CEU INFORMATION

This class provides 0.7 CEUs for wastewater operators and 7.0 hours of PDHs. Registration must be submitted to FRWA if you wish to attend the training class. There is no charge for those not wishing to receive CEUs, however if you wish to receive CEUs there is an Administrative Fee of \$50.00 for FRWA members and \$80.00 for non-members, and \$90 for PDHs. Payment may be made by organization check, cashier's check, and money order, Visa or MasterCard. If the administrative fee is paid less than five days prior to, or within ten days after the seminar, the fee will be \$100.00 for members and \$130.00 for non-members. 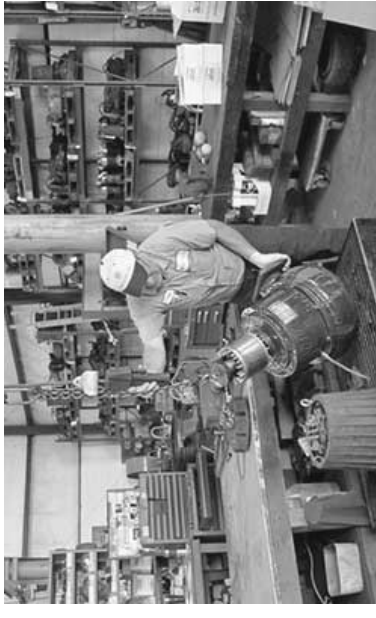


**0.7 Wastewater CEUs

From I-4 South: exit ramp for US-17/US-92 at exit 104, turn right at traffic light. At Benson Junction Road go left, about one half mile turn right at South Shell Road, go approximately 1 mile to Spring View Commerce Drive go left, Hydra Service is about half mile down on right hand side.

From I-4 North: take exit 108 on right, go to stop sign turn right, stay on the road until you come to South Shell Road turn right, go approximately 1 mile to Spring view Commerce Drive go left, Hydra Service is about half mile down on right hand side.
