines which military occupation specialty (MOS) qualifies for reciprocity and what documents are required to be submitted.
 - Gives guidance to military personnel whose MOS does not qualify for reciprocity but can receive operational experience towards a Florida operators license.



RULE CHANGES (5)

- Temporary licensing during a declared state of emergency.
 - Gives an overview of the temporary licensing.
 - What licenses will be issued.
 - What work can be performed.
 - When the license expires.
 - How utilities will report these operators to DEP.



RULE CHANGES (6)

- Rule 62-602.410, F.A.C. – Applications for Examination.
 - Incorporates the applications for examination for water, wastewater and distribution systems applicants.
- Rule 62-602.420, F.A.C. – Applications for License.
 - Incorporates the applications for license for water, wastewater and distribution systems applicants.
- Rule 62-602.600, F.A.C. – Fees for Operator Examinations and Licensure.
 - Adds application and license fees for reciprocity applicants totaling \$100.
- Rule 62-602.650, F.A.C. – Duties of Operators.
 - Updated rule reference number.

 - Make sure your mailing address is up-to-date.




RECAP
