## Workshop



This workshop was designed to provide Water and Wastewater Utility staff hands-on training in Emergency Preparedness, Response, and Recovery.

### Items covered will include:

- ⇒ How to align your utility as a FlaWARN partner.
- ⇒ How to complete and upload a Mutual Aid Agreement
- ⇒ Provide experiences and lessons learned from past natural or man-made emergencies
- ⇒ Perform pre-deployment inspections and safety checks on emergency equipment.
- ⇒ Safely transport and set up a generator on-site.
- ⇒ Operate the generator under load conditions.
- ⇒ Recognize hazards specific to emergency conditions (e.g., flooding, debris, unstable ground).
