CEUS/PDHS AND CONFERENCE INFO

Pre-Conference Bonus CEU/PDH Information (.5 CEUs)

The Training is on Monday, July 27th. It consists of both the Vendor Expo and Exhibitor Training.

In order to earn the Pre-Conference 0.5 CEUs, you are required to:

- Sign in and pick up your name tag by 8:45 AM Monday morning.
- Attend both the Vendor Expo (9:00 AM-11:30 AM) and the Exhibitor Training (1:00 PM-4:00 PM) on Monday, July 27th.
- CEU forms will be available for completion at the end of the sessions at 4:00 PM on Monday, July 27th.
