

Coast Guard Sector Houston-Galveston Marine Safety Information Bulletin 10-25

Harvest Moon Regatta, Galveston, TX

Date: 9/30/2025

Time: 1540

Starting Thursday, October 09, 2025, through Saturday, October 11, 2025, the Harvest Moon Regatta will take place between Galveston, TX and Port Aransas, TX. Approximately 120 sailing vessels (27' to 60' in length) will depart Galveston, TX and are expected to pass seaward of the Matagorda Sea Buoy (approximate position 28°22.962'N, 096°16.871'W) and finish in the vicinity of #6 Aransas Pass Buoy near Port Aransas (approximate position 27°50'N, 097°1'W and 27°50'N, 097°0'W).

The Regatta will span two Captain of the Port (COTP) zones and is projected to depart the Houston-Galveston COTP zone around midnight the evening of October 10, 2025. The Regatta will conclude in the Corpus Christi COTP zone in Port Aransas by 1 p.m. on October 11, 2025.

Mariners are advised to use special caution the week before and following the event due to an increase in sailing vessels that will be transiting to and from the event.
