Let's hear from you:

Thomas Smith, J&S Chemical: We are a manufacturer of specialty in-process lubricants for automotive parts manufacturing. Due to the Covid automotive industry shutdown, we forecasted a revenue loss. What to do to save jobs, how can we help out manufacturing? With our capabilities we can manufacture bulk (6500 gallons bulk) sanitizer. We've always been in close contact with GA Dept of Econ Dev, who helps us with due diligence reports, and connected us to GMA. On my first call, I met with Joe/Bobby Dodd Institute. Bulk manuf is limited because of small packaging. Joe's line of business is janitorial contracts with government entities and others as well, we have no experience in that. If J&S supply large qty and Joe repack into smaller qty, it keeps both of us operational. Lots of Joe's contracts requested hand sanitizer, we supplied it. Now, a long term product for us and repacking at Joe/Bobby Dodd. We are exploring other janitorial sanitizing products to add to our product line with Joe repacking it for us into smaller quantities. They are now our distribution channel. Thanks GMA!

Jason: This is a perfect example on how we want to help you! Jason and Wesley to tour J&S today, and tomorrow at Bobby Dodd Institute - to share the impact of the good side of manufacturing in these times. Great to hear about new products and new ongoing relationships! Thomas was open minded on the first TaskForce, and it has led to a great partnership where both manufacturers benefit.

Gene Kim, JX Nippon ANCI: We initially connected with GMA a couple of years ago. More acclimated at these Task Force calls, lots of discussion. We provide filter materials for masks for World Emblem. Currently engaged in a very productive phone call with another GMA connection. Hearing from others about what is going on regarding trade shows, business, new opportunities is very crucial for us when making decisions. Look forward to talk about reopening, what comes next. We are into the high performance materials. Most of our materials are plastic based, food bags, filters, laminate. Factories in AL and GA. HQ in Kennesaw. We also produce other very specific products: ie a nutrient for fish, a non-synthetic nutrient, also in supplements. Medical apparel industry PPE; specific requests for non-woven type of material, masks, etc.

LD DeKatch, FastSigns-Snellville: These calls provided us with innovations and repurpose information, to fill the niches right now. Signs and face shields. Face shields are easier for

employees to work, they dont fog up. We also make countertop shields for medical offices for instance. Trucking companies graphics such as unloading new guideline signs and new procedure signs for the drivers. These calls are great, it's not all doom and gloom, and are more detailed than live networking.

Justin Hughes, Dieselgrid, has given GMA insights in logistics/shipping space. Justin: there are new rules at deliveries, X number of trucks allowed in a facility. We have our own process to eliminate personal contact, and are building out an online version. Now in email. Justin, with Jason, is developing a Safe Shippers program, more on Thursday's GMA call. If you want to be part of that TaskForce, let us know, we'd love your input.

Michele Murphy, Benefit Resources: employee benefits. Looking forward to E2E call next Wednesday to solidify what I've heard/read. Love the positivity of this group.

Pierre Tanguay, was an executive with Wheelabrator: is in transition. Love the interaction here, to see how everything is connected, and everyone is connected here with each other. Like to hear about the recovery mode, people are smiling.

Jason Lammers, Grenzebach: "be right back", in listening mode.

Ami Pierson: National account manager, ADT Security/Commercial. We are a security integrator, we found new partners for thermal cameras to screen employees at any entrance. Also, a people count is part of the camera application. Will consult as to the next steps, what do you do when you have a positive read.

Tara Burke, are in the insurance space so like to meet people in other industries. Make sure you contact your insurance provider when you are making new products. Make sure you are covered.

Biff Hadden, Col Ret, works for the Secretary of Defense, covers MS, AL, FL, and Puerto Rico. Take care of servicemen who were hurt in training and provide employment for them. This time has brought change, I'm meeting with the Governor's office and the Secretary of State, as they get back to a workforce normal pace, how do you fill these positions. Previous employees are looking for alternative employment, or if older, not returning back. On Zoom call with Mark Butler, Commissioner of GA Dept of Labor, tonight. They are using zoom to get the word out. Jason, you may want to call Fred Rappensberger or Mark to see how the State can help us or we can help them. I refer to GMA calls as an example to stay engaged and communicate.

Roger Grabman: We hosted an Engineering Society meeting last night on YouTube, 6 subject matter experts talking about engineering procedures in a time of pandemic. Call is archived on YouTube! Next month: disruption of supply chain.

Charlie Lunn, TenCate Geosynthetics: Environmental Safety manager for all US. Have had positive cases, we are still up/running, people are comfortable coming to work. Connected with

Cokkie and C.A. Short last week about safety incentive program, it was good. Taking an antibody test this week, am the company guinea pig! Sign up online, it is a fast process. They are using the Abbotts test. Urgent Care of Dacula, GA and Urgent Care of Oconee - all test for antibodies, you must be symptom free. https://patient.labcorp.com/covid-19-antibody-test 3 different sources: LabCorp, Urgent Care of Oconee, NGPG Urgent Care in Dacula Roger Grabman: is antibody test covered by insurance? Charlie: no, per government mandate only the nose swapping test is covered.

Cokkie Eaker, GMA Scribe - Peerless Performance: connection with Charlie Lunn last week, demonstrated the safety incentive platform. Thank you for a great connection! Also connected with Daniel Defense yesterday. Would have never discovered these needs if casually met at a live event. These are great networking calls!

LD DeKatch: encourage everyone to be on Thursday's call, also thanks to Justin Hughes to put a process in place for truckers.
