

SWAINSBORO, GEORGIA COAM ORDINANCE

As many of you know, the City of Swainsboro has recently adopted an ordinance that would have been problematic for everyone in the COAM industry had it been left alone. The good news is that after a brief interaction with the city attorney and GAMOA's legal team, the ordinance now closely resembles those of Savannah or Macon. In essence, you are allowed to place a maximum of six (6) COAMs per location. There are no additional fees to be charged to you, the Master Licensee, or the Location Licensee. There is a no-fee Amusement Game Room license that needs to be obtained from the local government in addition to the occupational tax certificate for those businesses within the city limits of Swainsboro, the latter of which is required of all businesses in the city.
